The Round Rock Express and the Oklahoma City Dodgers play game three of their six-game series at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark on Saturday night. Express RHP Glenn Otto is set to start up against Dodgers RHP Ryan Pepiot. First pitch is scheduled for 7:05 p.m.

### LET'S RECAP

The Oklahoma City Dodgers claimed a 2-0 win over the Round Rock Express on Friday night at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark thanks to two late-inning runs that allowed the Dodgers to extend their series lead to 2-0. The two teams played through six scoreless frames to begin the contest before Oklahoma City plated its first run in the seventh inning as LF Luke Raley hit a single before moving to second on a Drew Avans single. In the next at-bat, DH Cristian Santana knocked the third single of the inning to drive Raley home and put the Dodgers on the board. An insurance run crossed for the Dodgers in the eighth when RF Steven Souza made his way around the bases after working a leadoff walk. He then advanced as 2B Carlos Asuaje grounded out, stole third and finally scored thanks to a base hit from Raley, bringing the total to 2-0. Despite the loss, Round Rock edged Oklahoma City 8-6 in hits as 2B Nick Solak and RF Carl Chester both recorded multi-hit games with two apiece. Express runners found themselves in scoring position five times throughout the contest, but the Dodgers defense kept them from scoring.

### UP ON THE BUMP

Round Rock RHP Glenn Otto is set to start on Saturday night. Through two starts with the Express, the righty holds a 6.00 ERA (6 ER/9.0 IP) and has struck out nine. Tonight will mark Otto's first road start for Round Rock.

### CLASSIC PITCHERS' DUEL

The Express pitching staff combined for 6.1 scoreless innings last night as RHP A.J. Alexy started the contest with 5.0 shutout frames that saw nine strikeouts, two hits and two walks. Texas Rangers RHP John King followed with one scoreless frame of relief during his second Major League rehab appearance in which he struck out two batters.

### ALL GOOD THINGS MUST END

Round Rock's scoreless outing on Friday ended the Express' active runs scored streak, which had extended over 55 straight games. The streak was the third-longest active run in Triple-A behind Salt Lake, who now sits at 86 straight games, and Oklahoma City, who is at 85. The 2-0 final marked just the second time this season that Round Rock has been shut out, with the first being on June 8 versus El Paso.

### HITTERS HIT

Friday night saw the 42nd time this season that the Express has out-hit their opponent and just the ninth time that the team has suffered a loss while doing so. Six different Round Rock batters tallied hits during the loss, including 2B Nick Solak and RF Carl Chester, who each had two.

### THAT'S OUR GUY

Texas Rangers C Yohel Pozo made his Major League debut on Friday night in Arlington as the designated hitter batting eighth. The Express alumnus recorded his first Major League hit on the first pitch he saw then later hit a three-run home run, helping the Rangers to a win over Oakland.

### ABD IN OKC

Former Round Rock RHP Austin Bibens-Dirkx continued his dominant run over his previous team with 7.0 shutout innings of relief out of the Oklahoma City bullpen on Friday night. Against the Express in 2021, Bibens-Dirkx is 5-0 with a 2.00 ERA (6 ER/27.0 IP), 25 strikeouts and five walks across five games. Against everyone else, the righty is 4-1 with a 5.10 ERA (31 ER/54.2 IP), 43 strikeouts and 13 walks across 12 appearances.

## ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Twenty nine members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021: RHP A.J. Alexy, INF Sherten Apostel, RHP Jason Bahr, INF Jax Biggers, OF Carl Chester, INF Ryan Dorow, RHP Scott Engler, RHP Demarcus Evans, C Jose Felix, RHP Joe Gatto, C Blake Grant-Parks, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, LHP John King, C Jack Kruger, LHP Jake Lotz, INF Charles Leblanc, LHP Sal Mendez, RHP Tyler Phillips, RHP Yerry Rodriguez, RHP Ryder Ryan, RHP Nick Snyder, OF Leody Taveras, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry, RHP Cole Uvila, OF Steele Walker, RHP Collin Wiles and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang. Interestingly enough, Apostel, Evans, King, Taveras and Tejeda all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang pitched for the Rangers in 2021 before making their Triple-A debuts.

## STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 14 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Michigan, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Texas, Virginia and Washington. John King, Jake Lemoine, Glenn Otto and Steele Walker represent the native Texans on the roster. King was born in Missouri City before a career at the University of Houston. Lemoine hails from Bridge City and was also a standout pitcher at the University of Houston. Otto is from in Spring and competed collegiately at Rice University. Finally, Walker was born and raised in Prosper before a college career at the University of Oklahoma.

## AROUND THE WORLD

Five different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 25 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, INF Sherten Apostel was born in Curacao, OF Elier Hernandez, RHP Yerry Rodriguez and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang is from South Korea.

## EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.



An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
