LAST GAME

The Baysox came from behind to take down the Harrisburg Senators by a 5-2 final on Friday night. Harrisburg grabbed an early 1-0 via a Terone Harris III RBI single in the second, as right-handed starter Alex Pham went just three frames for Bowie. The Baysox tied the game against Harrisburg southpaw Alex Troop in the fourth on a disengagement violation that allowed Jud Fabian to score from third. The Senators retook the lead on a solo home run from Brady Lindsly in the fifth, before the Baysox took the lead in the seventh. A Joseph Rosa RBI double tied the game at two, before Jacob Teter launched an opposite field two-run double that gave the Baysox a 4-2 edge. Shayne Fontana added on a solo homer in the eighth, with right-hander Houston Roth grabbing the win following his four innings of one-run baseball out of the bullpen and Conner Loeprich notching his second save of the season with a scoreless final two innings.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Harrisburg Senators enter this week with an overall record of 39-48. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, Harrisburg is 8-11 in the second half and 3.5 games back of first-place Erie in the second half Southwest division standings. The Senators are tied for the lowest team average (.229) and fewest home runs (64) in the Eastern League, but have committed the fewest errors (52) defensively. The Senators' roster is highlighted by eight of the Nationals' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - OF James Wood (No. 1 WSH / No. 4 overall), IF Brady House (No. 2 WSH / No. 70 overall) OF Robert Hassell III (No. 5 WSH / No. 93 overall), RHP Cole Henry (No. 12 WSH), RHP Zach Brzykcy (No. 17 WSH), IF Trey Lipscomb (No. 18 WSH), LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 22 WSH), RHP Gerardo Carrillo (No. 26 WSH).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Southpaw Mitchell Parker is set to take the ball tonight for the Senators. The No. 22 prospect in the Nationals' system, per MLB Pipeline, Parker has held opponents to a .223 average through his 66.1 innings this season, but his seven home runs allowed are third-most on the staff. Parker is coming off arguably the best start of his professional career - matching a career high with seven shutout innings, allowing just one hit and two walks, while striking out eight against Richmond last Sunday. The left-hander has also pitched well in each of his two starts against Bowie this season, allowing just one run on both occasions - tossing six innings on 5/10 in Harrisburg, while going four frames on 6/2 with a solo home run allowed to John Rhodes at Prince George's Stadium. A fifth-round pick of the Nationals in 2020 out of San Jacinto Junior College, Parker features a low-90s fastball, low-80s curveball, along with a changeup and splitter.

HAPPY HOLLIDAY

Jackson Holliday has already made a splash in Double-A, hitting .333 with a pair of doubles, while reaching in six of his first seven contests. Holliday has recorded hits in five of seven games, with multiple hits on three occasions. Baseball's top prospect ranks top five in the Orioles' system with a .330 average (3rd), .459 on-base percentage (1st), .510 slugging percentage (5th), .969 OPS (4th), six triples (1st), and 67 walks (1st) across three levels in 2023. Holliday on-base percentage is also second-best in all of Minor League Baseball. He is the second No. 1 overall prospect to don a Baysox uniform in quick succession, as Adley Rutschman (2021-22) also topped the prospect rankings during his time in Bowie. Holliday is also the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday. He is the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

AVOIDING THE TRAFFIC

While the Baysox sit with the fourth-most home runs in the Eastern League at 92, Bowie has struggled with the timeliness of its long balls. The Baysox have hit the third-most solo shots in the league at 57 total. However, in terms of portions, just under 62% of Bowie's home runs have been solo blasts. That is the highest portion of any team in the Eastern League.

TRENDING IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION

Bowie's struggles at home this season have been noted. The Baysox are one of just four teams in the Eastern League with a losing record at their home ballpark this season (21-28) and only two teams hold a lower winning percentage (.429) in home contests. However, lately Bowie has bucked that trend. This weekend, the Baysox go for their third series win at Prince George's Stadium in their last four attempts, after having no series wins at home on the season.

STARTING STRONG

Despite sitting in the bottom half of the Eastern League with a 4.25 staff ERA, the Baysox have gotten a lot of help from their starting staff. Bowie starters have hit a collective 3.76 ERA this season - the best mark in the Eastern League and second-best in Double-A. With two starts of at least five shutout innings already this week, Bowie starters have tossed at least five shutout frames on 17 occasions this season. Tuesday's win was also the seventh shutout of the season for Bowie. Only Erie (8) has more in the Eastern League this season.

CAREER NOTES

- Went 2-2 with a 6.94 ERA in 6 appearances (5 starts) for the Baysox last season.
- Had a sensational start to his time in the Orioles' system, winning the organization's Pitcher of the Month honors after 4-0 with a 2.57 ERA with 34 strikeouts to just 7 walks across 28 innings, between Aberdeen and Bowie
- Struggled in September, as he allowed 10 ER in 7.1 IP in the month, including allowing 4 in 1.2 innings against Akron in the season's final game on 9/18, in what would be a loss to eliminate the Baysox from postseason contention.
- Had a 4.08 ERA in 20 appearances (19 starts) for the Twins' organization across two seasons.
- Spent parts of two seasons with the Nebraska Cornhuskers, only full season was 2021, where he finished 6-1 with a 3.11 ERA in 11 innings.

NOTES BY OUTING

- 4/8 Allowed two early baserunners in the first with none out, but stranded both. Got two quick ground outs in the second inning, but allowed the next four batters to reach, including three hits, needing 28 pitches in the inning. Faced the minimum in the third.
- 4/15 Struck out five of the first eight batters faced. Allowed two baserunners in the third, only inning to allow multiple runners.
- 4/21 Allowed three runs in the first inning on two walks and two hits, needing 32 pitches for the frame. Two more runs in the third inning on a single, triple, and passed ball.
- 4/29 Front end of a doubleheader, struck out seven batters in his first trip through the order. Only hit allowed was a two-out double in the third. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- 5/5 Struck out three batters over first two innings, but allowed two runs in the third including a solo home run. Struck out four more batters, but back-to-back two-out base hits in the fifth forced his exit.
- 5/11 Struck out seven of first 11 batters faced. Faced one over the minimum through four innings, but allowed two singles to start the fifth inning before striking out the side. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- 5/17 Allowed each of the first three batters to reach base, and all to score on two sacrifice flies and a double. Allowed two more runners to move into scoring position, but none to third base.
- 5/23 After Bowie had taken a 2-0 lead in the second, allowed a walk and game-tying two-run home run in the bottom of the frame. Only allowed two baserunners over final three innings.
- 5/28 Faced the minimum over the first two innings thanks to a double play. Allowed three doubles. First five batters reached safely in the fifth inning.
- 6/3 Gave up a single and home run to the first two batters. Needed 71 pitches for just the first three innings. Allowed a second two-run home run in the fourth. Career high in hits allowed
- 6/9 Gave up a two-run home run to second batter of the second inning. Allowed two more runs in the following innings on three-consecutive two-out hits.
- 6/15 Struck out the first six batters, and seven of the first eight. Carried a perfect game into the seventh inning before allowing a leadoff single. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- 6/21 Stranded error at third base in first inning, and threw perfect second. Allowed first five batters of the third inning to reach, including two walks and a hit batter.
- 6/28 Allowed a leadoff home run in the second inning, and back-to-back home runs to lead off the fourth inning, before walking the next three batters, and failing to escape the frame.
- 7/3 Allowed three runs on back-to-back home runs with two outs in the first inning. Allowed two more base hits in the second, but picked off one runner, and faced the minimum over the next 13 batters.
- 7/8 Only hit over first four innings was an infield single. Allowed a leadoff home run in the fifth.
- 7/16 Two early base hits and wild pitch allowed a run in the first. Faced two over the minimum the rest of the way, including a walk and solo home run.
