FISHER CATS SWEEP DOUBLEHEADER: New Hampshire picked up 6-1 and 3-2 victories in Wednesday's doubleheader, earning the first doubleheader sweep of the season. Nick Pokul and Chavez Young homered in game one, and the combined efforts of Fitz Stadler, Marcus Reyes, Graham Spraker, and Connor Law limited the Sea Dogs to just two hits in game two.

UP NEXT: The Fisher Cats meet the Portland Sea Dogs (Boston Red Sox) for the fifth of six series on the season. The last series between these teams resulted in only four games being completed, with a projected eight-game series being played in the final meeting of these teams in early September. The Fisher Cats will return to Delta Dental Stadium for a six-game set against the Hartford Yard Goats (Colorado Rockies) next week. The last time the Fisher Cats played at Hadlock Field, they took the final four games of the series.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: July 30, 2008—Travis Snider, J P Arencibia, and Kyle Phillips each drove in two runs as the Fisher Cats rolled to a 9-2 win over Portland in Manchester. New Hampshire was already ahead 2-0 when they scored six times in the bottom of the fourth. Starter Robert Ray allowed one unearned run in his seven innings to pick up the win.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays clobbered the Red Sox 13-1 in the finale of the four-game series in Boston. Vladimir Guerrero Jr. hit his 33rd home run, a three-run shot in the fifth. Reese McGuire had three doubles for Toronto. Kirby Sneed pitched a scoreless ninth with three strikeouts....Triple-A Buffalo split at Worcester, falling 7-0 before taking game two, 8-1. Just promoted Rodrigo Vigil had two hits in the nightcap...Spokane rallied late for an 11-10 win over Vancouver...Dunedin 3 Bradenton 1. 19-year old Sem Robberse (Zeist, Netherlands) allowed one run in seven innings for the Jays. DSL Jays beat the Padres 11-1.

KYLE FANTASTIC: Kyle Johnston, who had a 16.1 innings scoreless streak as a starter (May 13-June 1), has now worked 14.1 scoreless outings dating back to June 20. He has had nine consecutive scoreless outings.

HIT PARADE: Otto Lopez is currently tied for most hits in all of Double-A (89). His .337 average ranks second among all Double-A players. Austin Martin OBP of .424 is second in Double-A.

STARTERS:

Johnny Barbato takes the mound for New Hampshire this evening. Barbato did not factor in the decision in his last outing, going 4.2 innings and giving up five runs on eight hits to Reading, also walking six. HE has a 1-2 record with an ERA of 5.09 with the Fisher Cats.

Victor Santos, recently acquired by the Red Sox as the PTBNL in the C.J. Chatham deal, will make his first start against New Hampshire this evening. He went three innings in relief in his only appearance for Portland, picking up the loss after giving up one run on three hits to Harrisburg.
