

#### LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped both legs of yesterday's double-header with hte Altoona Curve. In the first game, Bowie fell 3-2, as a three-run third inning did all the damage for Altoona. Lolo Sanchez hit a two-run single in the frame, before Jacob Gonzalez hit a sacrifice fly to drive a run home with the bases loaded. Left-handed starter Cade Povich threw 34 pitches and was only able to record two outs in the inning, ending his day after just 2.2 innings. Tim Susnara laced an early RBI double in the second and Jud Fabian hit his first Double-A home run - a solo shot in the sixth, but Bowie was unable to fight all the way back in the seven-inning affair. In game two, the Baysox fell 1-0. The Curve's Liover Peguero provided all the offense in this one with a leadoff home run in the first. Right-handed starter Conor Gillispie then retired the next 18 batters in a row to end the game, including five strikeouts. Bowie, however, mustered just three hits of their own, as the Baysox were shutout for the third time this season in the defaat.

## **TODAY'S OPPONENT**

The Altoona Curve enter tonight's matchup with a record of 33-31 - second place in the Eastern League Southwest division and 2.5 games behind first place Erie with four games to play in the first half. This is already the third matchup between the Curve and Baysox this season, with Altoona holding the 9-5 edge in the season series, including winning four of five at People's Natural Gas Field in April. The Curve are coming off a series in which they lost five of six on the road against Somerset. Altoona is a tough team to strike out, as the Curve have the fewest strikeouts (518) in Double-A, and fifth-fewest in Minor League Baseball. Altoona's roster is headlined by five of the Pirates' top 30 prospects, via MLB Pipeline - SS Liover Peguero (No. 6 PIT), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 9 PIT), OF Matt Gorski (No. 15 PIT), OF Matt Frazier (No. 21 PIT), and RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 29 PIT).

## **TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER**

Altoona looks to start right-hander Sean Sullivan this evening. Sullivan's 2.87 ERA would be third-best in the Eastern League if he qualified, but the right-hander has 47 innings through 10 starts this season. Sullivan has controlled the zone well, with just 15 walks across those 47 frames in 2023. Sullivan lasted just 3.1 innings in his most recent start this past Friday in Somerset, where he allowed a run on four hits with two walks and three strikeouts, in his first start since a stint on the seven-day injured list. Sullivan has two prior starts against the Baysox this season. He has allowed just two earned runs through a combined 10.1 innings, with four hits, five walks, and six strikeouts. An 8th round draft pick of the Pirates in 2021 from the University of California, Berkeley, the right-hander features a low-90s tailing fastball, alongside a mid-80s changeup and slider.

## THE A-MAYO-ZING COBY

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo sits second at the Double-A level with 22 doubles, while his 36 extra-base hits lead Double-A and are the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball. The No. 8 Orioles'/ No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, did see his nine-game hitting streak and 33-game on-base streak come to a close in game one of yesterday's doubleheader, but continues to have success against Curve pitching. Mayo is hitting .298 against Altoona this season, with four of his 12 home runs launched against Altoona, including three at PNG Field. Mayo sits third in the league with a .418 on-base percentage, is second with a .571 slugging percentage, and leads the league with a .989 OPS.

## LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook is enjoying one of the hottest stretches of his professional career. Cook has hits in 14 of 15 games for the first time in his minor league career, including five straight. He's hitting .333 (19-for-57) in that stretch with six doubles and three home runs. Cook has bounced back nicely in 2023, hitting .301 with 19 extra-base hits over the past two months, after hitting just .103 with one extra-base hit in the month of April.

## **DOUBLEHEADER DOWNERS**

The Baysox have struggled in twin bills thus far in 2023. Yesterday was the second time Bowie has dropped both legs of a twin bill this season, moving them to 1-5 overall. In particular, the Baysox have struggled to get the bats going in doubleheaders. Two of the three times the Baysox have been shut out this season have come as part of a doubleheader, while Bowie is averaging just 1.3 runs per game in doubleheader contests overall.

## **AVOIDING THE TRAFFIC**

Both teams this week have had opportunities with base runners, but struggled with consistent execution. The Baysox hold a .236 average with runners in scoring position - seventh in the Eastern League, while the Curve's .227 average in such situations is tied for the second-lowest in the league. With two outs, the struggles only grow, as Bowie (.216) and Altoona (.180) hold the worst averages with runners in scoring position in the league. In fact, Altoona has the third-lowest such average in Minor League Baseball. This week, the Curve are 3-for-17 (.176) with runners in scoring position, while the Baysox are just 1-for-17 (.059)







#### **COACHING STAFF**

#### Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 14-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the heim of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles sys-tem. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlanic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Battimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron. Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's Japlaying career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Priching Coach - Forrest Herrmann Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitch-ing coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization, Hermann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Hermann also worked with current Orioles left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Hermann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox develo-other filling the same role for Aberdean last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time n 2021.
