ROAD WARRIORS: After winning four out of six games in the first week of this two-week road trip in the Carolina League South, the FredNats kick off week two of this trip against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans, Single-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. This is the third straight year FXBG has traveled to Pelicans Ballpark. Fredericksburg has lost both series in MB four games to two. Coming in, Fredericksburg has won three series in a row, while Myrtle Beach has split their last three series. Tonight, RHP Bryan Sanchez gets the series opening start for Fredericksburg, facing Myrtle Beach righty Erian Rodriguez. On paper, the FredNats should have the advantage in this series. Fredericksburg's offense has scored the most runs in the Carolina League (194), and Myrtle Beach's pitching staff has allowed the most runs in the league (181).

ABOUT LAST WEEK: The FredNat bullpen had its best week of the year as Fredericksburg won four dramatic games in Charleston, hanging on at the end each time. FXBG won its four games by stranding the bases loaded for the RiverDogs in the 8th or 9th inning in all four wins. Brenner Cox had a great week, hitting two home runs, including the go-ahead shot in the 10th inning of the series opener. Jeremy De La Rosa also mashed in his first week of 2024 on a rehab assignment with the FredNats.

HE'S BACK: 2021/22 FredNat Jeremy De La Rosa burst back onto the scene last week with the FredNats on a rehab assignment after injuring the AC joint in his shoulder during spring training. In his first game action in 2024, De La Rosa went 8-for-17 with four doubles, two triples and three RBI, including the game-winning RBI in the 10th inning of Saturday's game.

BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. In 174 IP so far for the FredNat relievers, the unit has allowed 43 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.22. The Freddies are also 11/12 in save opportunities, and Thomas Schultz is first in the Carolina League and tied with High-A Wilmington's Todd Peterson for the second-most saves in Minor League Baseball with six. The team is 16-0 when holding a lead after seven, and 18-0 when leading after eight innings this year.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY: FredNat outfielder Brenner Cox had a 20th birthday to remember on Saturday in Charleston. He went 3-for-3 with a homer, a double and the game-tying RBI in the 8th inning of an eventual 5-3 extra-inning win. Cox had a great sereis against Charleston, going 6-for-18 with two homers, a career-high five RBI in one game, and nine total RBI for the week.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 16-2 this season when scoring first, including the last 14 wins in a row. Fredericksburg's only two losses this year when scoring first both came in last week's series against Charleston on Friday and Sunday.

CONTINUED: Another key to winning this year has been production with runners in scoring position. In 22 wins, Fredericksburg is hitting .241 with RISP, compared to .102 in losses. The FredNats did decently well at the plate with runners in scoring position last week, going a combined 11-for-44 (.250) against the RiverDogs.

ANOTHER PROMOTION: Prior to today's game, RHP Jose Atencio was promoted to High-A Wilmington. Atencio was one of the best starting pitchers in the Carolina League, posting a 31/1 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 28 innings for Fredericksburg. He is the only FredNat pitcher this year to reach the sixth inning of a start as he battled the RiverDogs through six tough innings last Thursday. Atencio was promoted to Fredericksburg in July of 2022 and now gets the call to Wilmington.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 163-131 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI).

TONIGHT'S START: Bryan Sanchez is making his sixth start of the 2024 season tonight for the Fredericksburg Nationals. Signed by Washington out of the Dominican Republic in 2018, Sanchez got his first taste of professional baseball in the Dominican Summer League in 2019.

After missing 2021, Sanchez came stateside for the first time in 2022, and impressed in the GCL with a 3.79 ERA across nine appearances (eight starts).

That earned him a spot on the Opening Day roster for the FredNats last season, where he split time evenly between starting and coming out of the bullpen. Bryan began the year as a reliever, with six appearances from April into early May. But after some reshuffling, Sanchez moved into the starting rotation. He excelled in that role, allowing one run or fewer in four of his six starts before ultimately being shelved for the year due to injury in mid-June.

LAST TIME OUT: Sanchez struggled with his command last week against the Charleston RiverDogs. The righty worked just 2.1 innings, as he walked two men and hit two others, as the 'Dogs tagged him for a pair of earned runs.
