NINTH INNING RALLY LIFTS CARDINALS OVER NATURALS: The Cardinals scored 4 runs in the top of the 9th inning to overcome a one-run deficit en route to a come from behind 6-3 victory over the NW Arkansas Naturals on Wednesday night at Arvest Ballpark. **Chandler Redmond** tied the game with an RBI single, while **Lars Nootbaar** (BB), **Mike Antico** (sac fly) and **Matt Lloyd** (1B) each drove in runs to cap the comeback. **Dakota Harris** and **Aaron McKeithan** each had 3 hits for Springfield. **Jack Ralston** and **Matt Svanson** combined to fire 4.2 scoreless innings in relief.

OPPOSING STARTER: Lefty **Noah Cameron** makes his 13th start of the season for the Naturals as the series shifts to Hammons Field...Last pitched on Saturday, June 29 at Wichita and did not factor in the decision, allowing 2 ER on 5 H with 6 K and 4 BB over 6.0 IP...In the month of June went 0-2 with a 3.80 ERA in 5 starts...In 2 starts against the Cardinals is 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA...After his start against the Cardinals on May 7 when he picked up the win with 5.0 innings of one-run ball, spent 3 weeks on the IL...Made 17 starts for the Naturals in 2023, going 3-10 with a 6.10 ERA, allowing 14 HR in 72.1 IP...Made 4 starts against the Cardinals last season and went 1-2 with a 10.13 ERA (.392 BAA)...Began last season at High-A Quad Cities going 2-2 with a 3.60 ERA in 7 starts...Split the 2022 season between Quad Cities and Low-A Columbia...Selected by the Royals in the 7th round of the 2021 draft out of Central Arkansas despite missing the entire 2021 season after Tommy John surgery in August 2020...Freshman All-American and All-Southland Conference in 2019...From St. Joseph, MO and called the Royals his "hometown team"...24 years old

CARDINALS LOOK TO FLIP SCRIPT ON NATURALS: The Cardinals head to Springdale to start a split six-game series against the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (Double-A, Kansas City Royals). The Naturals have had the Cardinals' number in 2024, winning 10 of the 12 matchups between the two this season including each of the last eight.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

NOOOOOOOOOT: For the 2nd time during the 2024 season, Cardinals OF **Lars Nootbaar** is rehabbing with Springfield. He has been on the IL with St. Louis since May 31 with an oblique strain. **Nootbaar** appeared in one game for Springfield on April 9 rehabbing from fractured ribs, going 1-for-4 with an RBI and 2 runs scored before being activated by St. Louis on April 11. In 5 games with Triple-A Memphis at the start of the season, he went 3-for-17 with a 2B. **Nootbaar** is batting .234 with 5 HR and 19 RBI to go along with 7 2B and a .741 OPS in 39 big league games this season.

Five games into his current rehab stint with Springfield, **Nootbaar** is 4-for-17 with a double and a home run.

AMERICA THE BEAUTIFUL: Baseball and the 4th of July go together like America and apple pie, and the Cardinals have had plenty of success at Hammons Field on Independence Day going 6-3 at home on the 4th. Last season Springfield defeated Amarillo 9-8 in downtown Springfield. The Cardinals have averaged 7,965 fans in nine 4th of July games at Hammons Field, with the largest crowd coming in 2013 when 11,818 saw the Cards beat Corpus Christi 2-1.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING!: After dropping 4 of their first 5 games to start the 2nd half of Texas League play, the Cardinals won 4 straight to run their 2nd-half record to 5-4. The four-game streak is the 2nd for the Birds this season since a 9-game winning streak to start the campaign; the Cardinals last won four straight from May 30-June 2 at Wichita.

Speaking of streaks, Cardinals INF/OF **Bryan Torres** has reached base safely in 12 straight games.

HOME SWEET HOME?: So far in 2024, the Cardinals have been much better on the road than in the friendly confines of Hammons Field. Springfield sport the worst home record at 15-22 and have dropped 11 of their last 13 and 22 of their last 29 games at Hammons Field. The Cards began the season by winning their first 8 home games. The last time the Cardinals won consecutive home games was May 24-25 against the Tulsa Drillers. The Birds have the 2nd-highest home ERA in the Texas League at 5.90.

While the Cards have struggled at Hammons Field, Springfield has been the best team in the Texas League away from home. The Cards have a league-best 27-14 record on the road this season and have the 2nd-best road ERA at 3.55, just 0.10 behind Frisco and tops in the North Division. Remarkably, the 10 teams of the Texas League have combined to put together a winning road record at 199-190, and the North Division is 102-84 away from home.

GRINDIN': Simply put, the Cardinals don't strike out very much. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 550 whiffs in 78 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (530 K in 78 games). The Cards are averaging just 7.05 K's per game. The Cardinals this week are up against the top strikeout staff in the Texas League; the Naturals average 10 K's per game.

LIGHTS-OUT 'PEN: During the Cardinals' 4-game winning streak, Springfield relievers have been up to the task posting a 4-0 record with a 1.45 ERA over 18.2 IP. Over their last 5 games, Cardinal relievers have an ERA of 1.67.

SEE YOU IN ARLINGTON: Major League Baseball announced the AL and NL rosters for the 25th annual All-Star Futures Game, and two Cardinals pitchers were honored with a nod. **RHP Tink Hence** will be taking part in the event for the 2nd straight season, and **LHP Quinn Mathews** also received the honor in his first full season of professional baseball. The game will take place Saturday, July 13 at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 220.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 41 straight games without a home run.
