YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Senators, 11-3, to open the series. The Flying Squirrels scored nine runs in the first two innings. In the top of the first, Victor Bericoto hit an RBI single, Diego Velasquez brought in a run reaching on an error, Vaun Brown hit a two-run single and Jimmy Glowenke brought him in t score to open a 5-0 lead. In the second, Velasquez knocked a two-run single and Zach Morgan hit a two-run homer, his first at Double-A, to extend the Richmond lead to 9-0. The Senators scored their only three runs on a pair of homers against Nick Sinacola, a solo shot by Jeremy De La Rosa in the fourth and a two-run homer by J.T. Arruda in the fifth. In the top of the sixth, Velasquez singled to pick up his fourth RBI of the game and another run scored on an error to open an 11-3 lead.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Harrisburg Senators in the second of a six-game series. In both previous six-game series between the two teams, they each won three games. The Flying Squirrels went 3-3 in Harrisburg from April 16-21. The Flying Squirrels won the first three games of a series at The Diamond from July 9-14 before the Senators took the final three games. This is the final series between the two teams this year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 6-3 in their last nine games since August 3, winning four straight prior to falling Friday night and in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader. Prior to that winning streak, they went 4-12 in their previous 16 games from July 13-August 2.

THE SENATORS are in last place in the Southwest Division second-half standings. In the first half, they finished in second place, one game behind Erie. Harrisburg's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including INF Yohandy Morales (No. 6), RHP Andry Lara (No. 15), OF Daylen Lile (No. 18), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 23) and RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 25). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects list includes eight Harrisburg players, including INF Yohandy Morales (No. 3), OF Daylen Lile (No. 8), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 15), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 17), INF Kevin Made (No. 19), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (No. 24), RHP Andry Lara (No. 25) and RHP Marquis Grissom (No. 26).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Dylan Cumming makes his eighth Double-A start and 13th appearance. Last time out, he allowed six runs on 11 hits in 3.1 innings in a loss against the Yard Goats. For the season, Cumming leads Giants minor leaguers in K/9 (11.34) and ranks second in strikeouts (110) and strikeout percentage (29.9%). Cumming began the year with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.87 ERA in nine games (seven starts). He was named the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month in April after going 1-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER/18.0 IP) in five games (four starts). On April 17 against Vancouver, Cumming started and threw three innings in a combined no-hitter with Nick Sinacola and Seth Cory. Cumming spent last year with Low-A San Jose in his professional debut season, going 7-3 with a 2.93 ERA in 34 games (seven starts). He worked as a reliever most of the season before making starts across July, August and September. Cumming began his collegiate career at Chicago State, where he pitched three seasons before the program was disbanded in 2020. He pitched his final two seasons at Liberty University in Lynchburg, Va., and was with the Burlington Sock Puppets in the 2022 summer, where he was selected as an Appalachian League All-Star. Cumming signed with the San Francisco Giants as a non-drafted free agent on February 25, 2023. For more on Cumming, see page two.

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Andry Lara makes his 15th Double-A start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. In his last start on Friday at Bowie, he was charged with a loss after allowing a season-high eight runs over two innings of work. On July 13 at The Diamond, Lara picked up a win after throwing six innings and allowing one run. He began the season with High-A Wilmington and went 2-4 with a 2.35 ERA in six starts before being promoted to Double-A on May 14. Lara signed with the Nationals as an international free agent in 2019. He spent all of last year in the South Atlantic League with Wilmington and went 6-8 with a 4.58 ERA in 23 starts.

GRAND LARCENY: On Tuesday night, the Flying Squirrels stole five bases in the first two innings of the series opener against the Senators. **Victor Bericoto** stole while **Diego Velasquez, Vaun Brown** and **Carter Howell** each picked up one. The five steals tied a season high for the Flying Squirrels, even with their August 4 game at Altoona. It was also tied for the fourth-most steals in a game in franchise history. The only games for the Flying Squirrels with more stolen bases were an eight-steal game over 13 innings on May 9, 2014 against the SeaWolves and two six-steal games, August 27, 2011 in 10 innings at Akron and June 5, 2014 against the Thunder. Tuesday was the sixth instance of the team stealing five bases in a game. Prior to the two five-steal games by Richmond this season the team's last five-steal game was in 2019. by Richmond this season, the team's last five-steal game was in 2019.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 74 double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Altoona is ranked second with 73. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 15 double plays this year, which is the most in the league, ahead of three pitchers tied for second with 11. It is also tied for the second-most in the minors. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. On July 10 against the Senators, **Seth Lonsway** induced three double plays, which is tied for the most by one pitcher in a game in the league this year. Bertrand matched that with three double plays behind him on July 19 against the RubberDucks.

TAKE THE JAIRO: In Saturday's doubleheader, **Jairo Pomares** drove in two of Richmond's three runs. In the second game, he lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 2-1 win in extras with a walk-off double. He was riding a six-game hitting streak prior to going hitless on Sunday afternoon. In his last eight games, he is batting .314 (11-for-35) with three doubles, a triple and eight RBIs while adding two stolen bases. For the season, Pomares is tied for seventh in the Giants organization with 10 homers and rankstied for sixth with 30 extra-base hits.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 48 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .313 (60-for-192) with four homers, 10 doubles, nine walks and 29 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on Friday night off the scoreboard in left-center. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 18-of-40 games dating back to June 15.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked ninth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,593), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

PROSPECT WATCH: Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 11) and SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features four Richmond players, including Brown (No. 14), Velasquez (No. 17), OF/IB **Victor Bericoto** (No. 18) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 11 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24) and Parker Dunshee (2023). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-22 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS: The have been 59 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which is one shy of the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 30 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by Andy Thomas on June 1 against the SeaWolves and Luis Toribio on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 30 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season. In last week's series at Altoona, three players made their Flying Squirrels debuts, including Zach Morgan, Justin Wishkoski, and Julio Rodriguez. Pitcher Jack Choate made his Double-A debut on Tuesday night against the Yard Goats.
