LAST GAME

Constantly teetering on the edge of pulling ahead, the Bowie Baysox needed ten innings to secure their fifth walk-off win on the season on Friday night, taking down the Somerset Patriots 3-2. Joey Ortiz stayed hot for Bowie, and he pounced on Matt Sauer with a solo home run in the first inning, his 15th of the season. Home runs were pivotal in the game, as Rodolfo Duran gave Somerset the lead with a two-run blast in the second inning. That homer would be the only run support for Somerset, as Cade Povich hurled five strong innings in his Double-A debut, striking out six batters. Maverick Handley smacked a game-tying home run in the fifth inning, tying the game at two into the tenth. Following a sacrifice bunt, Connor Norby laced a walk-off single to right field.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Still putting up strong numbers after winning the first half in the Northeast Division, The Yankees Double-A affiliate has consistently had the best pitching staff in the league, sporting a 3.50 ERA, but it has not been buoyed by any other league-leading marks, such as strikeouts or walks, they've been lead by allowing the fewest hits. The addition of power to the lineup has always been a help for the Patriots, as they enter the series leading the league with 157 home runs, nearly 20 more than the next team. No individual player has carried the load in full for Somerset, as they have nine different players with at least ten home runs. Speed has been critical for their success as well, with two players among the top three for stolen bases in the EL, including Anthony Volpe's 39.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right hander Randy Vasquez had a small taste of Double-A ball at the end of 2021, but has really matured into the level this season, constantly stringing together consistent starts for the Patriots in their rotation. His meeting with Bowie in July started a brief downturn, after Bowie plated four runs in a winning effort, including a Colton Cowser home run. Around his Bowie start, Vasquez went on a run where he allowed 19 runs in just 14.2 innings, and five home runs. Things have settled back into place, as he's only allowed one earned run in his last three starts. Since adding a two-seam fastball to his arsenal this year, he's seen an uptick in called strikes. His fastball can sit in the mid-90s while touching 98 at points, while he also sports a curveball and a changeup.

CHECK YOUR BLOOD PRESSURE

A walk-off win for Bowie on Friday was cathartic, and continues what had been one of the staples of the season. Bowie has been involved in 16 games this season that ended in a walk-off, winning five and losing 11. Bowie is tied for the most walk-off losses in all of Minor League Baseball (St. Paul) with over 1/3 of their road losses coming by walk-off. In six of the walk-off losses, Bowie had the lead within the final two innings of play, but still lost. In total, Bowie has suffered 11 losses where they had a lead within the final two innings of the game, but only two such wins this season where they trailed within the final two innings.

SOOTHING RELIEF

Bowie has had their ups and downs with work out of their bullpen, as they sported 4.78 ERA over the first half of the season. For much of the first half, Bowie relievers were among the top-three in the Eastern League for highest ERA. In the second half, however, Bowie relievers are sporting a 2.54 ERA, and have shrunk their overall ERA to 3.94, the third-lowest in the league.

NO NEED TO DASCH TO FIRST

First baseman Andrew Daschbach has had a curious relationship with full counts and walks this season. While already just one walk shy of matching his 42 walks from 2021, Daschbach is also on pace to strike out nearly 30 more times than in 2021, while he currently leads all Orioles minor leaguers in strikeouts Most interesting of his approach to the plate has been Daschbach's ability to draw a full count. He has worked 66 plate appearances full this season, the tenthmost in the league. He does not have a single base hit on a full count. No other batter among the top 50 for most full counts in the league has gone hitless on full counts, and his 33 strikeouts with full counts leads the league.

FRESH RANKINGS

With mid-season updates to top prospect lists, Bowie has reloaded themselves with some of the best talent in the Orioles organization. Ranked as the best farm system in baseball by MLB Pipeline, Bowie sports nine players among the update top-30 Orioles prospects.
