Luis Moreno Promoted to Triple-A Syracuse: Right-hander **Luis Moreno** was promoted to Triple-A Syracuse on Thursday. In 17 appearances and 15 starts for Binghamton, Moreno went 6-3 with a 4.88 ERA and 77 strikeouts in 79.1 innings. He ranked in the top 10 in the Eastern League in innings pitched. Moreno was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week in late June for his two outings at Akron. He went five hitless frames with nine strikeouts in the series opener and tossed four scoreless frames in relief in the series finale. The 24-year-old joins Mike Vasil at AAA Syracuse after both began the season in the Rumble Ponies starting rotation.

Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies took the lead in the seventh inning and held on to defeat the Erie SeaWolves 8-6 on Thursday night at Mirabito Stadium. Matt O'Neill hit a go-ahead RBI single in the seventh to put the Ponies up 6-5. Later in the seventh, Jose Mena drove in a run on an RBI single. Jose Peroza had a clutch sacrifice fly in the eighth to put Binghamton up 8-5. Agustin Ruiz hit a game-tying three-run homer in the second inning and drove in four runs. Wilkin Ramos made his Double-A debut and earned the win, while William Woods recorded his third save of the year.

Ty-namic: Right-hander **Tyler Stuart** will make his second start at the Double-A level on Friday night. In 15 starts across High-A Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton, Stuart leads all of Minor League Baseball with a 1.54 ERA. He has allowed two runs or fewer in every start this season. In his Double-A debut on Saturday against Somerset, he allowed one run over six innings with five strikeouts.

Thomas the Tank: Left-handed reliever **Tyler Thomas** has been dominant since signing with the New York Mets and being assigned to Double-A Binghamton on June 5. In eight appearances, Thomas is 1-0 with a 0.77 ERA, 0.51 WHIP, and 13 strikeouts over 11.2 innings of work. Opponents are batting .135 against him this season and he has only allowed five hits while facing 39 batters over eight appearances. Thomas has tossed six-straight scoreless outings out of the bullpen and has not allowed a run since June 16 against Portland.

Last Start: In his Double-A debut on Saturday against Somerset, Stuart allowed just one run over six innings with five strikeouts. The only run he allowed was a solo home run to Jasson Dominguez, the Yankees' No. 1 prospect. Stuart leads all of Minor League Baseball with a 1.54 ERA this season. He has allowed two runs or fewer in all 15 of his starts across High-A Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton this year.

2022: Stuart was drafted by the Mets in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Southern Miss. Stuart made three total appearances and two starts across the Florida Complex League and Low-A St. Lucie after being drafted.

BACKGROUND: Stuart did not pitch for the first two seasons at Southern Miss, redshirting in 2019 and not seeing action in the shortened 2020 season. He was primarily a reliever, making 35 appearances and four starts across 2021 and 2022. As a redshirt junior in 2022, Stuart pitched to a 4-0 record in 22 appearances and four starts, while holding a 3.38 ERA. He tossed 1.2 scoreless innings against LSU in the Hattiesburg Regional last season, across two outings for the regional champions. Stuart was a three-sport standout in high school in baseball, football, and basketball. He broke Herscher High School's all-time receiving record in football with 2,064 yards, including a 793-yard and 10-touchdown senior campaign. Was second on the team in scoring, while leading the team in rebounds and assists as a senior in basketball. He was First Team All-State and a Collegiate Baseball Second Team All-American to end his three-year varsity baseball career.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history.
