NEWS & NOTES

CAROLINA SHOWERS: Hudson Valley's first-ever game in Asheville on Tuesday was postponed due to inclement weather. It will be made up as part of a doubleheader on Wednesday, with game one beginning at 5:05 P.M. This will be the second doubleheader of the season for the Renegades, after a game was postponed in Brooklyn on April 11th.

CONSISTENCY: The Renegades swept the Wilmington Blue Rocks last week, securing another series victory. Hudson Valley has still not lost a series since July 2024, when they dropped four of six to the Blue Rocks at Frawley Stadium. Since then, the Renegades have won seven series and split three, including a seven-game sweep of Wilmington last August.

SWEEPERS: The Renegades swept their series with the Blue Rocks on Sunday, which is Hudson Valley's third series sweep of six-or-more games since 7/30/24. The Renegades swept Jersey Shore in a six-game set from 7/30/24-8/4/24, and Wilmington in a seven-game series from 8/20-25/24, both at home. Prior to this run, the Renegades only had one six-game sweep in franchise history, from 7/4-10/22 at Jersey Shore.

HOME BODIES: Hudson Valley has started 8-1 at home in 2025, having won eight straight at Heritage Financial Park following a season-opening loss. With three series victories at home in 2025, the 'Gades have not lost a series at home since September 2023. During that time span of 16 home series, the Renegades have won 13 and split just three of them. The Renegades are 55-20 (.733) at home since the start of the 2024 season, the best record in MiLB.

STARTING STRONG: Starting pitching was excellent down the stretch in 2024 for the Renegades, and a new crew of pitchers is off to a outstanding start in 2025. Last week against Wilmington, Renegades starters have combined for a 1.35 ERA in 33.1 IP, allowing just five earned runs and striking out 48 batters. In 15 games, Hudson Valley starters have 98 punchouts in 72.1 innings, good for a 12.2 K/9 clip. Those 98 strikeouts are the most in MiLB among all non-AAA teams and are tied for the second-highest tally overall, despite AAA teams playing six more games. The staff has also issued just 26 walks during that stretch, a BB rate of 3.2%.

A NEW FRONTIER: For the first time in franchise history, the Renegades travel to historic McCormick Field this week to face the Asheville Tourists in a six-game series. Despite the Renegades and Tourists being in the same league since 2021, this will be only the second time these two teams have ever faced off. The High-A affiliate of the Houston Astros traveled to Heritage Financial Park for the first time in the final week of the 2024 season, with Hudson Valley taking four of six games. McCormick Field is one of the oldest ballparks in MiLB, having been built in 1924. It has been home to the Tourists during that entire timespan. Asheville features six of the top 30 prospects in the Astros organization, including No. 4 prospect and 2024 first round pick Walker Janek.

HEAD-TO-HEAD DOMINANCE: Last week, Josh Moylan continued his excellent hitting against the Wilmington Blue Rocks. The Renegades infielder drove in seven runs in the series, notching three doubles and a home run. In 31 games over the last two seasons against Wilmington, Moylan has driven in 20 runs, recorded 14 extra-base hits, and reached base safely 45 times. During that span, Moylan is slashing .287/.352/.504 with an .856 OPS.

DOMINICAN FLAMETHROWER: Hard-throwing right-hander Carlos Lagrange was outstanding on Tuesday night in his home debut at Heritage Financial Park, allowing just two hits in six innings while striking out a career-high nine batters. After issuing a leadoff walk in the first, Lagrange retired 11 in a row, not allowing a baserunner until the fifth inning.

ENEMY TURNED FRIEND: Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz turned in arguably the best performance of any Renegades starter this season on Friday, tossing 6.2 frames while allowing just three hits and one run. The Yankees No. 7 prospect retired 14 in a row from the first inning until the leadoff batter in the sixth. Rodriguez-Cruz became the fourth consecutive Hudson Valley pitcher to record nine strikeouts, and the first to pitch into the seventh inning this season. The former Boston prospect was the second Renegade to record a quality start this season.

MISSING HOME: While being the best team at home in MiLB last season, the Renegades struggled on the road. The Renegades finished 26-39 away from Heritage Financial Park, the third-most road losses in the South Atlantic League. They have started 3-3 in 2025, and begin their second road series of the season in Asheville this week.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER: Hudson Valley's bullpen looks sharp early this season, recording a 2.43 ERA through 15 games, the best mark in High-A and fifth-best in MiLB. The closest competitor in High-A is West Michigan (A+, DET), who has a 3.24 ERA. Renegades relievers are holding opponents to a .187 opposing average, while striking out 64 batters in 55.2 innings. On Sunday, Hueston Morrill, Hayden Merda, and Cole Ayers combined for 5.2 scoreless innings, allowing just three hits and issuing only one walk. Over the final four games of the series last week, the pitching staff as a whole allowed just three total earned runs in 36 innings of work.

TEENAGE SPARK: George Lombard Jr. is off to a tremendous start in his first full season in High-A. The Yankees No. 1 prospect has reached base safely in 12 of 13 games he has played this season, the third-longest on-base streak in the South Atlantic League in 2025. On Tuesday, Lombard hit his first career High-A homer, going 2-for-2 with three RBIs and two walks. During his 12-game on-base streak that was snapped Sunday, the 19-year-old hit .333 with a .500 on-base percentage, .987 OPS, 11 runs scored, and seven stolen bases. The Yankees No. 1 prospect is having no problems competing with older players at the High-A level.

VANDY POWER: Bryce Cunningham, the Yankees 2nd round pick in 2024, was tremendous on Saturday night. The right-hander threw seven scoreless innings while allowing just four hits, becoming the first Renegades starter this season to complete seven innings. With his nine strikeouts, Cunningham became the fifth consecutive Renegades starter to record nine strikeouts. In recording a quality start, he also became the third Hudson Valley starter to do this season and the second in two nights. The Alabama native struck out 96 batters in 84.2 innings as a junior at Vanderbilt in 2024.

THE HESS TRUCK IS HERE: Ben Hess took the mound on Wednesday for the first time at Heritage Financial Park and continued his early season success. The Yankees No. 3 prospect allowed just one unearned run across three hits in five innings. Hess matched his pro debut strikeout total with nine punchouts, marking the third time a Renegades starter has struck out nine batters this season. In 9.2 innings, he has yet to allow an earned runs two starts. Hess struggled with injuries in his first two seasons at Alabama, but was healthy in 2024 and was selected in the first round of the draft.

RBI MACHINE: Jackson Castillo continues to swing the bat well in High-A after joining the Renegades last season. He has a current 13-game on-base streak spanning back to September 2024. During that span, Castillo has eight RBIs, four doubles, and a .411 on-base percentage. The Renegades outfielder had a tremendous night at the plate last Thursday, going 3-for-5 with two doubles and six RBIs. The Renegades outfielder notched two bases-clearing doubles in consecutive plate appearances, driving in six of Hudson Valley's eight runs in the game. It's the second time in 26 games with the Renegades that Castillo has driven in six runs or more in a game.

STAR-STUDDIED: To begin the 2025 season, the Renegades have SEVEN of the top 30 prospects in the New York Yankees system, which includes five pitchers. Yankees No. 1 prospect and 98th-ranked MLB prospect George Lombard Jr. is back with the Renegades, and No. 19 Yankees prospect Kyle Carr is on Hudson Valley's Opening Day roster for the second straight year. He made his first career Opening Day start on April 4th. The Renegades also welcome the Yankees' top two picks from the 2025 Draft in pitchers Ben Hess and Bryce Cunningham, making their professional debuts. Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz, the Yankees No. 7 prospect who was acquired in an offseason trade with the Boston Red Sox, starts his New York career with the Gades'. Dominican Carlos Lagrange (Yankees No. 18 prospect) also makes his High-A debut. OF Brendan Jones recently joined the Yankees Top 30 (#30) after the graduation of Yoendrys Gomez.

LAST TIME OUT: Hess followed up a strong debut with another good start last Wednesday against the Wilmington Blue Rocks, completing 5.0 innings and allowing one unearned run on three hits with two walks and nine strikeouts. The right-hander picked up the first win of his professional career as the Renegades hung on for a 10-7 victory while fending off a late-game charge by the Blue Rocks. The lone run allowed by Hess came home on a passed ball by catcher Omar Martinez on a passed ball in the third.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season in on the Renegades Break Camp Roster.
- Struck out nine batters in his professional debut on 4/9 at Brooklyn: 4.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 9 K on 70 pitches.

RECORD SETTER: While at Alabama, Hess set the program's all-time record with 13.34 K/9, while striking out 34.6% of batters he faced in three seasons.

FIRST TIME, LONG TIME: When Hess was drafted by the Yankees in the 1st round of the 2024 MLB Draft, he became the first pitcher taken by the Yankees with their first pick since they took **Clarke Schmidt** 16th overall in the 2017 MLB Draft. In between, the Yankees selected position players **Anthony Seigler** (2018), **Anthony Volpe** (2019), **Austin Wells** (2020), **Trey Sweeney** (2021), **Spencer Jones** (2022), and **George Lombard** (2023) with their first picks in six consecutive drafts. It was the longest run of position players selected by the Yankees with their first pick in the history of the Yankees. Hess is just the second four-year college pitcher drafted by the Yankees with their first pick since the team selected **Andrew Brackman** 30th overall in the 2007 MLB Draft, and the fourth since the Yankees drafted **Dave Walling** 27th overall in 1999 (also **Ian Kennedy**, 21st overall in 2006).

WE WANT 'BAMA: Hess became only the fifth player from the University of Alabama to be drafted in the first round of the First-Year Player Draft when he was selected 26th overall by the Yankees in 2024. He joined first baseman Joe Vitiello (seventh overall in 1991 by the Kansas City Royals), catcher Jeremy Brown (35th overall in 2002 by the Oakland Athletics), LHP Taylor Tankersley (27th overall in 2004 by the Florida Marlins) and RHP Tommy Hunter (54th overall in 2007 by the Texas Rangers). The Athletics' drafting of Brown was chronicled in the best-selling book Moneyball by Michael Lewis, but was omitted from the Hollywood film of the same name. Arguably the most-successful Crimson Tide alumni to play Major League Baseball was Hall of Fame Joe Sewell, who played for Cleveland (1920-30) and the Yankees (1931-33), batting .312 lifetime and being regarded as the hardest player to strike out in MLB history, fanning just 114 times in 8333 career plate appearances (1.4 K%).

PERSONAL:

- Full name is Benjamin William Hess.
- Signed with the Yankees on July 22, 2024 for a below-slot \$2,747,500 bonus.
- Dealt with injury concerns in high school and during his first two collegiate seasons, including a right flexor strain that limited him to seven games in 2023.
- Over his college career at Alabama (2022-24), Hess posted a 12-6 record and a 4.81 ERA in 33 games (30 starts) and set the program record with 13.34 K/9 in his career.
- Named a preseason 3rd Team All-American by D1 Baseball and Baseball America in 2024.
- At Charleston (IL) HS, ranked #1 right-handed pitcher in Illinois and #2 overall prospect by Perfect Game, and #72 overall in class, while MaxPreps ranked him the #1 player in Illinois.
- Was ranked as the #38 overall prospect by Baseball America and #44 by MLB Pipeline in the 2024 draft class.

LAST TIME OUT: In his Heritage Financial Park debut, Lagrange dominated the Wilmington Blue Rocks, striking out nine batters across 6.0 innings and picking up the win in a 4-2 Hudson Valley series-opening win last Tuesday. He allowed two runs on two hits and one walk. The right-hander allowed a two-run double to Marcus Brown in the top of the fifth.

LIMITED DUTIES: Lagrange's 2024 season was hampered by lower back inflammation which limited him to only 21.0 innings during the regular season. Owing to that, the hard-throwing right-hander enters his fourth professional season in 2025 with fewer than 100.0 professional innings pitched.

TOUCHING TRIPLE DIGITS: Lagrange has always been a hard thrower, and in the 2025 Yankees Spring Breakout Game against Orioles prospects, Lagrange got the start for the Yankees squad, throwing four innings and allowing two runs (one earned), two hits, two strikeouts and no walks. One of the most eye-opening moments was his pitches being clocked at 100 mph.

FALL STAR: Following the 2024 season, Lagrange pitched for the Salt River Rafters of the prestigious Arizona Fall League to solid results. In five games (four starts), Lagrange posted a 2.08 ERA (2 ER/8.2 IP), and struck out 10 batters. However, he also issued 15 walks to 43 total batters faced, a shocking 34.8% walk rate.

BREAKING BALL ADJUSTMENTS: Like many pitchers in the Yankees system, Lagrange features two distinct sliders. He throws a sweeper (82-85), and a harder, shorter slider in the upper 80s. He previously threw a curveball, which he has mostly scrapped as a pitch, although reportedly he was throwing the curve some in the Arizona Fall League.

- Picked up his first professional win and set a new career-high in innings, strikeouts and pitches thrown on 4/15 vs Wilmington: 6.0 IP, 2 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 9 K, 75 pitches, 51 strikes.
