RIDERS DROP HEARTBREAKER IN AMARILLO TO OPEN SERIES:

The Frisco RoughRiders took 6-0 and 7-1 leads, but could not hold them in an eventual 9-7 loss to the Amarillo Sod Poodles on Tuesday night from HODGETOWN. With the RoughRiders (8-8) leading 7-1 in the bottom of the seventh, Amarillo (9-7) scored six runs to tie the game, including a three-run, game-tying home run from Tristin English. In the bottom of the eighth, Deyvison De Los Santos hammered a go-ahead homer against **Nick Starr** (1-2) and the Sod Poodles added a sacrifice fly to take a 9-7 lead. In his start, **Owen White** threw the first quality start for a RoughRiders pitcher, ceding three runs over his six innings while striking out four and walking one. White retired the first 10 he faced and, through five innings, had only allowed one baserunner on a single. On the offensive side, **Kellen Strahm** started the Riders scoring with an RBI double in the third. **Evan Carter** and **Dustin Harris** both smacked two-run singles in the fourth to make it 5-0 before Carter cracked a solo homer in the sixth to boost the lead. It was Carter's fourth home run of the season to lead the team. **Nick Tanielu** was the star of the night for Frisco, doubling twice and tripling home a run in the seventh to become the first RoughRiders player with three extra-base hits in the same game this season. Jake Rice (2-0) threw a scoreless inning in relief for Amarillo to earn the win and Kyle Backhus locked it down for his third save of the season.

O(wen), THAT'S QUALITY:

On Tuesday, Owen White threw the first quality start for the RoughRiders this season when he tossed six innings, allowing three runs while striking out four. He retired the first 10 he saw and allowed just one hit through five shutout innings before ceding a run in the sixth and left two on in the seventh when he exited, both of which came into score.

AND WE THOUGHT WE WERE SAFE:

The RoughRiders fell to the Amarillo Sod Poodles on Tuesday 9-7, twice leading by six runs. It was the first time that the RoughRiders lost a game leading by at least six runs since May 13th, 2007 when the RoughRiders dropped a game 9-8 to the Midland Rock-Hounds. In that game, Frisco led 8-1 in the top of the seventh before Midland scored seven runs in the bottom of the seventh to tie it and one in the eighth to take the lead. Similarly, on Tuesday, the Riders allowed six in the seventh to tie the game and two runs in the eighth for the go-ahead tallies.

LOAD UM UP:

The RoughRiders have had a league-high 22 RBIs with the bases loaded this season. As a team, they are hitting .368 (7-for-19)/.348/.947/1.295 with three grand slams and 22 RBIs. They are one of just two teams in Minor League Baseball with at least three grand slams this season already (Triple-A Round Rock) as **Trevor Hauver** hit one on Opening Day, **Dustin Harris** added another on Sunday in San Antonio and **Luisangel Acuña** blasted one on Thursday.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have just committed six errors through 15 games and committed their first position player error on Sunday in San Antonio. The team's .989 fielding percentage is second in Minor League Baseball (Memphis leads at .991).

WALK THIS WAY:

The Riders hitters worked 40 walks in the six games against the San Antonio Missions, which was the sixth-most in the minors last week. On the season, Frisco's 79 walks lead the Texas League while their .354 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Evan Carter** is third in the Texas League with 13 walks and is first in OBP (.525).

I LIKE BIG WINS AND I CANNOT LIE:

The RoughRiders eight wins this season have come by eight, six, seven, seven, 10, four runs, eight runs and three runs, respectively, while their seven losses have come by a combined 22 runs. That gives Frisco a +31 run differential through 15 games, which is tied for the best in the Texas League despite being tied with Amarillo, Midland and San Antonio for first in the South Division, all of which have negative run differentials. The only team with a +20 run differential in the league is Tulsa, which is 10-5 (+29). The RoughRiders have scored at least six runs eight times (8-0) and scored three or fewer runs seven times (0-7).

EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Outfielder **Evan Carter** has reached safely in 11 of his 12 games this season, batting .378 (17-for-45)/.525/.600/1.125 with a double, three home runs, 13 walks, 15 RBIs and three stolen bases. Carter is fifth in the Texas League in average (.378), tied for sixth in hits (17), tied for ninth in home runs (3), tied for second in RBIs (15), tied for third in walks (13) and sixth in OPS (1.125). On Wednesday in San Antonio, Carter crushed a three-run home run and a solo homer for his second two-home run game of his Minor League career before adding another home run on Sunday. The No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs. Carter is also the second-youngest player in the Texas League this season, trailing on 19-year-old Deyvison De Los Santos of Amarillo.

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
