LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox took home a 2-1 win over Harrisburg on Tuesday night. Dylan Beavers singled home the game's first run in the top of the third, while Jud Fabian tallied three hits of his own, including a solo home run in the top of the ninth. RHP Alex Pham started and posted a season-high six shutout innings. Harrisburg got a run back in the bottom of the ninth, but **Keagan Gillies** stranded the tying and go-ahead runs in scoring position to pick up the save.

BASALLO BITS

During his team-high 18-game on-base streak, C/1B Samuel Basallo is hitting .362 with a 1.081 OPS. Basallo's five home runs during that stretch are fifth-most in the league. The 19-year-old is the youngest player in the Eastern League this season. He currently has the fifth-most hits (61) and home runs (10) of all qualified players. Basallo's on-base streak is tied with Portland's Blaze Jordan for the longest active streak in the league and the fourth-longest overall this season.

TEENAGE DREAM

With his two-run shot Friday night, Samuel Basallo became just the ninth teenager to reach 10 home runs in a season at the Double-A level since the year 2005. Basallo is the first teen in the Eastern League to reach the mark since Vladimir Guerrero Jr did so with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats in 2018. Basallo's 55 games to reach 10 Double-A home runs makes him the third-fastest teenager to do so since 2005. Only Guerrero (44 GP in 2018) and Giancarlo Stanton (41 GP in 2009) reached 10 HR in fewer games.

ON-BASE BEAVERS

OF/1B Dylan Beavers has reached base in 42 of 48 games started in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect leads the team in OBP (.371) and leads the team in walks (30), the sixth-most in the Eastern League. Tuesday was the ninth time Beavers reached base at least three times in a game this season.

TERRY TWO BAGS

Baysox RF/1B ${f TT}$ ${f Bowens}$ hit his team-leading 15th double of the season on Saturday night - tying him for the third-most in the Eastern League this season. Bowens has been a clutch bat for Bowie, leading the team with 34 RBI and hitting .308 with runners in scoring position - tied for the best mark on the team.

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (277.2) and strikeouts (322). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.18 WHIP, which is good for fourth-lowest in Double-A.

HITTING IN BUNCHES

Bowie's **Jud Fabian** tallied three hits on Tuesday night. It marked the fifth game of at least three hits for Fabian on the season - the most on the team. Fabian also has both four-hit performances from the Baysox this season. Fabian's tenth home run of the season on Tuesday tied him with Samuel Basallo for the team lead and fifth-most in the leauge.

SCOUTING THE SENATORS

Entering this week, the Harrisburg Senators sit at 32-25 on the season - tied for second in the Eastern League Southwest division and just a game out of first place. Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, the Senators are led by second-year manager and former Baysox player (1999) Delino DeShields. Harrisburg's roster includes four of the Nationals' top 8 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - OF Dylan Crews (WSH No. 2/MLB. No. 6), IF Brady House (WSH No. 3/MLB No. 36), IF Yohandy Morales (No. 4 WSH/MLB No. 88), and OF Robert Hassell III (No. 8 WSH).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Brad Lord is tonight's projected starter for Harrisburg. An 18th round pick of the Nationals in 2022 out of South Florida, Lord has taken the Eastern League by storm in 2024, as he sports a league-best 1.75 ERA through 56.2 innings, while siting second with six wins. Lord took home Eastern League Pitcher of the Month honors in May, allowing just three earned runs in 31 innings, winning all five of his starts. This will be Lord's first career start against Bowie.

Promoted from High-A Aberdeen on Apr. 30 after posting 2nd-lowest ERA in South Atlantic League Struck out eight batters over 4.0 scoreless innings in Double-A debut to record first Double-A win

2024: Threw longest outing of Double-A career in most recent start on Thu. 6/6 vs BNG. Went 5.0 IP, gave up just 1 H, 2 BB and struck out 6 to pick up win. Opposing batters hitting just .170 against him. Holds a 6.48 ERA on the road over 8.1 innings. Lasted just 0.2 IP on 5/31 @ SOM in last road start, the shortest outing of his Double-A career. Made first career Double-A start on 5/25 vs RIC. Pitched 4.0 IP, gave up 2 H, 2 R on a 2-R HR, 1 BB and struck out 3 to receive the loss. Bumped into rotation beginning on 5/25 after beginning Double-A career with four relief outings. Promoted to Double-A Bowie on April 30. First IronBird to be promoted to Double-A this season. Made Double-A win. At time of promotion, posted a 0.54 ERA over 16.2 IP with 19 K/7 BB. Held 2nd-lowest ERA in South Atlantic League. Started season in High-A Aberdeen and was Opening Night starter.

2023: Spent most of first half on IL with tendonitis suffered during Spring Training. Debuted in Aberdeen on June 15 after a one-game rehab appearance with FCL Orioles. Threw 40.1 IP, struck out 49 batters over 12 walks to an ERA of 2.68 in first full season in minors. Nine of his 12 appearances came out of the bullpen in bulk relief situations.

2022: Debuted in Single-A Delmarva in and made five appearances out of bullpen. Posted a 3.18 ERA over 11.1 innings with 11 strikeouts over three walks and 0.79 WHIP.

Worked as a starter for most of his career at Michigan until midway through his final season when he was pushed into the closer role. The- "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™ or "Fun Cup™" During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticuthe began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assist ant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2023 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1.363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

BILLY FACTEAU

Development Coach

A familiar face in Bowie, Facteau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022.
