LEADIN' OFF WITH LEANDRO: Hub City has sent Leandro Lopez to the mound to begin each of the last seven series. The Spartanburgers are 5-3 in series openers so far this season. Across his last 5 starts, Lopez has tossed 25.2 innings with just 4 earned runs and 29 strikeouts.

BURGER MAGIC: Hub City had just one walk-off win through its first three series at Fifth Third Park. The Spartanburgers walked off Rome in three of their four wins last week. On Saturday, Quincy Scott scorched a two-run base hit to end the game in the 12th inning. Scott entered the game in the 9th as a pinch-runner for Arturo Disla. Dylan Dreiling hit the walk-off on Wednesday and Jhocsuanth Vargas was the hero Thursday in his High-A debut.

SHUT DOWN STARTS: Hub City's starters put together their best week of the season against Rome. Every starter across the six-game series lasted at least four innings. The Emperors scores just three earned runs against the HC starters (0.87 ERA). David Davalillo tied a career high with 10 strikeouts. Leandro Lopez, Josh Trentadue, D.J. McCarty and Jose Gonzalez all set new season highs with innings pitched.

HOMERS IN THE UPSTATE: Hub City has managed to hit every home run of its season at either Fifth Third Park in Spartanburg or Fluor Field in Greenville. Hub City has hit 22 homers in 24 games at home. In the first three road trips, the Spartanburgers did not hit a single home run. In just six games at the Drive, the Spartanburgers left the park eight times.

LATE GAME LEADERS: The Spartanburgers are outscoring opponents 58-43 in the final three innings. Hub City has put up 18 runs in the seventh. The Spartanburgers have scored just 14 in the eighth, and then 26 in the ninth. Hub City leads the league in ninth inning runs. The Spartanburgers are also 19-1 in games with a lead after six innings.

2024 v. WS: The Hickory Crawdads battled against the Winston-Salem Dash for two series last year, finishing with a 6-6 record. After splitting the first series of the year. Hickory hosted Winston-Salem for three games before going on the road for three games during the week of July 4. The home team won all six games in that series.

The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the Down East

Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager, and Chad Comer serves as the first manager in Spartanburger's history.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ball-park seats over 5,000 people. The Johnson



Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Sprartanburgers game is the home opener in 2025 against Bowling Green.



Chad Comer - Manager

Chad Comer is the first ever manager of the Hub City Spartanburgers. He enters his tenth year as a coach in the minor leagues and joins Hub City after two seasons as the manager of the then-High-A Hickory Crawdads. Comer played collegiately for the University of Texas-Arlington. A four-year starter, he was named to the Buster Posey Watch List prior to his senior season. He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves, and he played two seasons of minor league baseball.



Drew Sannes - Hitting Coach

Drew Sannes joins the Hub City Spartanburgers as the hitting coach for the 2025 season after spending the past two years as the hitting coach for the Hickory Crawdads. In 2022, Sannes served as a development coach for the ACL Rangers. His coaching career began in 2020 when he served as the head coach at North Iowa Community College. As a player, Sannes started his collegiate career at the University of North Dakota. He finished it hitting .275 in two seasons with Concordia University-St. Paul.



Thomas St. Clair - Pitching Coach

Thomas St. Clair begins his fourth season as a coach in the Texas Rangers organization and first as the pitching coach for the Hub City Spartanburgers. St. Clair previously served as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College. The Winston-Salem, NC native played his college ball at Lenoir-Rhyne. He was drafted in the 24th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. St. Clair played two seasons in the minor leagues.



Jav Sullenger - Development Coach

Jay Sullenger has served as a player development coach in the Rangers organization since 2019. Previously, Sullenger spent five years as the head coach at Biola University and over a decade as the associate head coach at James Madison University.



Elevys Gonzalez - Development Coach

Elevys Gonzalez began his Rangers coaching career in 2020 as a hitting coach in the DSL. He served as the DSL Rangers manager for two years before coming to the states. Gonzalez is a native of Venezuela and played professionally for six years in the minor leagues.
