HIGHLIGHTS

UPSIDE DOWN: For the first time all season, the Somerset Patriots allowed 4 HR in Friday night's 10-5 loss. It was Somerset's largest margin of defeat this season, the first time they've allowed double digit runs and coming on 13 hits, which tied a season high.

ROLES REVERSED: After the Patriots had hit 8 HR in the first three games of this week's series, they were held homerless on Friday night, snapping a streak of 10 straight games with a homer for Somerset. On the pitching end, the Patriots allowed more than two home runs for the first time this season.

AND THEY'RE OFF... This week's series features the two Eastern League teams with the most stolen bases. Somerset has collected 18 SB over the first four games of the series, now leading the Eastern League with 73 SB on the season. On Friday, Mickey Gasper stole second, making it so that every active member of the Patriots has stolen a base this season.

NEW YEAR, SAME PATS: A year after leading the Eastern League with 205 HR and 205 SB, the Patriots lead the Eastern League in both categories again one month into the 2023 season, with 39 HR and 73 SB. Somerset is currently on pace to end the season with 178 HR and 333 SB. **RECIPE FOR K:** This season, the Patriots pitching staff has struck out 297 batters--the most in the Eastern League. Contrastly, at the plate, Portland has struck out the most times of any

Eastern League team (313). HADLOCK HAVEN: During the 2022 season, the Patriots hit 23 home runs at Hadlock Field, which was their most at any visiting ballpark in the Eastern League. Somerset's 46 home runs against the Sea Dogs in 2022 were the most they hit against any team in the league. Their 13 HR in the final week of the regular season vs. Portland were their most in a series last season.

PITCH SELECTION: Fastball (90-94), Curveball (77-80), Slider

2022: Signed with the San Francisco Giants as an MiLB Free Agent prior to the season, posting a 5.13 ERA in 40.1 IP for Double-A Richmond before his release on July 21. Fenter then signed with the (independent) 2022 Atlantic League Champion Lancaster Barnstormers where he pitched in nine games, going 2-1 with a 2.95 ERA in 21.1 IP. He signed with the Yankees prior to the 2023 season.

2021: Made 13 starts and 8 relief appearances for Double-A Bowie, posting a 5.47 ERA in 77.1 IP with 86 K. Prior to the season, he was selected by the Chicago Cubs in the Rule 5 Draft. At Cubs Spring Training, Fenter threw a perfect, seven-pitch inning before being returned to the Orioles on March 12.

2019: Went 8-2 with a career-best 1.81 ERA and 33% K rate for Delmarva, holding opponents to a .185 BAA.

2018: Split season between Short-Season Class-A Aberdeen and Class-A Delmarva, going 8-6 with a 4.84 ERA and 91K in a career high of 83.2 IP over 13 starts and 14 relief appearances.

2017: Made 11 starts for the Rookie-level GCL Orioles recovering from injury, posting a 3.45 ERA in 28.2 IP with 33 K. Made one appearance for Short-Season Class-A Aberdeen, throwing 1.2 IP of relief.

2016: DNP (Tommy John Surgery)

2015: Made professional debut with the rookie-level GCL Orioles, pitching to a 1.66 ERA in 21.2 IP with 18 K.

Career Notes: Selected by the Baltimore Orioles in the seventh round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of West Memphis High School (AR), signing for \$1M to forgo his commitment to Mississippi State.

Dominguez begins his 1st season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 9th overall as a manager and 17th overall coaching in the Yankees organization. An outfielder during his playing days, Dominguez signed with the Yankees as an undrafted free agent in 2001 and spread four minor league seasons for New York between the DSL and the GCL.
