LAST GAME

The Baysox hung on for a 3-2 victory over the Akron RubberDucks on Friday night. Bowie took a 2-0 lead on the first two batters of the game, as Heston Kjerstad walked, extending his on-base streak to 28 games, prior to Coby Mayo clobbering a two-run blast for his seventh home run of the season. The Baysox would scrape just one run across the rest of the night, with Noelberth Romero grounding into a 6-4-3 double play with the bases loaded to plate Donta' Williams in the fourth. On the mound, right-hander Carlos Tavera had his best outing of the season. Tavera took the win after going five hitless frames, walking only two and striking out five. It marked the second-consecutive night that the Baysox took a no-hitter into the sixth inning. While the no-hitter was quickly broken up upon right-hander Houston Roth relieving Tavera in the sixth, Roth still pitched well, striking out six of the first nine batters he faced and fanning seven RubberDucks overall through the final four innings. Roth's only blemish was a two-out, two-run home run by Angel Martinez in the eighth to make it a 3-2 game. In the bottom of the ninth, the tying run would reach via an Aaron Bracho walk, but he would be tug out at third to end the game after over-sliding the base following an infield single from Joe Naranjo - sealing the save for Roth and the victory for Bowie.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Akron RubberDucks enter tonight with a record of 20-22. Akron sits fifth in the Eastern League Southwest division, but just two-and-a-half games out of first place. The RubberDucks split their six-game series in Richmond last week and took four of six from the Baysox in Bowie last month. Both sides enter the series struggling defensively. Akron's 42 errors on the season are the third-most in the Eastern League. Only the Baysox (46) and SeaWolves (43) have more. Akron's roster is highlighted by six of the Guardians' Top 30 prospects, via MLB Pipeline. Positioned prospects include INF Angel Martinez (No. 9), OF Petey Halpin (No. 15) and INF Jose Tena (No. 21). On the mound, the RubberDucks' staff is led by right-handers Tanner Burns (No. 20) and Jack Leftwich (No. 30), along with southpaw Doug Nikhazy (No. 28).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Tanner Burns is set to get the ball for Akron tonight. The No. 20 prospect in the Guardians' system, per MLB Pipeline, Burns has had a very efficient season so far for the RubberDucks, despite pitching no deeper than five innings in each of his seven starts this far. Burns has only allowed two hits in each of his previous three starts, but did walk a season-high four batters in his no-decision against Richmond this past Sunday. Burns has not surrendered more than two earned runs in an outing since his season debut against Bowie on 4/11, where he went 4.1 innings, yielding five hits, but struck out a season-high seven batters in his efforts. In five career starts against the Baysox, Burns is 0-3 with a 4.37 ERA. The 36th overall pick by the Guardians in 2020's Competitive Balance - A Round, out of Auburn University, Burns features a low-mid-90s fastball, along with a mid-80s slider, upper-70s curveball, and a low-80s changeup.

HOME RUN HEADACHES

While Akron entered this series with 29 home runs on the season, the second-fewest in the League, and third-fewest in Double-A, Baysox pitching has allowed four home runs in four games across this week's series. The Eastern League has had a wide variation between home run friendly teams, as three teams (ALT, NH, SOM) are among the four best teams in Double-A at limiting home runs, while four teams (REA, HFD, BNG, BOW) are among the top seven teams for home runs allowed in Double-A.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto has been heralded as the contact king of the Eastern League. Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 57 hits and a .363 average - 42 points above the next highest qualified average. Prieto has hits in 18 of his 20 games this month and holds a .370 average and a .975 OPS in May. Prieto has struck out in each of the last two contests. However, it is only the second time all season that has happened. Prieto has just nine strikeouts through 39 games in 2023, to go along with 10 walks.

HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. The Orioles' No. 5 prospect has demonstrated plenty offensive consistency - sitting second in the Eastern League in slugging (.613), in addition to being fourth in average (.313) and third in OPS (1.004) among qualifiers, while also ranking second in extra-base hits (22), fourth in hits (47) and third in total bases (92), while sitting tied for the league lead with three triples. Kjerstad is in the midst of a 28-game on-base streak - the longest streak in the Eastern League this season, and tied for the longest at the Double-A level. Kjerstad has reached base safely in 37 of his first 38 Double-A contests.

LEAVING CRATERS IN CANAL PARK

Bowie has enjoyed some unexpected success via the long ball this week. In the first four games of the series, the Baysox have clobbered six home runs - the same amount the RubberDucks have allowed in their first 15 home games, and the lowest total in the Eastern League. Strangely enough, Bowie has launched just 16 home runs on the road this season - the second-lowest total in the league and the third-lowest total in Double-A. The home run has accounted for exactly 50% of Baysox run production in this series, after accounting for 23% of run production in the first 14 road contests of 2023.

CAREER NOTES

- 4th most strikeouts (126), 3rd most innings (117.0), and 2nd most starts (22) across the Orioles' system in 2022.
- Named an Orioles Organization All-Star in 2022 after successful stints in High-A Aberdeen and Bowie. Pitched to a 3.69 ERA in 14 appearances/10 starts across 63.1 innings for the Baysox, including a 2.08 ERA in August with a .137 BAA.
- Named Mountain West Pitcher of the Year in 2021.
- Nearly quit baseball before when only team offering him a roster spot out of high school was Division III Pacific Lutheran, "I honestly almost gave up baseball at the end of my high school career, I didn't really know if I loved it, but then I got that one opportunity ... and kind of found this new passion toward baseball."

NOTES BY OUTING*

- Baysox Opening Day starter. Allowed two singles in the first inning, and was saved from allowing a run with an outfield assist. Allowed one base hit in every inning besides the third, but never worked with multiple runners on base.
- Allowed first run of the season in the fourth inning after a double and a single. Walked the first two batters of the fifth inning and was lifted.
- Allowed runners into scoring position in three different innings, but none reached third base. Mixed six flyouts and four groundouts.
- Third pitch thrown was hit for a solo home run. Walked and hit a batter later in the frame, but did not see another runner in scoring position. Left game tied at one, bullpen allowed six runs.
- Allowed three consecutive batters to reach in the first inning, and again in the second. An error and a walk lead to another run in the fifth inning.
- Allowed a solo home run to the third batter of the game. Only other runner to reach scoring position was a stolen base with two outs in the fifth.
- Second pitch thrown went for a double, but faced the minimum over the next 17 batters. With two outs in the sixth, a double, error, and three-run home run cost him the shutout performance
- Gave up a leadoff single, but stranded two runners in the first, followed by two perfect innings. Allowed a solo home run in the fourth, and had a runner thrown out at home in the fifth.

Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.	Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Herrmann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Herrmann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Herrmann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.	Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.	Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time in 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullpen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving on to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
