LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox defeated the Binghamton Rumble Ponies 6-5 on Wednesday night behind six runs in the first three innings. **Jud Fabian** hammered his team-leading ninth homer of the season, a two-run shot in the first. **Samuel Basallo**, **John Rhodes** and **Ryan Higgins** all collected RBI to put Bowie in front 6-1 through three innings. Binghamton closed the deficit to within one in the sixth but **Nick Richmond** and **Morgan McSweeney** escaped first and third jams and **Keagan Gillies** recorded his first save of the year to seal the win.

BASALLO IS HOT

Over his last 15 games, C **Samuel Basallo** is batting .375 (21-for-56) with three homers, two doubles, 11 RBI and an OPS of 1.015. With an RBI single and a walk yesterday, Basallo extended his season-long on-base streak to 13 consecutive games, two games shy of matching Dylan Beavers' 15 game on-base streak, which is the longest on the team this season. The Orioles No. 2 prospect has collected the fifth-most hits in the league (54).

FABIAN LETS IT FLY

OF **Jud Fabian** blasted his team-leading ninth homer of the season last night with a 411 foot blast in the first inning. The Orioles No. 12 prospect hit six of his nine homers on the season in the month of May, which was tied for the most in the league along with Harrisburg's Brady House. The 23-year-old is in a four way tie for fourth in the Eastern League in home runs with Harrisburg's Brady House and Erie's Hao-Yu Lee and Chris Meyers.

BUCKLING BINGHAMTON

In eight games against Binghamton this year, Bowie's pitching staff has recorded a 1.54 ERA in 70 innings, the lowest by any Eastern League team against the Rumble Ponies this season. Baysox starters have combined to give up just seven earned runs over 30.2 innings thrown (2.05 ERA).

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (251.2) and strikeouts (299). Conversely, Bowie's starters have thrown the fewest number of innings in the league and in all of Double-A (204.0). Sunday was the first six-inning start by a Baysox starting pitcher all season. The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.20 WHIP, which is good for fifth-lowest in Double-A.

WE LIKE WESTON

RHP **Cameron Weston** makes his third start of the season and his seventh overall outing with the Baysox. The 23-year-old is coming off his shortest start of the season where he went 0.2 innings and gave up four runs on two hits and walked a season-high three last Friday at Somerset. Weston started his Double-A career in the bullpen for four games before being bumped into the rotation on May 25. The right-hander has allowed two runs and struck out nine in 7.2 innings this season against Binghamton.

SADDLING UP THE PONIES

Entering this week, the Binghamton Rumble Ponies are third in the Northeast Division at 26-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Mets most recently split their six game series against Harrisburg at home. The last time Bowie and Binghamton met was from May 14 - May 19 and Bowie won four of six at Mirabito Stadium. Seven of the Mets' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- OF/1B Ryan Clifford (No. 4), C Kevin Parada (No. 9), RHP Brandon Sproat (No. 13), OF Alex Ramirez (No. 16), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 18), RHP Nolan McLean (No. 19), RHP Joander Suarez (No. 28).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Tyler Stuart makes his 10th start of the season tonight. The 24-year-old has struck out the most batters on the team (52) and has thrown the second-most innings on the team (47.1). Last time Stuart faced Bowie, the Mets No. 18 prospect threw seven innings and struck out a season-high nine batters but gave up three runs on seven hits on May 18 at Mirabito Stadium. In his most recent start against Harrisburg last Friday, Stuart struck out six over five innings of three-run ball in a no decision. This is Stuart's second season with the Rumble Ponies after debuting last year in July.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011.
