SERIES RECAP:

The Reading Fightin Phils took two of six games on the road against the Hartford Yard Goats (Rockies). After losing the series opener, the Fightins won both games in a double header on Thursday after Wednesday's game was postponed due to rain. James McArthur and Matt Seelinger claimed victories on the mound while Logan O'Hoppe and Jhailyn Ortiz each blasted home runs, two of the six homers the R-Phils hit in Hartford.

O'HOPPE'S OFFENSE:

Logan O'Hoppe bolstered his offensive numbers in Hartford last week. The catcher hit three home runs, including a grand slam, as a part of his five-hit series against the Yard Goats. He leads the team with a .301 batting average, a .414 on-base percentage, 34 runs, 32 RBIs and 11 home runs. In addition, he's been a rock behind the plate with 34 starts as catcher in 2022. He throws out runners attempting to steal at roughly a 20% clip. Since Bryson Stott moved off the Phillies' prospect list, O'Hoppe is now ranked the No. 4 prospect in the organization.

OUTFIELD ASSISTS:

Jack Conley and Vito Friscia developed into reliable outfielders for the Fightins. Both rostered as catchers, the pair has shown off their strong arms from the outfield so far this season. Out of the team's 15 outfield assists, Conley and Friscia account for over half of them. Conley has over a third of them himself with six. He's shown versatility in the outfield, throwing three runners out from right field, two from left and one from center. Friscia added three outfield assists. Both were drafted by the Phillies, Conley in 2018 and Friscia in 2019.

ON-BASE OCKIMEY:

Josh Ockimey claimed a top-spot in one statistic across the Eastern League in Hartford. The first baseman leads the league in walks with 44 as he overtook Bowie's Gunnar Henderson, who led the league for most of the season. Ockimey drew seven walks against the Yard Goats, including three in the series opener. Whether he walked or put the ball into play, Ockimey found a way to get on base. He ranks second on the team with a .404 on-base percentage and is tied for second with 38 hits. 2022 is Ockimey's first season with the Fightins as he previously spent time in the minors with the Boston Red Sox, the team that drafted him in 2014.

BIG LEAGUE CLUB WATCH:

The Phillies completed a sweep of the Angels at home on Sunday as they came from behind with a 9-7 walk-off win. Bryson Stott hit the walk-off three-run home run in the bottom of the ninth inning. It was the first walk-off home run of his Major League Career and second big league home run. One inning prior, Bryce Harper hit a grand slam to tie the game, but the Angels retook the lead in the top half of the ninth. Kyle Gibson got the start for the Phillies and pitched 3.1 innings. The game was scoreless heading into the top of the third before the Angels scored five runs on six hits, all of which were charged to Gibson.

ON THIS DAY IN BASEBALLTOWN HISTORY:

June 7, 2000: At Reading, Pete Zamora, making his first start of the season in game two of a double-header, retires all 21 Harrisburg batters to record the first perfect game in R-Phils history. A batter after Eric Valent makes a fantastic sliding catch to preserve the perfecto, Zamora strikes out Dan McKinley to end it. The 6-0 win earns the Phils a split on the day as the Senators take the first game, 1-0, defeating Brandon Duckworth on an unearned run.
