JACKSONVILLE SPLIT SERIES WITH DURHAM

After falling behind early, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell to the Durham Bulls 10-2 Sunday, to split their six-game series. The Durham Bulls (35-28) struck first in the series. finale. Tanner Murray walked and Tristan Peters singled with one out in the fourth. With two runners on, Carson Williams (8) crushed a three-run blast, giving the Bulls an early lead against Jacksonville (37-26). After a five-run fifth for the Bulls, Jacksonville answered with two in the sixth. The Bulls put the nail in the coffin with a run in the seventh and eighth.

SUMMER DAYS DRIFTING AWAY

Jacksonville began the 2025 campaign on a tear posting a 21-8 record through the first 29 games of the season. After posting a Triple-A best, ERA (2.80), batting average against (.205) and tied for the best record (21-8), the Jumbo Shrimp have cooled off heading in to summer. In their last 34 games (May 1-present). Jacksonville is 16-18 and have a -36 run differential. Their, 645 OPS is the second-lowest in Triple-A while their 314 strikeouts is the seventh-most.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the season opener, Jacksonville has recorded a stolen base in 51 of their last 62 games, with multiple steals in 38 contests. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have eight games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. With a stolen base on Sunday, the Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A and are fourth in the minors with 141 steals.

EXIT (VELOCITY) STRATEGY

Jacksonville's biggest strength in 2025, along with stealing bases, has been its pitching and defense. The club ranks tied for second in Triple-A with a 3.70 ERA, and their 259 runs allowed are the third-fewest at the level. Interestingly, Jacksonville's staff ranks only 20th in Triple-A in strikeouts (537), but their 445 hits allowed are the level's fewest, meaning the club has supressed quite a few balls put in play. Opponents have mustered an average exit velocity of 87.1 against the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff, the fourth-lowest such mark in Triple-A

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD

Jacksonville's bullpen went nearly a week between earned runs, yielding three runs in the ninth inning of their May 24 contest against Memphis before a ninth-inning tally on Friday for Gwinnett. Over their last 13 games dating back to May 25, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to surrender 28 runs, 24 earned, on 47 hits in 57.2 innings for a 3.74 ERA. Jacksonville relievers have combined for 50 strikeouts against 28 walks during this stretch.

WALK IT OUT

Through 63 games thus far in 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp have totaled 227 free passes (3.6 BB/G). Jakob Marsee is tied for second in walks in the International League (41). Among the 109 qualified players in the circuit, Marsee ranks 10th in walk rate (16.1%). Including Marsee, Jacksonville has six other players scattered among the 106 other qualified players in walk rate in the IL. (Maximo Acosta, 11.1%; ; Jacob Berry, 8.8%; Troy Johnston, 7.6%; Andrew Pintar, 6.8%).

PITCH PERFECT

Jacksonville's 37 wins in 2025 can be attributed to the strength of their pitching staff. Not only is the staff tied for the second-best ERA in Triple-A (3.70), they've coupled that with the 11th-fewest strikeouts and tied for the fifth-fewest walks. The low strikeout number isn't necessarily troubling because the staff have thrown the third-fewest pitches per inning (16.27). Meaning, that opposing hitters don't draw a ton of three-ball counts, but they also don't drive up the pitch counts of Jacksonville hurlers. Jumbo Shrimp starters average 4.0 IP per contest and own a Triple-A-best 15.78 pitches per inning. In addition, the bullpen averages 4.2 IP per game and is third in Triple-A in pitches/inning (16.68) behind Durham (16.36) & Nashville (16.50).

SHRIMP BITES

Of the 369 pitchers in the IL with a minimum 10 IP, Jacksonville has three active pitchers in the top 100 of runners left on base percentage. Christian Roa 36th, 84.7%; John Rooney 46th, 83.3% and Adam Mazur 48th, 83.0%. Josh Simpson is making his second start for the Jumbo Shrimp today. Prior to this season, his last start came in 2021, where he made five in 19 appearances.
