SOMERSET PATRIOTS NOTES

- The Somerset Patriots defeated the Altoona Curve in game four of a six-game series at PNG Field in Altoona, Pa. on Friday by a score of 12-1.
 - Somerset scored a season-high 12 runs and posted its highest run differential of the season at +11.
 - Eight Somerset batters logged a hit, and eight Somerset batters scored at least one run.
 - The Patriots bullpen has combined for 8.1 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to Thursday's game.
- **RHP Baron Stuart** (4.1 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 4 K) made his second start of the season and did not factor into the decision.
 - Across his two starts at Double-A, Stuart has combined for five strikeouts.
- RHP Luis Pacheco (1.2 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 2 K) earned his first win in his fourth appearance of the season.
 Pacheco has a 3.31 ERA across 5.1 innings pitched this year.
- **C Rafael Flores** (2-for-5, 2B, 4 RBI) led the team in runs batted in, bringing home two runs each on a double and a single.
 - Two of Flores' four runs batted in came with two outs.
 - Flores set a career-high with four runs batted in.
 - Flores leads Somerset and is fourth in the Eastern League with 12 runs batted in this season.
- **3B Jake Gatewood** (2-for-5, HR, 2B, 3 RBI, R) clobbered his first home run with the Yankees organization.
 - Gatewood leads the Eastern League with six doubles this season.
 Catewood neares Caregorith and is given in the Eastern League with a 200 OPC this and the Eastern League with a 200 OPC the Eastern League wit
 - Gatewood paces Somerset and is sixth in the Eastern League with a .990 OPS this season.
 Gatewood is tied for the Eastern League lead with Akron's Jorge Burgos with eight extra-base hits

- **RF Christopher Familia** (2-for-4, 2B, 3B, RBI, 2 R, K) made his Double-A debut and collected his first hit and run batted in at the Double-A level.
 - Familia is the fifth Patriots position player to make his Double-A debut this season and the third Patriots position player to do so this series (Gomez, Hernandez).
- SS Alexander Vargas (1-for-3, SF, 2B, 2 RBI, 1 BB, 1 K) posted his first multi-RBI game of the season.
 Vargas has driven in runs in five of the nine games he has played this year.
 - 2B Dylan Jasso (2-for-4, 2B, RBI, BB) brought in a run for the fourth time in the last five games.
 - Jasso is fourth on the Patriots with seven RBI.
