NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

The 2026 season has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha but things are trending up, with the Chasers coming off series wins over Toledo and St. Paul.

- After an 0-4 start to the year, the Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, then went 3-11 from April 22 to May 8 ... Omaha has won 10 of the last 17, since May 9.
- Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... last year, the Chasers had just one winning month, going 15-11 in August ... with a 12-10 record in May, the Storm Chasers need to win 2 of their final 3 this month for a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
- Prior to last Sunday's win, the Chasers had been under .500 for 29 days, from April 24 to May 23 ... Omaha has spent 18 days at or above .500, 15 of which came consecutively in a 13-game stretch from April 10 to 24.

SERIES SPEAKING

Last week's series win was Omaha's 2nd straight and the club's 5th of 9 series this year.

- The Chasers have won 5 of their 8 week-long series this season - taking series against Buffalo (4-2), Iowa (3-2), Indianapolis (4-2), Toledo (4-2) and St. Paul (4-2).
- In 4 of this season's 5 series wins, Omaha won the series opener ... in 3 of the series wins - against Buffalo, Toledo and St. Paul - the clubs split the first four games before the Storm Chasers took both remaining contests to claim the series.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Storm Chasers have trailed at some point in each of their last 8 wins, with Sunday's 5-3 victory representing Omaha's 15th overall comeback win this year.

- Over Omaha's last 8 wins (since May 13), the Storm Chasers have trailed for a total of 16 1/2 innings, 6.5 of those innings coming in 4 wins last week in St. Paul.
- Omaha's 15 comeback wins ranked tied for the 2nd-most in the International League and tied 4th at the Triple-A level ... the Chasers' '99 comeback wins since 2024 rank 2nd-most in the International League and 3rd-most at the Triple-A level.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by a quartet of baserunning threats.

- Omaha's 84.1% success rate (58-for-69) ranks 3rd in the IL and 5th in Triple-A.
- John Rave** leads Omaha in steals (13) ... **Gavin Cross** has 11 steals in as many tries, the 2nd-most steals in the IL without being caught ... **Kameron Misner** has swiped 9 bags, while **Tyler Tolbert** has 8 steals.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE

A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.

- The Storm Chasers are seeing 3.990 pitches per plate appearance, 4th-most in the International League and 7th at the Triple-A level.
- Among 185 Triple-A players with 150+ plate appearances this year, **Kameron Misner** is 7th in pitches seen/PA (4.407) while **John Rave** ranks 8th (4.347).

DON'T BRETT, SQUIRES IS HERE!

Chasers first baseman **Brett Squires** has been on fire across his first two weeks at the Triple-A level, since earning a promotion to Omaha on May 12.

- After a 1-for-15 start in his first 4 Triple-A games, Squires is 15-for-42 (.357) over his last 11 games with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs and 14 RBI.
- Combining his Double-A and Triple-A games, Squires is hitting .290 (51-for-176) with 15 doubles, 1 triple, 13 home runs, 45 RBI and a .975 OPS ... he ranks tied 2nd among Minor Leaguers in extra-base hits (29), tied 9th in the Minors in RBI, tied 10th in home runs and 12th in total bases (107).
- His 11 extra-base hits since May 16 are the most of any player in baseball (Majors & Minors), while 39 total bases in that stretch are 2nd-most in the Minors and 3rd in baseball ... his .929 SLG since May 16 is the 2nd-best in baseball (min. 30 PA), trailing only **Drew Cavanaugh** (.944, RIC/SAC).

MAYS-TERCLASS

With one week remaining in the month of May, the Storm Chasers have one of the league's best hitters this month and a trio of strong bullpen arms.

- Luca Tresh** has been one of the International League's best hitters in May, hitting .397 (25-for-63) with 9 extra-base hits and 15 RBI in 17 games, for a 1.068 OPS ... 21 hits in games he's caught this month are tied 4th-most among MiLB catchers.
- Eric Cerantola**, **Jose Cuas** and **Ben Sears** have all been especially effective out of Omaha's bullpen this month ... Cerantola has pitched to a 1.13 ERA (1 ER in 8.0 IP) while Cuas has a 2.79 ERA (3 ER in 9.2 IP) in 10 games this month and Sears has worked a 3.31 ERA (6 ER in 16.1 IP) over 7 May appearances.

TODAY'S START

- Ryan Ramsey is making his **10th start** with the Storm Chasers this year and his **11th appearance** of the season with Omaha.
- Playing his **5th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- This is Ramsey's 1st career start against the Redbirds ... has a 7.26 ERA in 9 career appearances against other Cardinals affiliates, having pitched in 4 games against Springfield (AA) and 5 against Peoria (A+).

RAMSEY RUNDOWN

- STARTER'S ORDERS:** Ramsey made just two spot starts last year for Omaha, but cracked the Storm Chasers' Opening Day roster ... in 2025, just 8 of his first 13 appearances were starts, while he has been in Omaha's rotation all of 2026, outside of one bulk relief/piggyback outing in his 2nd game of the year ... he is 1 of 12 players (5 pitchers) that has been on Omaha's active roster all season.
- DOUBLE THE TROUBLE:** Ramsey has had 14 double plays turned behind him this season, the most of any pitcher between the Majors and Minor Leagues ... he's had 3 starts without a single double play turned behind him, but 4 appearances with 2+ double plays turned on the ground, including 3 double plays on April 5 vs. Buffalo, April 17 vs. Indianapolis and April 30 vs. Louisville.
- RAMSEY TO THE RESCUE:** Omaha starting pitchers have earned just 3 wins this season and Ramsey is responsible for the most recent 2 - his starts May 6 @ Indianapolis and May 24 @ St. Paul ... 3 starting pitcher wins are the fewest of any Triple-A team.

LAST OUTING: SUNDAY, MAY 24 @ St. PAUL

- Threw 5.0 innings for the 5th time this season in the series finale and earned his 3rd win of the season ... allowed a solo homer to Royce Lewis in the 1st inning, then settled down to work scoreless innings from the 2nd through the 5th to end his start ... worked around walks in the 2nd and 3rd, getting a double play in the 3rd ... worked around singles in the 4th and 5th, did not come out for the 6th.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Worked 5.0 innings of 1-run relief on April 5 vs. Buffalo (TOR), 1 out shy of tying his longest career relief appearance.
- Ranks 1st among Storm Chasers pitchers in innings (44.2), tied 1st in strikeouts (40) and 2nd in starts (9).

CAREER NOTES

- 2025** Began the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA) and spent most of the year in Double-A, also making a pair of spot starts for Omaha ... posted a 5.54 ERA (65 ER in 105.2 IP) in 25 appearances (18 starts) at Double-A ... his 114 total strikeouts ranked tied with **Shane Panzini** for the Royals organization lead.
- Pitched to a 3.73 ERA (17 ER in 41.0 IP) over his first 9 appearances (7 starts) from April 9 to May 31 which included a 5.2-inning, 5 strikeout, scoreless performance May 18 @ Tulsa (LAD).
- Made his first Double-A start on April 15 @ San Antonio (SD), throwing 5.2 innings of no-hit ball to start what became the fourth no-hitter in Nationals history ... relievers **Chazz Martinez**, **Ryan Brady** & **Brandon Johnson** finished it off ... was NWA's third combined no-no, the club's first no-hitter since 2013.
- Was transferred to Omaha on April 30 and made his Triple-A debut on May 1 vs. Indianapolis (PIT) ... returned to the Naturals on May 2 and returned to Omaha for a start on September 19 @ Columbus (CLE).

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- Spent the entire 2024 season with Quad Cities (A+), splitting time between the bullpen and as a starter ... appeared in 22 games (11 starts) with a 2.43 ERA (24 ER in 89.0 IP) and 97 strikeouts to 30 walks (3.23 K/BB) at High-A ... had a career-high 25.2-inning scoreless streak from July 25 to August 27, the River Bandits' longest scoreless streak in their Royals-affiliate era (since 2021).
- Largely split 2023 between Columbia (A) and Quad Cities (A+), but also made 2 rehab appearances (1 start) with the ACL Royals (R) ... pitched to a 0.54 ERA (2 ER in 33.1 IP) with 38 strikeouts across 7 starts with Columbia before earning a promotion to Quad Cities ... made 5 appearances (2 starts) at High-A with 22 strikeouts in 14.1 innings (13.8 K/9) ... set a Fireflies record with a 24.0-inning scoreless streak from April 21 to July 29, spanning 5 outings and stints on the Development List and Injured List.
- Made his professional debut in 2022 with the ACL Royals (Rk) after Kansas City drafted him in the 13th round of the 2022 MLB Draft ... pitched in 1 game in the ACL that season.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Pitched 3 seasons (2020-22) for the University of Maryland (Big Ten), working a career 17-2 record with a 3.13 ERA (47 ER in 135.0 IP) and 140 strikeouts to 58 walks (2.41 K/BB) for the Terrapins ... named 2022 First Team All-Big Ten and 2021 Second Team All-Big Ten.
- Threw a 9.0-inning perfect game for the University of Maryland on April 29, 2022 against Northwestern.
- Was drafted by Cleveland in the 36th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Pascack Hills High School but elected not to sign and instead attend the University of Maryland.
