## NATURALS TAKE SERIES OVER ROUGHRIDERS:

Forecasted rain held off long enough for the Northwest Arkansas Naturals to edge the Frisco RoughRiders in Sunday's series finale by a score of 4-3. The Riders put the game's winning run at first in the bottom of the ninth before recording the final out of the game. **Cole Ragans** (0-1) struck out six batters in his five-inning start for Frisco (10-5), allowing two earned runs on four hits. Following a three-inning start from Alec Marsh, Naturals (7-8) Yefri Del Rosario (1-0) held the Riders scoreless in three innings with four strikeouts. The RoughRiders opened the scoring action for the first time in the six-game series with a lead-off home run from **Jonathan Ornelas**, his first of the season. For Ornelas, the long fly came as his tenth hit in his last four games. Frisco extended their lead in the bottom of the third with an RBI double from **Dustin Harris**, following a one-out walk to **Jordan Procyshen** to make it 2-0. Harris's double extended his active hitting streak to eleven games, going 15-for-41 (.366 average) since the conclusion of his second game. Northwest Arkansas began their fightback with a solo home run in the top of the fourth from Michael Massey, cutting the Riders lead to 2-1. The Naturals finished the six-game series with 12 home runs. Two more runs came in the top of the fifth when Tucker Bradley bunted his way aboard and stole both second and third, and John Rave walked. After Tucker scored on a wild pitch, advancing Rave to third, Massey reached on a fielding error from **Ezequiel Duran**, bringing in Rave to give the Naturals the 3-2 lead. The Naturals started the sixth inning with a lead-off double from Robbie Glendinning, who came in to score on a run-scoring single from Nate Eaton to stretch the Northwest Arkansas lead, to 4-2. In their final chance, **Justin Foscue** doubled off the wall and **Josh Stowers** singled to put runners at the corner with one out. **Kellen Strahm** flew out deep enough to center to allow Foscue to score from third to cut the lead to one. After Dio Arias was hit by the first pitch to him, Procyshen grounded out to end Sunday's game, 4-3.

## SETH'S RATH:

Riders reliever **Seth Nordlin** was flat out dominant in his outing against Northwest Arkansas on Friday. Nordlin threw four shutout innings, retiring all 12 batters he faced with four strikeouts. After throwing a first-pitch ball on his very first offering, Nordlin threw 22-straight strikes over the next three innings. Overall, he threw 34 pitches, 29 for strikes.

## JONNY ON THE SPOT:

RoughRiders infielder **Jonathan Ornelas** has been incredible at the plate for the RoughRiders over the last four games, knocking three hits in three contests. In the last 11 games, Ornelas is hitting .413 (19-for-46)/.426/.500 to raise his season average to .370.

## DURAN, DURAN; DOUBLE TROUBLE:

The Rangers No. 4 prospect **Ezequiel Duran** has been on fire to start the season with Frisco. In his first 11 games of the season, Duran reached in every contest. Duran is second in all of Minor League Baseball with nine doubles. Over those first 11 games, Duran hit .289 (13-for-45)/.347/.489 with those nine doubles, four RBIs, 10 runs scored and three stolen bases. The infielder blasted his first home run of the season on Saturday.

## DUSTIN BUSTER:

After starting the season 0-for-8, **Dustin Harris** is now on an 11-game hitting streak. Harris is hitting .366 (15-for-41)/.404/.488/.892 over his streak with a double, a home run and 10 RBIs. The 11-game hitting streak is the second-longest streak in the Texas League, trailing only Zack Gelfo of Midland (13 games). The No. 6 prospect in the Rangers system was the Tom Grieve Ranger Minor League Player of the Year in 2021, hitting .327/.401/.542 with 20 home runs and 25 steals between Low-A Down East and High-A Hickory.

## YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT:

Over the last 13 games, the RoughRiders have banged out at least 10 hits in seven contests. Their 117 hits in the last 13 games are more than 55 teams (45.8 percent) in MiLB have all season. Overall, Frisco is hitting .277/.349/.413 to start the season, a batting average good for third in the Texas League and sixth in Minor League Baseball.

## REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 966 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

## WELCOME TO THE LEIT SHOW:

Rangers No.1 prospect, RHP **Jack Leiter** was as-advertised on Saturday in his first start of his professional career. Over his three innings, Leiter whiffed seven while allowing just one run on one hit with two walks. The second-overall pick out of Vanderbilt in the 2021 draft, Leiter was a unanimous First-Team All-American in his final season with the Commodores while tying the NCAA lead in strikeouts on the year. The son of two-time All-Star and two-time World Series champ Al Leiter, Jack is ranked as the No. 17 prospect in baseball by MLB.com. In his second start of the season, he went four innings, allowing just one run on one hit again, striking out four against San Antonio.

## LOOK AT ALL THAT TALENT:

While Leiter headlines the top 30 prospects talent on the squad, the Riders back up him with plenty of players to watch. INF **Ezequiel Duran** slots in as the No. 4 prospect in the organization after the Rangers acquired him from the Yankees as part of the **Joey Gallo** deal at the 2021 deadline. INF **Justin Foscue**, who joined the club after sustaining an injury during spring training, is the No. 5 prospect. OF **Dustin Harris** is the No. 6 prospect after his incredible 20-20 campaign a year ago. Another trade piece, Harris came to the Rangers when they dealt **Mike Minor** to the A's in 2020. LHP **Cody Bradford** is the No. 20 prospect. Bradford, a former Baylor Bear from Aledo, Texas, led all Rangers farmhands in strikeouts last season.

### ABOUT ZAK

-Grew up never playing travel ball, always played Little League baseball and never started on the All-Star teams. After making the varsity team his freshman year at Northumberland High School, he was cut. He was "heartbroken" and wanted to prove to everyone that he could play varsity. Made the team his sophomore season, playing third and pitching, but pitching was his passion.

-Around midway through his SO year in HS, decided he wanted to play in college, so decided to try travel ball. During his first time with the Richmond Braves, he was cut after the tryout. Mom encouraged him to tryout again in two weeks and made the team.

-Mom went to Liberty, so he wanted to go there, but went to camp and saw players that were a lot better than him when he was a junior. Went to a showcase and was the last one to throw. VMI was the only school interested and Kent only said he wanted to go there when he heard they were D1. At the time, he was only throwing 82-84 on a good day, but had a high spin rate. Played QB on football team in HS for three years and lettered one year in golf

-Pfeiffer (D2) was only other team that recruited him.

-At VMI, finished 2019 season 5-5 with a 4.64 ERA, striking out 132 over 97.0 innings while walking just 30. Those strikeouts led the Southern Conference and was ninth in the nation (also a school record). Was second in the country in strikeouts at the end of the regular season, but was passed when others pitched in the postseason.

-Teammates with Josh Winder (started 2021 season with Wichita Wind Surge) at VMI. He was a big inspiration to Kent throughout his career.

### 2022 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers system per MLB.com.

-In first start at San Antonio, threw four innings, allowing three runs before being placed on the 7-Day Injured List.

### 2021 SEASON

-Finished third among Rangers farmhands in strikeout rate (31.9 percent), only behind Avery Weems (34.5) and Cole Winn (32.2).

-Began season in the bullpen, throwing five-straight scoreless outings (18.2 IP, 10 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 26 K) before transitioning into a starting role with Hickory.

-As a starter, went 4-2 with a 4.10 ERA over nine starts, but finished out time with Crawdads with best start on August 5th against Greensboro: 7.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 13 K. Won High-A Pitcher of the Week for his efforts.

-In Double-A debut, threw first career complete game in game one of the doubleheader at Northwest Arkansas, but took the loss in a 1-0 game. Kent went 6.0 innings, allowing just one run on a solo home run, ceding three hits while striking out seven and walking two.

### 2020 SEASON

-Tied with Cody Bradford for most strikeouts in the Fall Developmental League (25 K/17.0 IP) among Rangers farmhands.

### 2019 SEASON

-Though he started seven games, he never pitched more than three innings in a game.

-Finished last eight outings, six starts, with a 0-1 record and 3.45 ERA.
