ABOUT LAST NIGHT... The Hillsboro Hops (Diamondbacks) twirled their third complete game shutout in franchise history as Brandon Pfaadt kept the Vancouver Canadians off balance in a 2-0 loss Wednesday evening at Ron Tonkin Field.

Pfaadt was the story of the night. The 22-year-old tossed nine shutout innings, allowed four hits, walked one and struck out five to earn the win and make history.

The only serious challenge the C's mustered came in the sixth. Rafael Lantigua doubled with two outs before Tanner Morris singled to left field. Lantigua got the wave as he tried to score from second base but a strong throw nailed him at the plate to preserve the shutout and keep the Hops ahead 2-0.

Hillsboro did what they needed to do on offense to back Pfaadt's gem. The Hops plated a pair in the bottom of the second thanks to three hits - including an RBI double from Dom Canzone - off of Canadians starter Paxton Schultz (L, 3-2). Despite those two runs, Schultz was otherwise solid through five innings in which he scattered six hits, walked two and struck out seven.

Adrian Hernandez took over in the sixth and logged three scoreless innings with one hit, two walks and five strikeouts.

Ryan Gold and Eric Rivera were the only other two C's hitter to record a hit. Gold doubled with one out in the second but was stranded at third and Rivera singled with two outs in the eighth.

BATTLE FOR THE 'BORO: Vancouver and Hillsboro go head-to-head this week in their second of five week-long meetings this season. The C's took four of six May 18-23 when they outscored the Hops 32-22, including a 13-4 romp in the series opener on May 18 that featured a season-high 18 hits and the first of two instances where the Canadians plated 13 runs.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ROSTER MOVES: The Toronto Blue Jays activated RHP Nick Fraze and OF Cameron Eden prior to tonight's game. Fraze has been on the IL since June 16 while Eden was laid up on July 2 with a hamstring strain.

ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS HISTORY: July 15, 2014 - Vancouver twice rallied from behind to beat Eugene 13-7 at The Nat on this date seven years ago. Ryan McBroom's two-run homer in the third tied the game 5-5 before a pair of Emeralds errors in the fifth put the Canadians up 8-7. A five-run eighth put the game out of reach. Tim Mayza earned the win with three innings of relief while Joe Lovecchio and Jose Fernandez combined on the final three frames and kept the Padres affiliate scoreless.

BLANKED: The C's were shutout for the third time this season last night. It was the first time they failed to score since June 10 in Spokane, when they lost 8-0. Vancouver has been kept off the board for the last 10.1 innings; their season long is 12.2 frames May 4-5.

T.G.I.T.: Vancouver is 7-3 on Thursdays this year, their second-best record on any given day of the week (Sundays, 8-2).

FEELING BULLISH: The Canadians have K'd 613 hitters this year. Of those, 319 belong to the bullpen over the course of 277.1 innings pitched. Brandon Eisert leads all relievers with 53 punch outs.

ON THE HILL: Nick Fraze returns to action tonight after a month on the Injured List with an elbow issue. He last worked June 4 against Eugene when he took the loss after a season-low 3.1 innings in which he allowed four runs (two earned) on six hits - a season high - walked three and K'd three. Fraze, 23, had proven himself to be one of Vancouver's most dominant and consistent pitchers through the first month of the season; he turned in three consecutive quality starts (May 14, May 21, May 28) and allowed three earned runs on nine hits with three walks and 19 strikeouts in those 18 innings of work. He faced Hillsboro on May 21 and surrendered a single run on three hits with a pair of walks and six strike outs but did not factor into the decision. The Dallas, TX native was a 22nd round pick (657th overall) in 2019 out of Texas State.

MLB.com's #6 Diamondbacks prospect Slade Cecconi takes the ball for Hillsboro. In his last turn on July 9 at Tri-City, the right-hander earned the win with five innings in which he gave up two runs on six hits with one walk and a season-high seven strikeouts. Tonight is his second outing against Vancouver; he went 3.2 stanzas in his second career start on May 21 and gave up a Ryan Gold home run. From MLB.com: "Cecconi has the prototypical pitcher frame at 6-foot-4 and he has an electric fastball to go with it, touching 97-98 mph this past summer. His slider is a true out pitch and is right up there with Levi Kelly's for the best in the system. He also throws a curveball and changeup. He showed improvement with the change at the team's alternate training site."
