### RIDERS HOLD OFF HOOKS IN OPENER:

Kellen Strahm reached base three times, scored twice and threw out a runner at home from center field to help the Frisco RoughRiders preserve a 3-2 win over the Corpus Christi Hooks on Tuesday at Riders Field. Corpus Christi (25-27, 58-63) nearly canceled out a 3-0 deficit in the sixth inning but Strahm's throw from center field on a base hit prevented the tying run from scoring. The RoughRiders (28-24, 59-61) had taken the lead in the first inning when Strahm and **Trevor Hauver** scored on **Liam Hicks'** double. **Noah Bremer** (1-2) spun five shutout innings in his start for Frisco, allowing just two hits and earning the win. He struck out four and walked one. After missing last season due to injury, Bremer earned his first win at the Double-A level since Sept. 9, 2021. Bremer has now allowed just two earned runs in his last three starts at Riders Field. He tied his season high on Tuesday with five innings and threw 78 pitches. **Grant Wolfram** struck out five batters in a hitless and scoreless 1.2 innings of relief. **Antoine Kelly** pitched the final two innings without a hit, striking out four and earning the save. The Riders scored in the first inning for the fourth consecutive game when Hicks laced a ball up the left field line for a two-run double. Hauver had doubled earlier in the inning for his team-leading 22nd double. **Aaron Zavala** picked up an RBI on a base hit up the middle in the fifth inning, extending the lead to 3-0 and scoring Strahm scored for the second time. Strahm reached three times on Tuesday with a walk, a hit by pitch and a single. Angel Macuare (1-3) took the loss for Corpus, giving up two runs over four innings.

### **DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:**

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in each of the last four games. The Riders lead the Texas League in first-inning runs with 94 over their 120 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .273/.367/.442/.809 in the first inning with14 home runs.

### WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 605 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .358 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. In the six games in Midland, the Riders walked 38 times (6.3 per game) with **Chris Seise**, **Trevor Hauver** and **David Garcia** leading the way with five.

### HE'S DOING BIG(GERS) THINGS:

RoughRiders infielder **Jax Biggers** has been showing off in the power department this season for Frisco. Entering 2023, his career high in home runs was four and on Wednesday, he hit his 11th long ball of the season. In his last 27 games, he has clubbed six homers while hitting .294 (30-for-102)/.410/.539/.949 with three doubles, one triple, six home runs, 17 RBIs, 19 walks and 19 runs scored. In August, he has a .928 OPS, which leads the team.

### NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 25 games in August, (13-12 record) the RoughRiders are second in the Texas League with a 3.98 ERA while allowing a league-low 18 home runs. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant two Tuesdays ago in Corpus, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. **Nick Krauth** then followed up with a second quality start, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when **Owen White** and **Jack Leiter** completed the feat. On the offensive side in the month, Frisco is second-to-last in the Texas League with a .725 OPS and tied for last in runs per game with 4.7 per contest.

### HAUV YOURSELF A YEAR:

**Trevor Hauver** has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 54 games since, he is batting .292/.408/.465/.873 with 15 doubles, six home runs, 31 RBIs and 41 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 40 points and his OPS 90 points.

### HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 34 games, Hicks is batting .322 (37-for-115)/.437/.426/.863 with seven doubles, a triple, a home run, 20 RBIs, 21 walks and 15 runs scored. In his last 21 games, he is batting .333 (23-for-69) with a .883 OPS.

#### K'S BY KELLY:

Rough Riders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on August 17th in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all 11 save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (3) and Evan Carter). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ABOUT DANE								

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 5-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

-Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign.

-For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVIDshortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schrines College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.

-Acker was taken by the Oakland Athletics in the 4th round of the 2020 draft, one pick after Braves pitcher Spencer Strider.

### 2023 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com entering the season.

-In Double-A debut at San Antonio on July 3rd, allowed two-run inside the park homer in the third inning to Juan Fernandez, but struck out five.

-When he was promoted to Double-A Frisco on July 3rd, Acker had just thrown 53.1 career MiLB innings over 17 games with only 50.1 innings and 12 games in affiliated ball above the Rookie level.

-Finished out High-A time with a 1.65 ERA (3ER/16.1IP) in June.

-Induced ground balls at a 46.9% rate with High-A Hickory over his six starts.

-Earned first career MiLB win with five strong innings against San Antonio on July 18th.

### 2022 SEASON

-Acker returned from rehab in mid-July, throwing in the Arizona League before making four starts with Hickory, debuting with the Crawdads on August 21st.

-After the season, Acker participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.

### 2021 SEASON

-After trade to Rangers, Acker made two starts with the Down East Wood Ducks before his second ended with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Traded from the Oakland Athletics along with OF Khris Davis and C Jonah Heim in exchange for INF Elvis Andrus and C Aramis Garcia and cash on February 6th, 2021.
