"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

LAST TIME OUT: The Saints' chances at a comeback were cut short in the eighth due to weather as they dropped their second straight to the Toledo Mud Hens, falling 4-3 in a rain-shortened affair on Wednesday night at Fifth Third Field. Just like he did on Tuesday night, Carson McCusker ripped a first inning double, plating Luke Keaschall this time who walked with one man out. McCusker finished 1-of-3 with a walk and is now 3-for-8 with a pair of two-baggers since breaking out of an 0-for-20 skid. The Mud Hens wasted little time tying it up in the bottom of the first as they strung together a pair of two-out hits off Darren McCaughan. Ryan Kreidler singled to left before Jace Jung served a double into the right field corner to even it at one apiece. Toledo took their first lead in the third, benefitting from a Jose Miranda error that put the leadoff man on. Shortstop Trey Sweeney cashed in with a one-out, infield single and it was 2-1 Mud Hens. In the fifth, Gage Workman's leadoff double turned into a run when Hao-Yu Lee hit into a fielder's choice play that drove in the run with one down. Miranda atoned for his previous error pulling a two-run double just inside the left field line to tie the game at three, but the Mud Hens scored the last run of the night in the sixth before the steady downpour was too much to continue. The decisive run was scored on three consecutive two out hits. Trei Cruz, who had the walk off winner on Tuesday, singled to chase McCaughan from the game at 97 pitches. The St. Paul starter was steady, going an out shy of a quality start (5.2 IP, 4 R, 3 ER, 0 BB, 5 SO). John Stankiewicz came on in his season debut with the Saints and allowed singles to Andrew Navigato and Workman to give Toledo the lead.

DEADLINE DEALING: The Minnesota Twins made another trade yesterday, acquiring two prospects from the Philadelphia Phillies in exchange for RHP Jhoan Duran. Both of the players acquired by the Twins rank among the top-100 prospects in baseball according to the MLB Pipeline. RHP Mick Abel was officially added to the St. Paul Saints roster today while C Eduardo Tait was assigned to High-A Cedar Rapids. During his time with Triple-A Lehigh Valley this year, Abel ranks 4th in the International League in ERA and 10th in strikeout-rate (26.6%) and WHIP (1.16) among pitchers with at least 50 innings thrown this year.

HIT IT HARD SOMEWHERE: Carson McCusker crushed a first inning double at 113.4 mph off the bat on Tuesday and smoked one 114.1 mph that resulted in an error on Wednesday, marking the Saints' two hardest hit balls since June 5. The man dubbed "McCrusher" now owns the five hardest hit balls from the St. Paul lineup this year and six of the top-10, including a longball vs the Railriders on June 5 that was demolished 463 feet and at 115.2 mph, marking the third-hardest batted ball in Saints franchise history (Matt Wallner-115.6 mph & Trevor Larnach-115.5 mph). Since June 6, the date of McCusker's monster homer, the Saints have averaged just 86.3 mph on their batted balls, the 3rd-lowest average exit velocity among Triple-A clubs. From the start of the season-June 5, the Saints average exit velocity was 88.4 mph, 14th among Triple-A clubs.

SECOND-HALF SAINTS: The St. Paul bats have been slumping since the start of the second-half, with the Saints ranking in the bottom three in the league in batting average and OPS since the standings reset. Here's where both St. Paul and Toledo rank in several categories in that span:

EDOUARD FRAPPE LA BALLE FORT: Despite an 0-for-4, 4 SO on Wednesday night, Saints infielder Edouard Julien still has seven multi-hit games in his last 15, a stretch where he's 21-for-51 (.412) with 4 HR. Since going 4-for-4 on Sunday, June 8 against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre at CHS Field, "the Canadian Crusher" is hitting .322 (47-146) with 10 of his 11 home runs this season and a 1.030 OPS that ranks as the best in the St. Paul lineup and 24th in the Int'l League among hitters with at least 50 AB in that stretch. After breaking camp with the Twins for the second year in-a-row, the Quebec City native hit just .198 (18-91) with 2 HR and a .607 OPS in 29 games with Minnesota before being optioned in May, and got out to a slow start with the Saints, hitting just .200 (18-90) with 1 HR and a .639 OPS before breaking out with the 4-for-4 day.

MCCRUSHER WILL GET BACK TO MCCRUSHIN': One of MiLB's most prolific sluggers, Saints outfielder Carson McCusker tied his career-high in homers in affiliated ball by going deep Friday, July 18 in Louisville (all 19 HR this year have come with the Saints after he hit 19 between Double-A & Triple-A last season). Since homering, he's gone just 4-last-34 (.118) with 15 SO, including a career-long 0-for-20 slump he snapped on Tuesday. Despite the recent struggles, the Sparks, Nevada native ranks 6th in the league in homers (19), nine of which have come since his brief MLB debut in late-May. McCusker has belted three of the five longest tracked home runs by a Saint this season and four of the top-10. The Saints single-season record for home runs in the Triple-A era is 21, shared by three St. Paul hitters (Y. Severino-2024, J. Camargo-2023, C. Williams-2023).

EARLY SET BACKS: The Saints have allowed 90 runs in the first inning this season, the 2nd-most in minor league baseball (trails only Charlotte-96). St. Paul are 17-29 (.370) in games in which they allow at least a run in the first and 29-27 (.518) when they throw up a zero in the first.

TWINS REPORT: The Twins (51-57) are one of 24 MLB teams off today following a 13-1 loss to the Red Sox yesterday afternoon at Target Field. Minnesota will open a 3-game series on the road in Cleveland tomorrow night in their first game after the trade deadline, followed by a 3-game set in Detroit. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (52-45, 14-13) were rained out last night in Amarillo (ARI) and play a doubleheader tonight against the Sod Poodles. Twins top prospect Walker Jenkins has four multi-hit games in his last nine, a stretch where he's 12-for-34 (.353). High-A Cedar Rapids (57-40) bounced back with a 7-3 win to even a series in Lansing (ATH). 20-year-old SS Brandon Winokur, the Twins' No. 12 prospect, has homered in back-to-back games and now has 14 round-trippers on the year. Low-A Fort Myers (43-53, 16-16) lost 4-3 last night in Bradenton (PIT) despite an 8-strikeout performance from 20-year-old RHP Adrian Bohorquez in 4.0 innings.

LAST APPEARANCE: Threw on Friday night vs Worcester at UHS Field. Pitching behind Major League rehabber Bailey Ober, made just his third career relief appearance and his first since August 26, 2022 with Low-A Fort Myers. Took over with the Saints trailing 1-0, and pitched around heavy traffic in all three innings of work. Used two double-play balls to limit the damage. Worked around two singles in the sixth before walking three in the seventh inning, including a third free pass that walked in a run. Struck out the nine-spot hitter and induced a double play ball out of Nate Eaton to get out of the jam and end the inning. Allowed three runs on a home run to Vaughn Grissom in the eighth. Threw 16 four-seamers (27%), 15 cutters (25%), 12 sweepers (20%), 8 curveballs (14%), 6 sinkers (10%) and 2 changeups (3%) while generating just six swings-and-misses, snapping a streak of 9+ whiffs in ten straight outings. Recorded two of his three punchouts on the curveball and one on the cutter.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: Raya etched his name into Saints history in his start on May 24 vs Norfolk. After entering play with an ERA north of 12.00 on the season and more walks than strikeouts, he came out and struck out the first six batters he faced, becoming the third-ever Saints pitcher to go six up, six down all on the strikeout to start a game, joining Joe Ryan (Aug. 20, 2021 vs Iowa) and Bailey Ober (May 30, 2021 @Iowa). He came one shy of the franchise record of 7 K's in-a-row at any point in a game, a record held by David Festa (set on May 25, 2024 @BUF). Raya was also perfect through the first four innings of the game before reaching his pitch count, marking just the third time that the Saints took a perfect game bid through four innings (Mario Sanchez went 13 up-13 down to start on June 26, 2022 @Buffalo & Simeon Woods Richardson went 12 up-12 down on April 28, 2023 @Rochester). The Saints bullpen promptly followed his start with a leadoff walk in the fifth in a game the Saints would go on to lose 12-1 in 7 innings.

YOUNG GUNS: After making St. Paul's Opening Day roster following one appearance with the Saints to end last season, Raya is one of just six pitchers aged 22-years or younger to begin the 2025 season on a Triple-A roster. At 22 years, 7 months, and 21 days as of Opening Day, Raya is more than five years younger than the average pitcher at the Triple-A level this season. A LONG WAIT: A fourth-round pick in 2020, Raya had to wait a while to make his professional debut. After entering the year as a 1st Team Preseason All-American, his senior season at United South High School in Laredo, Texas was limited to just 18.0 innings in which he struck out 36 batters. His final high school outing was a complete-game, one-hit shutout. However due to the COVID-19 shutdown, followed by a right rotator cuff strain, Raya threw his first professional pitch on April 12, 2022, 670 days after hearing the Twins call his name in the Draft.

THAT'S MARK, WITH A K: Raya, who's full legal name is Marco Antonio Raya, goes by Mark, despite not having a "K" in his legal name. He said you'd have to ask his dad as to why --- he's listed as "Marco" everywhere on Major League Baseball's websites.

GOOD GENES: Athletes run in the Raya family. Mark's mother played college tennis, his father played baseball at Nixon, while his sister made it to regionals as a junior and senior at United South HS in hurdles. Raya's brother also holds the Texas A&M International career strikeout record (127) despite only pitching two years for the Dustdevils in Division 2.
