

Tonight: It's game No. 3,333 in franchise history as the Lugnuts open a six-game series through Sunday in Dayton against the division-leading Dragons, the first of 24 meetings this year between the two ballclubs. Dayton enters the series coming off five wins in six games at Great Lakes while the Lugnuts split at home against Lake County. The two teams are following different philosophies with regard to starting rotations, with the Lugnuts sending six different starters to the mound during the series while Dayton will start right-hander Eduardo Salazar both tonight and in the Sunday series finale.

What's New in 2021: In the franchise's 25th season in existence, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson[®] Field[™], the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 5, Captains 2. The Nuts received home runs from Jake Suddleson, Max Schuemann and Michael Guldberg -- Guldberg's second straight day with a home run -- in defeating the Caps on Mother's Day to clinch a season-opening six-game split with Lake County.

Last Series Overview: The Lugnuts dominated the Lake County Captains on Opening Night, 8-1, behind an ace performance (7 K in four shutout innings) from Seth Shuman and a home run and a double in young Jordan Díaz's first two at-bats of the season. The Captains struck back with three straight wins, 3-1, 7-6 and 6-2, before the Nuts won both games over the weekend behind dominating pitching, 2-0 and 5-2. Lansing out-homered Lake County, 6-1, and limited the Captains to a .218 batting average with 63 strikeouts in 54 games.

Pitching and Power: Six games into the season, the Lugnuts' pitching corps leads the High-A Central in ERA (2.33), fewest walks issued (14) and, by a large margin, GO/AO ratio (2.73), with nearly three groundouts for every one out in the air. The hitters lead the HiA-C in doubles (16) and are second in hits (48) and TBs (82).

Meet the Boss: Scott Steinmann is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017).

Familiar Settings: 13 of the 30 Lugnuts players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members Scott Steinmann, Don Schulze and Anthony Phillips all have experience in the league.

A Trio of Michiganders: Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University, and Jeff Criswell (Portage Central H.S.) and Jack Weisenburger (Rockford H.S.) are the fourth and fifth Michigan Wolverines to play in Lansing (following Troy Miller, Jake Fox and Rich Hill).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielders Michael Guldberg and Jake Suddleson are all making their pro debut this season.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. Outfielder Jake Suddleson and first baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Jeff Criswell and Jack Weisenburger, Michigan; Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); and the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama, and Ryan Gridley, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 15 different states represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. Jake Suddleson and Patrick McColl played together at Harvard, Reid Birlingmair and Charlie Cerny pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and Jeff Criswell and Jack Weisenburger pitched together in Ann Arbor. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons, but William Simoneit played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing Colin Peluse by a year. On Saturday, Simoneit caught Peluse, forming a full Demon Deacon battery.



Professional Career: Drafted 194th overall in the 6th round from Georgia Southern in 2019, signed for \$235,000 (one round in front of Lugnuts teammate Drew Millas)... one of 10 2019 draftees on the Lugnuts roster... made pro debut with Short-Season A NYPL Vermont Lake Monsters on June 29, 2019... of 14 runs allowed in 11 games, nine came in two poor outings; dominated otherwise, finishing with back-to-back five-inning scoreless performances.

Family Ties: Seth's father, Bart, was the starting shortstop on the 1979 NCAA Division-II National Champion Valdosta State Blazers, hitting .277 and striking out just eight times in 61 games... sister, Sloan, was a two-time national champion cheerleader at Valdosta State... brother, Scott, nine years older (first name: Rutherford), was drafted in the 19th round in 2009 by Tampa Bay from Auburn University and pitched in the Midwest League with the 2010 Bowling Green Hot Rods (3.01, 14 saves, 46 G, 71 2/3 IP, 38 BB, 111 K), rose as high as Double-A, and spent the 2019 season as a relief ace for independent Lancaster.

Glory Days on the Gridiron: Starting quarterback at Valdosta H.S., named 2nd-Team All-State by the Georgia Sports Writers Association and Honorable Mention All-State by the Atlanta Journal-Constitution in 2015, breaking the school's single-season passing record with 3,194 yards... 25 touchdowns, 3 interceptions... wore No. 10 and played in four games as a freshman at Georgia Southern, 114 snaps, in 2016-2017, passing for 357 yards and a touchdown and rushing for 39 yards.

Success in Statesboro: Considered a walk-on with Georgia Southern baseball due to football scholarship, and splitting his time between baseball and spring football, but quickly established himself as an impact pitcher, going 8-0, 3.34, 46 2/3 IP, 49 K, receiving the honor of the start in Sun Belt Tournament Championship game vs. South Alabama (received no-decision)... left football team after freshman year to gain full baseball scholarship... named Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference in both 2018 and 2019 as sophomore and junior... named First-Team All-Sun Belt Conference in 2019 (3.83, 16 GS, 91 2/3 IP, 27 BB, 114 K)... earned nickname "The Franchise" at Georgia Southern because of his importance to the program during his three years.

A Fun Georgia Southern Note: The Eagles' most notable game in team history might have been on March 15, 2008, when they hit 14 home runs in a 26-8 victory over Columbia. In the eighth inning alone, the Eagle crushed five homers, including three consecutive shots by pinch-hitters.
