### SERIES HISTORY (528 GAMES)

Omaha and Nashville played each other regularly from 1985-1997 (American Association) and 1998-2019 (Pacific Coast League).

In the modern PCL (2005-2019), the teams had 16 games scheduled against each other each season, typically 8 in Omaha and 8 in Nashville.

With a move to the International League for both teams, they did not play each other in 2021and again were not scheduled for games in 2022, despite playing in the same division.

The last series Omaha and Nashville played was August 26-29 at Werner Park, with Omaha taking the first two games and Nashville winning the last two.

PAPILLION, NEB. – After falling behind early in 1st inning, the Omaha Storm Chasers quickly stormed back to provide run support for starting pitcher Mike Mayers and beat the Gwinnert Stripers 5-3 Sunday afternoon the salvage the series and avoid a sweep.

Mayers allowed 3 runs on 4 hits in the 1st, but settled into a groove in the 2nd, retiring 13 of his last 17 batters for his 1st win of the season in his 2nd start of the week.

10 of 18 runs Mayers has allowed this year have come in the first inning, this was his third of five starts this year where he allowed first-inning runs, then shut down the offense across the rest of his outing.

The Chasers opened each of the first four innings with a baserunner and began to chip away at Gwinnett in the 2nd inning, as CJ Alexander opened the inning with a single, then scored on an Angelo Castellano RBI single. Omaha quickly tied the game in the 3rd, as five straight hits opened the frame, with an RBI double from Maikel Garcia that scored Dairon Blanco, and an RBI single from Tyler Gentry that plated Garcia.

In the 4th, Tucker Bradley walked to open the inning, advanced to second on a wild pitch, stole his first of two bases in the game, then scored moments later on another RBI single from Castellano that gave Omaha a 4-3 lead that the team didn't relinquish.

After Mayers settled into his groove on the mound, Omaha's bullpen backed him up, as Jackson Kowar pitched a scoreless 6th inning. Evan Sisk fired a scoreless 7th and Collin Snider produced a 1-2-3 8th, before Nick Wittgren came on in the 9th.

Wittgren retired all three batters he faced to earn his second save of the season, combining with Snider and Sisk to retire the final seven Stripers hitters of the evening.

Omaha added a run of insurance in the 8th, as Jakson Reetz doubled home Nick Pratto, a hit that gave all nine Storm Chasers in the lineup a base hit in the game. Blanco, Nick Loftin and Castellano each had two hits, while Blanco stole three bases, Bradley stole two and Alexander stole one for a season

Bradley stole two and Alexander stole one for a season-high six steals as a team.

### **PICK A NICK**

The three Nick's on the Storm Chasers all had very different weeks in last week's series

Mick Pratto led the Storm Chasers with 12 TB, 2 HR & 5 RBI last week ... Pratto enters tonight on a five-game hitting streak, a stretch where he's gone going 5-for-17 (.294) with 1 double, his first 2 homers of the season and a pair of sacrifice flies.
 After being the standout in the team's last road series in Des Moines, Nick Loftin went just 3-for-23 (.130) at the plate last week, with six strikeouts ... he opened the series 0-for-15 before singling Friday and adding a pair of hits Sunday.
 Nick Wittgren has assumed the role as Omaha's closer, with 7 of his 8 outings corplete and helf of this anneasones perfect retiring every batter faced. he has a series and helf of this anneasones perfect retiring nearly batter faced.

scoreless and half of his appearances perfect, retiring every batter faced ... he has retired his last 10 hitters faced and has not allowed a run in 6.0 innings.

### **ROLLING IN THE DEEP**

Every game in last week's series vs. Gwinnett saw Omaha's starting pitchers throw at least 5.0 innings, after just two starts of 5.0 IP or more in the first 13 games.

Last week, Omaha starters have combined to allow 13 earned runs in 33.0 innings (3.55 ERA), including quality starts from Mike Mayers and Jonathan Heasley.
Even when they go deep into games, receiving run support has been a challenge for Omaha starters, who are averaging just 2.32 runs of support per game ... when receiving at least 3 runs of support, Omaha starters are 6-1, compared to 2-10 when cetting less than 2 runs of support. getting less than 2 runs of support ... the team is 8-1 when recording at least 10 hits, but 0-10 when getting 10 hits or less.

#### SAMAD (TAYLOR'S VERSION)

Samad Taylor led off the first 18 games of the season for Omaha and gone 24-for-77 at the plate, with 7 extra-base hits and 15 runs batted in, he got his first day off Sunday.

He has collected multiple hits in 8 different games this season, including each of the first 4, with hits in 15 of the 18 games he's played ... he's reached base in 17 of 18, including each of the last 12 games, Omaha's longest on-base streak this year.

His 24 hits rank tied 8th in the International League, while he ranks tied 6th with 8 steals ... 8 steals are tied 7th in Triple-A as well.

### **SOMETHING'S BREWING**

Brewer Hicklen was activated from the 7-Day Injured List earlier today, after opening the season on Omaha's IL (right elbow strain).

Hicklen was named the Royals Triple-A Player of the Year last year for Omaha and set career-highs in doubles (30), home runs (28), runs batted in (85) and runs scored (85) ... he finished just two homers shy of a 30/30/30 season (HR/SB/2B).

#### **FREDDY FERMIN'S BUSINESS**

Added to Kansas City's 40-man roster in November, catcher **Freddy Fermin** was recalled by the Royals on Friday (April 21) and started Sunday for Kansas City.

In the Royals' 4-3 loss to the Angels Sunday, Fermin recorded his first MLB hit in the 3rd inning off lefty *Reid Detmers* a 103.3 MPH single to left field.

Fermin's average exit velocity of 92.7 MPH still leads Omaha hitters this season, with a tour best 100-bits put in 19x1 100 MPH or barden.

## MANAGER: Mike Jirschele • #23

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Widger during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Widger's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Frame He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.



## PITCHING COACH: Dane Johnson • #59

- **pane Johnson** enters his fourth year in the Royals organization and as the Storm Chasers pitching coach, after joining Kansas City ahead of the 2020 season. 2023 marks his 24th season coaching overall.

- **Bijan Rademacher** (bi-ZHON RAH-de-moch-err) joins the Royals as the Omaha Storm Chasers Hitting Coach this year after spending the last two years with the Arizona Diamondbacks as their Minor League Hitting Coordinator (2021) and ACL Hitting Coach (2022).

- Stone graduated with a bachelor's of science in kinesiology from Cal State-Northridge. He resides in Simi Valley, California with his dog, Ozzie.




