Last Time Out... Anthony Gutierrez hit an infield single in the bottom of the 10th inning that scored Jayce Easley from second base and brought in the game's only run as Hickory topped the BlueClaws 1-0 at LP Frans Stadium... Eiberson Castellano started for Jersey Shore and gave up two hits over five scoreless innings with six strikeouts... Gunner Mayer threw two perfect innings of relief striking out six.

Hitting the Road...The BlueClaws are in Hickory for six games this week (1-1), the only six meetings of the season between the BlueClaws and Crawdads (Rangers)...Jersey Shore took four of six at Hickory last year...This is one of just three series the BlueClaws will play against the Southern Division this season – Bowling Green (April 30 – May 5) and Winston-Salem (August 13-18) will both visit Lakewood later this summer.

Back to Sam...Sam Aldegheri becomes the first BlueClaw to make two starts this year...The left-hander from Verona, Italy started the season opener on Friday and gave up one unearned run over 4.1 innings, while striking out four and walking four against Aberdeen...He is the #23 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline...Aldegheri made four starts with the BlueClaws last year but spent the bulk of the season with Clearwater, going 3-1, 3.86...He is 22 and won't turn 23 until September 19th.

Going Gone...Justin Crawford and Felix Reyes both homered for the BlueClaws on Tuesday in Hickory, the team's second and third home runs of the season...Crawford hit three last year with Clearwater, while Reyes hit 10, nine with Clearwater and one with the BlueClaws...Andrick Nava hit the first BlueClaws home run of 2024, a two-run blast on Saturday as part of a three hit, three RBI day...Nava's home run was the 10th of his career and he hit three with Jeresy Shore last season...Cade Fergus and Chad Castillo each hit 12 home runs last year while Felix Reyes hit 10.

Youth Is Served...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws have five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9th), Justin Crawford (11th), Hendry Mendez (17th), and Emmaarion Boyd (21st).

Welcome to the Phillies...OF Hendry Mendez is 4-9 so far this season – two hits on Sunday and two hits and a walk in his organizational debut on Friday...Mendez came to the Phillies from Milwaukee with IF Robert Moore in exchange for IF Oliver Dunn in November...He spent last year with High-A Wisconsin in the Midwest League...The 20 year old is the #23 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline.

Run Baby Run...The BlueClaws have 11 stolen bases in five games, second most in the league (Aberdeen has 13)...They stole three on Opening Night, three on Satuday, and four on Tuesday...Justin Crawford leads the team with four...Last year, Clearwater (Phillies Low-A) led all 120 minor league teams with 270 stolen bases and had nine players with at least 10 stolen bases...Of those nine, six open the season with the BlueClaws – Emaarion Boyd (56), Justin Crawford (40), Bryan Rincon (23), Erick Brito (14), Troy Schreffler (11), and Cade Fergus (10).

Schreffler Off To Great Start...Troy Schreffler, who grew up a Phillies fan in Harrisburg and played at Maryland, is 4-8 to start the season with four RBIs and a stolen base...He had three hits in the win on Tuesday at Hickory...He spent the bulk of last year with Clearwater, hitting .289 with 11 stoeln bases in 42 games.

Pottstown to ShoreTown...C Jordan Dissin grew up in Pottstown, Pennsylvania and went to Malvern Prep High School, growing up a huge Phillies fan...He made his BlueClaws debut this week and had an RBI double in the game on Sunday...Dissin began his career at Richmond and finished at Saddleback JC in California before the Phillies drafted him in the 12th round of the 2022 draft.

Fantatstic Four...William Bergolla had the second four-hit game of his US career on Saturday (6/14/23 vs Tampa with Clearwater), going 4-4 with three runs scored...Bergolla is 19 years old and one of just six 19 year olds to play with the BlueClaws since they moved to High-A in 2021 (the only younger player was Andrew Painter who debuted with the BlueClaws at 19 years, 2 months old, while Bergolla did so at 19 years, 5 months old).

A Sensational Debut...RHP Charles King spent the last two years working as a biomechanical analyst in the pitching department of the Padres following a five year career at TCU...He signed with the Phillies in February and got the last five outs in earning the save in his professional debut on Saturday, even stranding a leadoff ninth inning double with a one-run lead.

Lock It Down...Wesley Moore and Andrew Walling picked up right where they left off last year, with each throwing two scoreless innings over two appearances apiece...Last year, Moore had a 1.91 ERA while Walling had a 3.23 ERA with 27 strikeouts in 16.1 innings with the BlueClaws...Both opened the season with Clearwater before earning second half promotions to the BlueClaws.

Flying Into ShoreTown...Emaarion Boyd, the #18 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline, joins the BlueClaws for the 2024 season...Boyd stole 56 bases last year, second most in the Florida State League and ninth most in Minor League Baseball...Since 2005, only two Phillies minor leaguers - Anthony Gose had 76 in 2009 Johan Rojas had 62 in 2022 – had more stolen bases than Boyd did last year.

The Biggest Hit...IF Felix Reyes returns to the BlueClaws, where he spent the last two weeks of 2023...In fact, he'll struggle to have as a big of a hit as he did in the last regular season game in Lakewood last year...On September 3rd, Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to give the BlueClaws a 7-6 win over Abrerdeen in the home finale...The BlueClaws would go on to make the playoffs by one game.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws had an Opening Night walk-off win when Emaarion Boyd scored on a wild pitch...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

From The Shore to the Show...123 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show including one this year (Ben Brown, Cubs)...Three debuted in 2023 – James McArthur with the Royals, Johan Rojas with the Phillies, and Orion Kerkering with the Phillies...Kerkering, who was with the BlueClaws from May 9th through July 6th, is the only player to play for the BlueClaws and Phillies in the same year.
