YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 4-1, snapping their six-game win streak. In the top of the first, Zach Watson gave the Baysox a 1-0 lead with an RBI single, snapping **Mason Black's** scoreless streak at 23.0 innings. In the bottom of the first, **Vaun Brown** tied the game with a solo homer. Bowie took a 2-1 lead in the fourth with an RBI single by Joseph Rosa and he added a sac fly in the sixth to extend the lead to 3-1. Tim Susnara opened a 4-1 Baysox lead with a sac fly in the eighth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Flying Squirrels won four-of-five at Prince George's Stadium from April 25-29, with the finale postponed until June for rain. In their series in Bowie from June 13-18, the Baysox won four-of-seven. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will play a six-game series against the Baysox at The Diamond from August 8-13.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 14-3 in their last 17 games since June 18, including taking five-of-six in last week's series at Reading to open the second half of the season. They won six straight from June 23 through Friday, their longest winning streak since a seven-game stretch from April 28-May 5, 2022, and matched that streak with six consecutive wins from July 1-6. Over the last 17 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .263 (145-for-552) with 21 homers, 28 doubles and have scored 97 runs. In that same stretch, the Richmond pitching staff has a 2.62 ERA (44 ER/151.0 IP), the best in the league, with 197 strikeouts. Over the last 22 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined to go 2-2 with a 2.09 ERA (18 ER/77.1 IP). For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.65 ERA is the best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 281.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 402.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.24 ERA, which is second-lowest in Double-A and the sixth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE BAYSOX opened the second half dropping four-of-six in last week's series against the Patriots. They are 3-8 in their last 11 games since June 25. Bowie's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including 3B Coby Mayo (No. 9), LHP Cade Povich (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 13), RHP Chayce McDermott (No. 15), OF John Rhodes (No. 26) and RHP Jean Pinto (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes Mayo (No. 7), Povich (No. 11), Fabian (No. 15), McDermott (No. 17) and Rhodes (No. 19).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Ryan Murphy** makes his 15th start of the season and his third against the Baysox. He pitched twice in last week's series at Reading, starting the series with four perfect innings last Wednesday with five strikeouts. Murphy started the series finale on Monday and allowed one run over 3.2 innings. He faced the Baysox on April 29 at Prince George's Stadium and worked four innings, allowing two runs in a no-decision. He was handed a loss at Bowie on June 15 after giving up two runs in four innings. Over his last six starts since June 4, Murphy has gone 0-2 with a 2.42 ERA (6 ER/22.1 IP). Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 27 Giants prospect and No. 25 by MLB.com. *For more on Murphy, see page two.*

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander Cade Povich makes his 16th start of the season and his third against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Monday against the Patriots and allowed three runs over six innings with eight strikeouts in a no-decision. Povich faced the Flying Squirrels on April 29 at Prince George's Stadium and threw five scoreless innings with 10 strikeouts. On June 15 in Bowie, he threw six perfect innings before **Wade Meckler** led off the seventh with a single. It was the only baserunner Povich allowed over seven scoreless innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts, which is tied for the most by a pitcher in the Eastern League this season. He was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for his performance. It was also the most strikeouts by a Baysox pitcher in a game since Rahadames Liz struck out 14 against the Connecticut Defenders on August 14, 2007. In his two starts against the Flying Squirrels, he has worked 13 scoreless innings with 23 strikeouts. This year, Povich leads the Eastern League in strikeouts (99), strikeout percentage (34.3) and K/9 (13.43). Povich was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round (98th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Nebraska. He was traded to the Orioles on August 2, 2022 along with three other pitchers for RHP Jorge Lopez. Povich is rated by Baseball America as the No. 10 Orioles prospect and No. 11 by MLB.com.

HOT SQUIRRELS SUMMER: The Flying Squirrels have gone 14-3 over their last 17 games, which is tied for the second-best record over a 17-game span in franchise history. It is even with a 14-3 stretch from April 15-May 3, 2010 and another from May 24-June 10, 2015. It is one game behind a 15-2 span from July 28-August 16, 2013. The 2013 team lost games on each end of that stretch, making 15-3 the team's best record in an 18-game span in franchise history. Their 12-1 record prior to Friday's loss was the best 13-game run in franchise history. On a technicality, the 2013 team went 12-1 in 13 games and 16-2 in 18 games, but had a game suspended prior to that window from July 21 that was completed on August 16, a 6-5, walk-off win over the Baysox. Although that game was played within the timeframe of the hot streak, the record reverted back to July 21. The Flying Squirrels' 12-2 record over the last 14 games is also tied for the best in team history, even with runs in 2013 and 2014.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, the Flying Squirrels are again at the top of the level in average attendance (6,492) and total attendance (266,171). The team's average attendance is the 13th-highest among the 120 MiLB teams.

RETURN OF THE MECK: On Friday, **Wade Meckler** went 0-for-4, snapping his 24-game on-base streak. It was the longest on-base streak to begin a Double-A career in Flying Squirrels history, passing the previous record set by **Luis Matos** (17 games) earlier this season. It was also tied for the ninth-longest on-base streak in franchise history. Meckler also saw his 11-game run scored streak end, which was a Flying Squirrels franchise record, passing the previous mark of nine straight games by Tyler LaTorie in 2014. In Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 23, Meckler tied the single-game franchise record for hits, going 5-for-5 and capping the night with a two-run, walk-off single for a 9-8 win over the Senators. For the season, Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 200 PA) in batting average (.404) and on-base percentage (.473). He leads the Eastern League (min. 100 PA) in on-base percentage (.457) and is tied for first in batting average (.364).

VAUN GONE WILD: **Vaun Brown** is riding an 11-game hitting streak since June 22, which one game shy of matching **Carter Williams** (12 games) for the longest hit streak by a Richmond player this season. It is also the longest active hit streak in the Eastern League and tied for second-longest in Double-A. In his last 11 games, Brown is batting .354 (17-for-48) with five homers, four doubles, 16 RBIs, 10 runs scored and no walks. Brown homered in back-to-back games on June 28 and 29 at Reading, totaling six RBIs in the two games. This week, he hit a three-run homer on Tuesday and added a solo shot on Friday. Brown has seven RBIs in his three games played this week against the Baysox.

ALL ABOARD THE SHANE TRAIN: **Shane Matheny** has reached base in 16 consecutive games dating back to June 18. For that stretch, he is batting .310 (18-for-58) with six doubles, two homers and 11 RBIs, adding seven walks. He has hit safely in six consecutive games since last Saturday, batting .348 (8-for-23) with two RBIs since the calendar flipped to July. Matheny also hit solo homers in back-to-back games on Tuesday and Wednesday to begin this week's series. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 102 walks, which is the fifth-most in franchise history. He is two behind fourth-place **Skylar Stromsmoe** (104). His .362 career on-base percentage is tied for third-highest in Flying Squirrels franchise history (min. 600 PA).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: **Andy Thomas** has picked up 13 RBIs over his last 11 games since June 24. From June 24-29, he collected nine RBIs over a four-game span, including a two-run homer on June 29 night at Reading. Last Sunday night, he added a sac fly and a solo homer. In his last 11 games, Thomas is batting .342 (14-for-41) with two homers, three doubles, a triple and 13 RBIs. For the season, he leads the Flying Squirrels with 40 RBIs. His season-high 10-game hit streak was snapped on Friday night.

I LOVE LUCI: In his last 11 games since June 23, **Marco Luciano** is batting .359 (14-for-39) with two homers, five doubles, seven RBIs and 11 runs scored. On June 24, he tied his career high in hits, going 4-for-4. On Tuesday, he hit his 11th Double-A homer, a solo shot in the eighth inning. Luciano has scored a run in four straight games, tied for the second-longest active streak in the Eastern League.

THE FUTURE IS NOW: Flying Squirrels pitcher **Carson Whisenhunt** is set to pitch in tonight's SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Seattle's T-Mobile Park. The Futures Game showcases 50 of baseball's top prospects each year. Whisenhunt and former Flying Squirrels pitcher **Kyle Harrison** will be representing the Giants. Harrison also pitched in last year's Futures Game at Dodger Stadium. Jackson Holliday and former Baysox Heston Kjerstad will represent the Orioles. Former Flying Squirrels pitcher **Dan Otero** is a member of the National League team's coaching staff. The seven-inning game is set to begin at 7 p.m. ET and will air on Peacock and SiriusXM. Whisenhunt is the sixth player to participate in the Futures Game as a member of the Flying Squirrels, including **Tommy Joseph** (2012), **Tyler Beede** (2015), **Shaun Anderson** (2018), **Heliot Ramos** (2021) and Harrison (2022). Other players who were selected for the Futures Game before or after playing in Richmond include **Collin Balester** (2007), **Gary Brown** (2011), **Kyle Crick** (2013), **Jorge Guzman** (2018), **Kieran Lovegrove** (2018), **Luis Alexander Basabe** (2018), **Joey Bart** (2019), **Marco Luciano** (2019) and **David Villar** (2022). Ramos also went to the Futures Game twice (2018 and 2019) before being selected a third time as a member of the Flying Squirrels in 2021. Villar was picked in 2022 but was not eligible because he was in the majors at the time.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 2), LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 6), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 8), RHP **Mason Black** (No. 9), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 14), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 15), OF **Wade Meckler** (No. 16), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 27) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Luciano as the best power hitter, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. Luciano is also ranked as Baseball America's No. 55-overall prospect. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes nine Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2), Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29). Luciano is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in baseball.
