**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** RHP **Dominic Hamel** struck out 10 batters over six innings, allowing one unearned run and OF **Stanley Consuegra** doubled twice and scored twice in Brooklyn's 6-2 victory Saturday night over Greensboro to take a three games to two series lead. The Cyclones bullpen allowed one run over three innings en route to locking down the victory. Along with Consuegra, OF **Alex Ramirez**, 1B **JT Schwartz**, and INF **Jose Peroza** each collected two hits. C **Nic Gaddis** banged his sixth home run of the season. Brooklyn bats ran starter RHP **Justin Meis** from the game after just 2 2/3 innings.

**SMALL VICTORIES:** With a win today, Brooklyn can clinch the only series of the season against Greensboro. The Cyclones last won a series against Jersey Shore June 21-June 26.

**GIL HODGES DAY:** The Brooklyn Cyclones are celebrating Gil Hodges Day at Maimonides Park with the Hodges Family. The first 1,000 fans in attendance receive a Gil Hodges Statue commemorating his recent induction into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown which takes place next Sunday, July 24th. Hodges played and won a World Series with the Dodgers in 1955 and managed the New York Mets to their first World Series in 1969.

**CARSON COLLECTS 11 Ks:** RHP **Carson Seymour** struck out 11 batters Friday night, becoming the ninth pitcher in Brooklyn Cyclones history to fan 11 batters. It's the first time a Cyclones arm has struck out 11 hitters since 2016 when LHP **Thomas Szapucki** achieved the feat on August 6th at Tri-City. That year, three Cyclones struck out 11 batters between July 23-August 6: RHP **Nabil Crismatt** vs. Aberdeen, RHP **Harol Gonzalez** at Vermont, and LHP **Thomas Szapucki** at Tri-City.

**CON SWAGGER:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** has had a dominant start to his Brooklyn career, collecting

**vs. GREENSBORO:** The Pittsburgh Pirates affiliate comes to Maimonides Park, setting up a match-up with Brooklyn for the first time in team history. Greensboro is in the North Division and hosts three of Pittsburgh's Top 30 prospects including former Mets minor leaguer No. 6 C Endy Rodriguez. He is joined by No. 11 RHP Jared Jones and No. 19 OF Hudson Head. The Grasshoppers play at First National Bank Field in Greensboro, North Carolina.

seven doubles in 11 games with nine RBIs. Consuegra went 4-for-5 on Wednesday with a home run and a career-high three doubles in the 9-0 victory over Greensboro.

**NIC KNOWS:** C **Nic Gaddis** has enjoyed a power play stretch at the plate, homering four times in his past 14 games with a .545 slugging percentage. Since June 21, Gaddis has a .425 OBP and a .970 OPS, reaching in 19 of his past 21 games.

**PEROZA POP:** INF **Jose Peroza** has collected 32 total bases in his past 15 games with four doubles, one triple, and three home runs.

**BOMBOSAS:** Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 42 home runs in the past 52 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

**PROSPECT POP:** Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offensively, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF **Jaylen Palmer**, No. 19 prospect 1B **JT Schwartz**, and No. 29 prospect INF **Jose Peroza**. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP **Dominic Hamel**, No. 16 prospect RHP **Junior Santos**, and No. 21 prospect **Mike Vasil**.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Santos turned in his seventh-straight start lasting for five or more innings. Santos began the year pitching five innings just twice in his first nine starts.

**HIGH-RANKING MEMBER:** Santos ranks as the top pitching prospect on the staff, ranking No. 16 according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 17 according to *Baseball America*.

**BREAKOUT:** The 20 year old pitched with Low-A St. Lucie in 2021, tossing 96 innings which doubles the workload he turned in in 2019 (40.2 IP) and 2018 (45). This season marks the second full season assignment for the righty.

**VALUED MEMBER:** Santos signed with the Mets in 2018 for \$275,000 out of Santiago in the Dominican Republic.

**WEIRD START:** Santos struggled in his first start of 2022, lasting just two innings in game one of a doubleheader and 5-1 loss to the Wilmington Blue Rocks on April 9. Santos’ clunky start may have been affected by Friday night’s postponement. Ready, warming up, and tossing in the outfield minutes before schedule first pitch on Friday, Santos had to shut it down and repeat the process on Saturday after the Cyclones-Blue Rocks game was postponed due to soft infield dirt and “wet grounds.”

**OPENING DAY STARTER:** Junior Santos made Brooklyn’s Opening Day start in Wilmington, Delaware on Saturday evening. It was Santos’ fourth Opening Day and first Opening Day start since 2018 when he pitched for the DSL Mets against the DSL Angels. In that outing, he struck out six over three innings of one-run ball.
