TODAY'S GAME: The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, continuing a six-game set with Harrisburg.

LAST TIME OUT: Connor Scott, Mason Martin and Chavez Young each homered in a 6-5 loss at Harrisburg on Tuesday night. Harrisburg picked up seven extra base hits in the series opener.

LA LECHE: Since his return from the injured list on July 8, INF Domingo Leyba has provided some punch at the top of the Altoona lineup and was quickly promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis on July 25. After ranking as one of the Eastern League's most productive hitters in the first five weeks of the season, Leyba returned from a 2-month stint on the IL to hit: .409/.458/.636/1.094, 2 2B, 1 HR, and 3 RBI in 7 games.

JULY 'PEN WORK: Since July 1, Altoona's bullpen has the lowest WHIP by a Double-A team with a 1.22 mark, the 7th-best mark by an MiLB team. Noe Toribio (9.0 IP), Nick Dombkowski (6.0 IP), Grant Ford (6.1 IP), and Oliver Garcia (5.0 IP) have each been unscored upon in the calendar month. Justin Meis has also gotten himself on track during the peak summer month with a 1.59 ERA in 4 July outings (2 ER / 11.1 IP) with 5 H, 5 BB and 15  $\check{\mathsf{K}}$ .

SMASHYCRAFT: Limited to shorter outings in his return from Tommy John surgery, RHP Braxton Ashcraft turned in his best start with Altoona on Sunday, July 23 against Reading when he retired all nine batters faced on a tidy 29 pitches, 25 strikes. Ashcraft has allowed one unearned run in his five starts with the Curve and features a 2.27 ERA (11 ER / 43.2 IP) this season with Bradenton, Greensboro and Altoona.

THE BIG LEFTY: Lefty Anthony Solometo is the youngest pitcher to reach the Eastern League this season, doing so at 20 years, 6 months and 15 days when he made his debut on June 17 at Somerset. Solometo leads all Pirates minor leaguers with a 2.51 ERA and 96 strikeouts this season. He is one of 8 players to play in the EL at age 20 or younger, Harrisburg has two of them: Brady House and James Wood. Jackson Holliday (BOW), Jasson Dominguez (SOM), Yanquel Fernandez (HFD), Blaze Jordan (POR) and Marcelo Mayer (POR) are the other players in the league that are not permitted to drink alcohol.

MARTIN'S BIG IMPACT: First baseman Mason Martin matched his career-high with three walks and knocked a critical solo homer in the 8th inning to help Altoona secure a 4-3 win over Reading on Thursday, July 20. Martin matched his career-high in walks for the fourth time this season and also made his first professional appearance in the outfield since his debut season in 2017 when he made 13 appearances for the GCL Pirates. Through 68 games this season, Martin's .367 on-base percentage is the highest mark of his professional career since his debut season in 2017 when he recorded a .457 OBP in 39 games. Since June 29 (16 games) he's batting .288/.431/.596/1.027 OPS with 1 2B, 5 HR, 9 RBI, 10 BB, 26 K and 2-3 SB.

TRACKS TO PITTSBURGH RIDE THROUGH CURVE, PA: With Pittsburgh's promotions of Endy Rodriguez, Quinn Priester and Liover Peguero in mid-July, the Pirates roster featured 15 Curve alumni as of play on July 18. In Priester's debut on July 17, all but one player in the starting 10 suited up as a minor leaguer for Altoona (Carlos Santana). 9 of the current 25 Pirates have suited up for Altoona since the beginning of the 2021 season.

EXTRA RUNS: The Curve have allowed the most runs in extra innings this season in the Eastern League, allowing 19 runs in 10 extra innings. Altoona has scored 13 runs of their own and are 5-4 in games that have gone to extras.

STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE: Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to fewest in minor league baseball.

THE MEN FROM THE UPPER CHAMBER: Managed by former Expos star Delino DeShields, the Senators went 31-37 in the First Half and have several top Nationals prospects according to MLB Pipeline: No. 1 OF James Wood, No. 2 INF Brady House, No. 5 OF Robert Hassell III, No. 12 RHP Cole Henry, No. 17 RHP Zach Brzykcy, No. 18 INF Trey Lipscomb, No. 22 LHP Mitchell Parker, and No. 26 RHP Gerardo Carrillo

THE FIRST TO FILIBUSTER: Dustin Saenz makes his second start of the season on against Altoona. Saenz allowed 5 runs on 9 hits in 5.2 IP on June 29. Washington's 4th round pick in 2021 out of Texas A&M, Saenz attended King HS in Corpus Christi, Texas and he was collegiate teammates with Seattle's Bryce Miller who recently made his major league debut.

**2023:** Began the season with the KT Wiz of the Korean Baseball Organization and went 1-7 with a 5.62 ERA (31 ER / 49.2 IP) in nine starts before his release on June 9... Signed by the Pirates as a minor league free agent on June 30 and placed on the Development List, activated on July 14 and started against New Hampshire...

**2022:** Opened the season in the rotation for Indianapolis before he was selected to the Pirates major league roster on April 24... Made his major league debut April 26 against Milwaukee allowed 2 unearned runs in 2.2 IP of relief with 4 strikeouts... Made MLB debut on same day INF Tucupita Marcano and OF Jack Suwinski were recalled from Altoona to the Pirates roster... Totaled four appearances for the Pirates and allowed nine runs (four earned) in 9.2 IP with ten strikeouts... Was designated for assignment by the Pirates on May 12 and claimed by the Baltimore Orioles... Went on to make six appearances for the Orioles and recorded a 3.55 ERA (5 ER / 12.2 IP)... Designated for assignment by the Orioles on October 14, 2022 and was granted free agency... Signed by the KT Wiz of the Korean Baseball Organization and was released on June 9, 2023... Signed to a minor league deal with the Pirates on June 30, 2023...

CURVE CUTS: Beau Grayson Sulser...Attended Ramona High School near San Diego...Played three years at the varsity level...Helped team to conference title as a sophomore and set a state high school record when he hit safely in 30 straight games...
