SEVEN-RUN COMEBACK NETS CARDS FRANCHISE RECORD: Matt

Lloyd hit a three-run homer with two outs in the bottom of the eighth inning to cap a five-run inning as the Cardinals came all the way back from down 7-1 to defeat the Wichita Wind Surge on Sunday afternoon at Hammons Field, setting a new franchise record with their 9th straight win. Nathan Church had three hits for Springfield, and RJ Yeager continued his torrid start to the season going 1-for-2 to extend his season-opening hitting streak to 8 games. Ryan Shreve picked up his first win of the season with 2.0 innings of shutout relief and Leonard Taveras notched his first save with a scoreless 9th.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Jamison Hill** makes his second start of the season for Amarillo...Allowed 4 R (all earned) on 8 H with 7 K in 4.1 IP in his first start of the season against Midland on Wednesday, April 10...Spent all of the 2023 season with the Sod Poodles, going 7-6 with a 4.35 ERA, allowing just 95 hits in 118.0 IP but also walking 74 with 104 K...Opponents batted .218 against him...In two starts against the Cardinals in 2023 went 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA...Made his Double-A debut in 2022 when he went 1-0 with a 6.30 ERA in 5 appearances (4 starts)...Also made 21 starts at High-A Hillsboro (7-7, 4.35) and one appearance with Low-A Visalia in 2022...Signed by the Diamondbacks as a in July 2021 after going undrafted out of Fresno State...As a senior in 2021, went 5-3 with a 5.23 ERA in 12 starts...Led Bulldogs with 72.1 IP...Step-grandfather is Garry Templeton who was a two-time All-Star with the Cardinals (1977 & 1979)...Played with St. Louis from 1976-81 as part of a 16-year MLB career (3x All-Star, 2x Silver Slugger)...Also played for the Padres and Mets...25 years old

RED-HOT CARDS HEAD TO LONE STAR STATE TO TAKE ON DEFENDING CHAMPS: The Cardinals make their first trip of the season to Texas, starting a six-game series against the Amarillo Sod Poodles (Double-A, Arizona Diamondbacks) starting on Tuesday at HODGETOWN. Springfield went 5-7 in 12 games against the Sod Poodles in 2023.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

CARDS SET NEW FRANCHISE MARK: With their come-from-behind 8-7 win over the Wichita Wind Surge on Sunday at Hammons Field, the Cardinals ran their season-opening winning streak to 9 games, a new franchise record for consecutive wins. Springfield had won three straight previously, from June 9-16, 2007 and from September 2-10 last season during a 17-6 run over 23 games to claim the North Division 2nd half crown.

The comeback win on Sunday also ran the best start in franchise history to 9-0, easily eclipsing the previous record of 2-0 which was done twice: 2016 & 2017.

The Cardinals' 6-0 start at Hammons Field is also their best start ever, as is their 3-0 start on the road. The Cards' previous record for best start to a season at home was 5-0 in 2019, while they won their first two games on the road twice (2014 & 2017).

SPRINGFIELD STANDS ALONE: The 9-0 Cardinals are the only reamining undefeated team in all of affiliated professional baseball. The Spokane Indians (High-A, Colorado Rockies) of the Northwest League were also 8-0 going into play on Sunday, but lost 4-2 to the Tri-Cities Dust Devils on Sunday afternoon

BIRDS' BATS TOP TEXAS LEAGUE EARLY: While the Cardinals haven't hit for a ton of power thusfar, Springfield's lineup sits atop the league in several offensive categories. Through nine games the Cardinals lead the Texas League, and all of Double-A, with a .303 batting average. The Cards are the only club at the Double-A level with a team average .300 or over; the New Hampshire Fisher Cats are next with a mark of .286. The Cards also lead the Texas League in OBP (.401), OPS (.815), and RBIs (54). Springfield has also been particularly prodcutive hitting situationally, with a league-high 7 sacrifice flies this season. The Redbirds' bat-to-ball skills have also been on display with just 54 K, fewest in the Texas League by 21 (Frisco, 75) and Double-A by 7.

LIGHTS OUT STAFF TO START CAMPAIGN: The Springfield pitching staff has also been up to the task for the Cards over their first nine games of the season. Through nine games, the Cardinals' staff is 2nd in the Texas league with a 2.88 ERA, and 1st with a 1.10 WHIP and .201 opponents' batting average. The Redbird staff has walked just 30 batters in 78.0 IP.

The Springfield bullpen has been stellar, putting together a 2.11 ERA while going 4-for-5 in save opportunities thusfar. The Cards' starting rotation owns 5 wins already, most in the circuit. No other Texas League team has more than 2.

The Cardinals' staff features 6 of the organization's top 30 prospects according to *MLB Pipeline*, including the top two in right-handers **Tink Hence** and **Tekoah Roby**.

YEAGER BOMBS: Through his first 8 games, **RJ Yeager** finds his name littered across the league leaderboard in several run production categories. The Mississippi State product's 11 RBIs leads the Texas League and **Yeager** finds himself tied for 3rd in home runs (3), one longball behind **Emmanuel Rodriguez** (WCH) and **Colby Thomas** (MID). **Yeager's** .750 SLG is good for 3rd, as is his 1.207 OPS and 21 total bases. He has hit safely in all 8 of his appearances so far.

TORRES A TERROR ON BASE PATHS: With 2 SB on both Saturday night and Sundayafternoon, Cardinals OF **Bryan Torres** took the lead in the Texas League with 7 SB. He has been caught just once. **Torres** racked up 71 bags for the Milwaukee Milkmen of the American Association in 2023.

FAMILIAR FACES: Of the 28 players on the Cardinals' Opening Day roster, 13 donned a Springfield uniform in 2023. Of the newcomers, only two Cards, Bryan Torres (Richmond, 2021) and Matt Lloyd (Chattanooga, 2021-22), have Double-A experience. Slugger Chandler Redmond returns for another season in Springfield after coming up one home run shy of the Springfield franchise record in 2023 with 31 longballs. Redmond also sits two home runs shy of Springfield's franchise career record of 59 by Xavier Scruggs.

Cardinals skpper **Jose Leger** is back for his fourth year as manager in Springfield.
