SUNDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats were defeated by the Portland Sea Dogs on Sunday night, falling 12-5 at Delta Dental Stadium and dropping the series to the Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. In his Fisher Cats debut, starting right-hander Alek Manoah threw five strong innings, allowing one run on three hits and three walks while striking out 10 in a no-decision on 82 pitches (47 strikes). The 2022 American League All-Star and Cy Young Award finalist gave up a run in the second but eventually settled down and struck out seven of his last 10 hitters faced, including striking out the side in the fourth. At one point, he retired nine in a row, eight via the strikeout. With Portland leading 2-1 in the bottom of the sixth, New Hampshire plated home four runs on an RBI single by Will Robertson, a bases loaded walk by Steward Berroa and a two-run single by Leo Jimenez to take a 5-2 lead. Portland answered with three in the seventh as Red Sox top prospect Marcelo Mayer tied the score 5-5 on an RBI single to right-field. The Sea Dogs erupted for seven runs in the eighth off left-hander Mason Fluharty and right-hander T.J. Brock with Alex Binelas and Niko Kavadas both hitting homers, two of three hit by Portland on the night. Mayer, Kavadas and Binelas all had three RBI games. Jimenez and Berroa led the way for the Fisher Cats with two RBIs each, including a solo homer by Berroa in the fifth, his fourth homer of the season. Orelvis Martinez, Trevor Schwecke and Rainer Nunez all collected two hits each with Nunez extending his hit streak to six consecutive games.

QUITE THE DEBUT: Alek Manoah's 10 strikeouts last night were a new season-high by a Fisher Cat this year and the most recorded by a Fisher Cat pitcher since July 23, 2022 when Adam Kloffenstein struck out 10 also against Portland. It's the first time Manoah has struck out 10 or more batters in a game since Oct. 2, 2021 when he struck out 10 Orioles in seven innings. The 2022 AL All-Star, First-Team All-MLB First Team selection, and AL Cy Young finalist has joined the likes of many Toronto Blue Jays players who have been sent to play games in New Hampshire that includes Jose Bautista, A. J. Burnett, Edwin Encarnacion, Lourdes Gurriel Jr., Adam Lind, Lyle Overbay, Ricky Romero, and Victor Zambrano.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: Orelvis Martinez has been much more patient at the plate this year than last. The Blue Jays No. 4 prospect has 36 walks on the season in 66 games played – he had just 40 walks last year in 118 games played. June was his best month so far from a discipline standpoint, striking out only 14 times (fewest in a month) while walking 14 times. He continues to be among the Eastern League leaders in homers (3<sup>rd</sup>) and RBI (3<sup>rd</sup>).

IT'S BECAUSE HE GETS ON BASE: Orelvis Martinez and Leo Jimenez both currently have 13-game on-base streaks. For Martinez, it is his longest on-base streak of the season after his previous season-high was 12 straight games. Jimenez's season-long on-base streak is 18 games from May 23 to June 15

HAPPY BIRTHDAY Q!: RHP Luis Quinones will get the ball in the series finale after celebrating his 26th birthday yesterday. Quinones will make his third start of the year and his 18th overall appearance. His last start was one of his best outings of the season, striking out a season-high six in 3.2 innings at Harrisburg on June 10. Against Portland, Quinones has a 1.29 ERA in seven innings pitched this year.

BRING THE RAIN: 1B Rainer Nunez has had a productive series against Portland this week at Delta Dental Stadium in his first meeting against the Sea Dogs. The Blue Jays No. 29 prospect is 5-for-16 (.313) with a home run and is currently on his longest hit streak of the season at six consecutive games.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (July 3, 2010)- Eric Thames went 3-for-4 with a homer and six RBIs as the Fisher Cats rolled past the Rock Cats 15-7 to start a four-game win streak. For Thames, it was his 14<sup>th</sup> homer, and Shawn Bowman added his 13th. The next night, July 4, the Fisher Cats would win again as Kyle Drabek tossed a no-hitter.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Red Sox completed a sweep of the Blue Jays (45-40). Alex Verdugo hit the first pitch of the ninth from Jordan Romano out of the park for a game-winning home run. Brandon Belt homered twice and Bo Bichette knocked in the other two runs with a single in the third. Toronto opens a series in Chicago against the White Sox tomorrow night...Buffalo (36-43) was rained out with Worcester. The teams will finish the series tonight...Vancouver (44-30) lost Sunday afternoon at home to Spokane 8-6. Garrett Spain went 3-for-5 with 2 RBI...Dunedin (37-37) won 2-1 in 11 innings at St. Lucie.

**COMING UP:** The Fisher Cats hit the road tomorrow to face the Hartford Yard Goats for a six game road trip. After a four day All-Star break, New Hampshire will return home for a three-game series against the Altoona Curve beginning on Friday,
