### BULLPEN STARS IN 6-2 WIN AT NORFOLK

Both Deyvison De Los Santos and Joe Mack homered on Tuesday and Jacksonville's bullpen worked 7.0 scoreless innings to knock off Norfolk 6-2. The Tides jumped out to a lead in the first inning on a two-run shot by Creed Willems. However, Norfolk mustered just two singles the rest of the way. Andrew Pintar's RBI triple in the third got the Jumbo Shrimp on the board and Jesús Bastidas tied things in the fourth with an RBI single. De Los Santos went deep in the fifth and Jacob Berry added a sacrifice fly in the sixth. A Mack eighth-inning bomb and a Bastidas sacrifice fly in the ninth set the final margin at 6-2.

### SHUT DOWN CYCLE

Over the last three games, Jacksonville has yielded only three runs on seven hits in 27.0 innings. The club's pitching dominance coincides with a three-game winning streak to help the Jumbo Shrimp rebound from a 1-6 start - their worst in recorded club history (since at least 2005). During this three-game stretch, Jacksonville hurlers have combined to tally 38 strikeouts (37.3 percent of their 101 batters faced) against 14 walks.

### GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT

Jacksonville has recorded double-digit strikeouts in all but two games thus far in 2026, with the lone exceptions being a pair of nine-punchout performances. Jumbo Shrimp hurlers have tallied at least 14 strikeouts in six of the last seven games, totaling 95 against 31 walks during that span. As a result, heading into play on Wednesday, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A with 124 strikeouts on the season. The club's pitchers have combined to fan 32.1 percent of opposing hitters (MLB average: ~24.1%).

### MEN OF STEAL

In 2024, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered only 86 stolen bases, 29th in Triple-A and 119th out of the 120 MiLB teams. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp swiped a franchise-record 305 bags, second-most in Triple-A and sixth-best of Minor League Baseball's 120 teams. Jacksonville, which had not finished in the top five at their level in stolen bases since at least 2005, had more games with multiple stolen bases (84) in 2025 than games with either one steal (32) or no steals (34) combined.

### TRUST THE PROCESS

Jacksonville ranks 29th or 30th in Triple-A in several offensive categories, including batting average (.175), on-base percentage (.303), slugging (.288), OPS (.591) and hits (53). The potential silver lining for the club has been they also own Triple-A's lowest BABIP at .218, far below the baseball-wide average of roughly .300. Perhaps encouragingly is that the Jumbo Shrimp rank much higher, even if not elite, at the level in barrel percentage (15th, 6.1 percent), chase rate (20th, 29.1 percent), average exit velocity (23rd, 87.7) and hard-hit percentage (24th, 33.2 percent).

### 'PEN PALS

Jacksonville's bullpen was arguably the club's biggest strength in their 2025 championship run, with the club leading Triple-A in ERA (3.64) and BAA (.214) while also throwing the fifth-most innings (700.2) of any bullpen at the level. However, over the first five games of the season, Jumbo Shrimp relievers combined to surrender 22 runs, 21 earned, on 27 hits (9.6 H/9) in 25.1 innings for a 7.46 ERA (21 BB, 7.5 BB/9, 38 K, 13.5 K/9). The club has seemed to start to turn that around over the last five contests, yielding only two runs, both earned, on eight hits (2.6 H/9) in 27.1 innings for a 0.66 ERA (9 BB, 3.0 BB/9, 43 K, 14.2 K/9). Heading into play on Wednesday, Jacksonville relievers have combined to toss 15.0 consecutive scoreless innings.

### FORMULA ONE

With a 29-14 (.674) record in one-run games in 2025, Jacksonville tied with Indianapolis for the most one-run victories in all of Minor League Baseball. The 29 one-run triumphs were the most for a Jacksonville club since 2014, when the Jacksonville Suns went 35-17 (.673) in one-run triumphs. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp went 58-34 (.630) in games decided by three runs or fewer, meaning 65.2 percent of their 89 victories came by those slim margins.

### POPCORN SHRIMP

Jacksonville's nine hits on Tuesday marked the club's single-game high so far this season. The Jumbo Shrimp had collected five hits or fewer in half of their 10 games thus far in 2026... Jacksonville is just 6-for-55 (.109) with runners in scoring position over the last six games.
