LAST TIME OUT: The St. Paul Saints squandered their chances with runners on for a second straight game as they dropped the series finale 3-2 to the Columbus Clippers on Sunday afternoon at CHS Field. The Saints loaded the bases in the first, but managed just one run when Matt Wallner hit into a sacrifice fly double play. Columbus tied it up in the second when Dayan Fries drew a bases loaded walk off Taj Bradley. The Twins rehabber would strike out the next batter he faced, exit after 1.2 innings reaching his pitch count, and make way for Raul Brito, who stranded the bases loaded to keep it at 1-1. Brito would go 2.1 scoreless before handing the ball to John Klein, who was even more dominant, going 3.0 shutout and facing one over the minimum. The Saints retook the lead when Mendez hit an RBI single with two out in the fifth, but squandered a bases-loaded, nobody out chance in the sixth. That proved costly as the Clippers rallied for two runs off Grant Hartwig in the eighth and hung on.

RISP MANAGEMENT: The Saints are coming off a series split against Columbus, a six-game slate in which they held a lead in every game. The Saints took a 3-1 series lead following just their second-ever doubleheader sweep as a franchise (and their first since 2021) on Friday, before letting leads slip on both Saturday and Sunday. Across the last two games, the Saints have had traffic on the bases in 15 of their 18 offensive half-innings, including the leadoff man on in 11 of them. The Saints have combined to go just 4-for-29 (.138) with runners in scoring position over those two games. On the season as a whole, the Saints have hit .266 (108-406), ranking 6th in the International League.

SAINTLY SLUGGERS: After blasting a ridiculous 24 home runs in a seven-game span from May 2-9, the Saints have hit just five round-trippers in their last seven games since then and have been overtaken by the Charlotte Knights for the most homers in baseball. Over their last 13 contests (circa May 2), the Saints rank t-3rd in MLB/MiLB in homers (29), 2nd in team SLG% (.585) and team OPS (1.007), and are 5th in runs scored (115, 8.8/gm). The Saints have homered in 24 of their past 31 games and have not gone back-to-back games without a homer since April 10-11 in Toledo. The Saints currently tout eight hitters with at least five homers on the season, tied with Louisville for the most of any team in MLB or MiLB.

THE SAINTS ARE HOT: Despite back-to-back losses, something the Saints had not done since dropping four-in-a-row from April 21-24 in Indianapolis, St. Paul are still 14-6 over their past 20 games since April 25, holding the best record in Triple-A and the 7th best among all full-season MiLB clubs over that time. During the run, the Saints have outscored their opponents 143-98 (+45) after they were a -38 (112-150) over their first 24 games to start the season in which they went 9-15. Over their last 20 games, St. Paul rank 2nd in the Int'l League in AVG, OPS, and runs. Despite an ERA that ranks 8th, their SO:BB ratio is 4th in the Int'l League.

GABBY'S GOT A BRAND NEW BAG: Gabriel Gonzalez brings a four-game hit streak into Tuesday, a stretch where the 21-year-old is 8-for-13 with 2 XBH and three walks. Before Friday's doubleheader, he did not have back-to-back multi-hit games in his first 38 games to start the season. Between Friday and Saturday, he produced three straight multi-hit games. Gonzalez had entered play Friday mired in a slump where he was 5-last-54 (.093), including an 0-for-25 skid in the middle. The Twins' No. 7 prospect raised his average has raised his average 34 points the last four games (.174 > .208). Gonzalez is a year removed from leading the Twins system with a .329 average between three levels and is currently on pace for a career-high 27 home runs.

LEADING OFF WITH A BANG: After most recently adding an inning-opening blast to their ledger on Friday, the Saints are tied with their parent club for the most in baseball with 21 homers to lead off innings this year. Kaelen Culpepper (5), Orlando Arcia (4), Aaron Sabato (3), Alex Jackson (2), and Emmanuel Rodriguez (2) have all touched off for at least two home runs to lead off an inning each this year, with Culpepper three times leading off with home runs to start the day offensively for St. Paul.

LOWERTOWN LAUNCH PAD: Entering play Tuesday, CHS Field ranks 2nd among all full-season MiLB parks in combined OPS this season (.908 between the Saints and their opponents). The 88 homers featured in St. Paul already are the 3rd-most at an MiLB venue this year, trailing only Truist Field in Charlotte (110) & Louisville Slugger Field (92). Last Wednesday's game snapped a streak of 21 games-in-a-row featuring at least one homer from either team in Lowertown dating back to last season (the longest CHS Field homer streak is 47 consecutive games from Sept. 22, 2023-July 24, 2024). Over the previous five years (2021-25), the Saints' home ranked 3rd (.795) among IL ballparks in combined OPS, behind only Truist Field (CLT) & Werner Park (OMA) and 5th in the league in home runs (966), trailing Syracuse, Omaha, Durham, & Charlotte's parks.

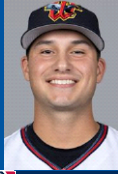

LAST APPEARANCE: Started Friday in Game 1 of a doubleheader against Columbus...retired six-in-a-row to start before allowing a leadoff double to Dom Nunez in the third...faced three over the minimum over his 4.0 scoreless frames...threw 20 four-seamers (31%), 17 changeups (27%), 16 curveballs (25%), 8 sliders (13%), and 3 sinkers (5%)...generated seven swings-and-misses, four on the curveball...

MIKE THE INVINCIBLE: Paredes had a unique statline last season, going 11-0 across his 37 appearances (2 starts) with Double-A Wichita, plus one relief outing with the Saints to end the year. After pitching in his Triple-A debut to end the season on Sept. 19 in Memphis and getting a no-decision, he ensured just the 15th season in the last 20 years in all of minor league baseball where a pitcher racked up double-digit wins without a loss in the same season. It was just the sixth season in that span in which a pitcher accrued at least 11 wins without a losing decision, the first since Luis Quinones went 11-0 in the Blue Jays system in 2024. Paredes' season in which he pitched 35 of 37 games in relief also featured 7 saves; there have only been 17 seasons of 10+ wins and 7+ saves in the minors since 2005. Paredes had pitched in 46 consecutive games without a losing decision (13 wins in that stretch) until he was saddled with a loss in his final appearance with Double-A Wichita on April 16 before a promotion to the Saints.

SALUTATIONS, MICHAEL: A native of San Diego and graduate of San Diego HS, Paredes was SDHS's 2018 salutatorian, awarded to the student with the 2nd-highest Grade Point Average in their graduating class. He was a member of the Academy of Finance for one of his high school extracurriculars and went on to be named a 2020 Mountain West All-Academic selection as a business management major at SDSU.

CAREER NOTES

• Entering 2026, owns a 6.0% walk-rate the past four years dating back to his first full-season in the minors, the 3rd-lowest rate in the Twins system (trailing only Zebby Matthews-3.2% & Pierson Ohl-3.6%, min. 200 IP)

- Spent majority of the season with Double-A Wichita before being called up for one final appearance to close the season with the Saints for his Triple-A debut
- Went 11-0 on the year between the Wind Surge & Saints, becoming just the 15th pitcher in the last 20 years in MiLB to accrue double-digit wins without a loss in a single-season (just the sixth in that span w/ at least 11 wins & zero losses)
- In Double-A, went 11-0, 2.43 ERA (28 ER, 105.2 IP) with 28 walks (6.6 BB%) and 91 strikeouts (21.7 K%)...did not allow a run in 21 of his 37 appearances and 2 runs or fewer in 34 games...went at least 2.0 IP in all but one appearance
- Fired 20.2 innings without an earned run allowed to start the year (an unearned run in his fourth game on 4/17 snapped a 9.1 inning scoreless streak overall)
- Fired 11.0-consecutive scoreless innings from Aug. 23-Sept. 12 to end the Double-A season...extended it to 13.0 straight after his scoreless app. with Saints
- Called up for his Triple-A debut on Sept. 19 @Memphis...threw 2.0 scoreless innings of relief...struck out the Redbirds' Michael Siani for his first punchout at the level to end the game, a 7-3 Saints victory in the penultimate contest of the year

Cracked 2 HR on 5/3 vIOW, his 6th career multi-HR game as a pro...collected a hit in five consecutive AB's from May 2-3 vIOW (HR in final 2 AB of 5/2, hits in first 3 5/3)... Hit safely in 15 straight games from April 24-May 13 (28-64, .438, 5 HR, 10 XBH, 15 RBI), the longest for a Saints hitter on the season at the time...blasted 2 HR, his 7th career multi-HR game, and went 4-for-5, 5 RBI on 5/8 @Las Vegas to extend hit streak to 12 games in-a-row...
