- Maikel Garcia and Nick Loftin opened the top of the first with back-to-back singles and Michael Massey brought Garcia home on a sacrifice fly, but from that point on, the Naturals only put three baserunners on and the Cardinals pitching faced one over the minimum to silence what had been a rather potent lineup the last two nights.
- John Rave and Tucker Bradley singled in the second and third respectively, but were both caught stealing. Nate Eaton walked in the fourth with two outs, but the final 16 Northwest Arkansas hitters were retired in order to end the night and in the end, Springfield pitching just faced three over the minimum over the course of the night.
- Starting pitcher Alec Marsh struck out eight across 4.0 innings of one-run ball and was followed with eight more strikeouts across 4.0 innings from the bullpen.
- Holden Capps allowed one run across 2.1 innings, striking out four but taking the loss. Jonah Dipoto threw the final 1.2 innings, striking out four as well without allowing a run, for a season-high 16 strikeouts combined from the staff.

### This Day in Naturals History

The Naturals are 6-6 all-time when playing on May 7

On May 7, 2015, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals homered four times but lost to the Springfield Cardinals 13–8 at Hammons Field, snapping an 11-game winning streak. On the second pitch of the game, **Dusty Coleman** hit a leadoff home run to left-center field, just the third leadoff homer in franchise history, kickstarting a five-run first inning for the Naturals. Mike Bianucci added a three-run homer to cap the inning, but the Cardinals scored four in the bottom half, then exploded for seven runs in the 7th to go from being down 7-6 to up 13-6 and snap Northwest Arkansas' winning streak.

## THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, six players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 9 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Holden Capps, Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Stephen Woods Jr. and Ángel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021, as did catcher **Tyler Cropley**, who is currently on the Injured List.

### FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 19 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 11 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave, Patrick Smith and Ángel Zerpa.

#### TOOLSY TEAM

Six active Naturals players were listed in Baseball America's 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the "Best Defensive Catcher" in the Australian infielder Robbie Glendinning was a February free agent signing
- SS **Maikel Garcia** is rated as having the "Best Infield Arm" in the system.
- RF **Seuly Matias** is rated as having the <u>"Best Outfield Arm"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** is rated as having the <u>"Best Control"</u> in the system.

### MJ MELENDEZ IS A BIG LEGUER!

In Tuesday's 7-1 win for the Kansas City Royals, 2021 Natural MJ Melendez hit seventh and served as the Royals' DH, becoming the 113th player to debut in the Majors after spending time in Northwest Arkansas, the fourth in the 2022 MLB Season.

- Melendez went 1-for-3 with a walk, collecting his first MLB hit in the bottom of the sixth inning, an opposite field single.
- In the bottom of the second inning, third baseman Bobby Witt Jr. finally drilled his first big league homer, a solo shot to left field, moments before Melendez took his first at-bat.
- Bobby Witt Jr. was Naturals alum 110 to reach the Majors, debuting on April 7 ... Collin Snider was the 111th on April 9 ... Yunior Marté became the 112th Naturals alum to reach the Majors, debuting with the San Fransisco Giants on April 12.

### **EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring five runs or less, the Naturals are just 1-12, while 11-1 when scoring six runs or more.
- The Naturals are 3-11 when recording nine hits or less, but 9-2 when recording 10 hits or more.
- The Naturals are 12-2 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 0-11 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 9-5, whereas 3-8 when the opponent scores first.

## Yo, You Wanna See Some Real Speed?

Through 25 games, the Naturals have stolen 36 bases in 44 attempts (average 1.44 steals/game) and *pulled off a double steal 6 times*.

- 36 steals ranks tied second in the Texas League, seventh in Double-A and tied for 28th in the Minors, while a 81.82% success rate on steals ranks 14th among MiLB teams with at least 35 successful steals.
- Maikel Garcia's 10 steals (in 12 attempts) ranks tied for fourth in the Texas League and tied for eighth in all of Double-A.

### NATE IS GREAT

Utility man **Nate Eaton** has been a consistent presence in the Naturals lineup all season along, playing all over the diamond for Northwest Arkansas as well.

- Eaton's .322 average leads qualified Naturals hitters and ranks 10th in the Texas League, while he's tied with Michael Massey and Maikel Garcia for the team lead in hits with 29.
- Eaton entered last Wednesday's game on a eight-game hitting streak, the longest on the team this season though the streak was snapped last night with an 0-for-4 day at the plate ... between April 23 and May 1, Eaton hit 15-for-31 (.484 average) with two homers, six runs batted in, four steals
- Last week, Eaton hit .417 against Amarillo, 20-for-24 at the plate with four runs batted in, three steals and a 1.087 OPS.
- With 14 starts (122.0 innings) at third base, 3 starts (27.0 innings) in left field, 3 starts (27.0 innings) in right field and one start at shortstop (9.0 innings), the VMI product is the only Naturals player who has spent time at more than three positions in the field.

### G'DAY ROBBIE!

by the Kansas City Royals and has proven himself to be one of the best players on the 2022 Naturals.

- The native of Perth, Western Australia reached base in each of the first 15 games he played to start the season, but struck out pinch-hitting in the ninth inning to snap that streak ... a 15-game on-base streak is the longest on the team this year and is tied for fifth-longest in the Texas League.
- Among 10 qualified Naturals hitters, Glendinning is the Naturals' team leader in slugging percentage (.571) and OPS (.996), while ranking second on the team with a .425 on-base percentage, tied second with four home runs, 15 walks and ranks third in runs batted in (17) and runs scored (18) and fourth in batting average (.286).
- Robbie's .996 OPS ranks seventh in the Texas League.

#### Gar-see ya on Base

Shortstop Maikel Garcia drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and now has 21 on the season, which is tied for second in the Texas League and tied for third in Double-A.

- In 117 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 50 times, for a .427 on-base percentage (29 hits + 21 walks) ... he has reached at least once in 22 of the 24 games he's appeared in this season ... the only games he didn't reach base were back-to-back games, on April 23 and 26.
- The Venezuelan has reached base at least twice in 15 of 22 games where he has reached base.
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking tied second in walks (21), tied for fourth in steals (10), tied sixth in hits (29), tied seventh in runs scored (21) and 10th in on-base percentage (.427).
- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.



## #36 CHRIS WIDGER • Manager

- Chris Widger will manage the Naturals after guiding the River Bandits to a High-A Central championship in their first season as a Kansas City affiliate in 2021. In doing so, he was named the Minor League Manager of the Year by Baseball America following the 2021 season.
- 2022 marks Widger's seventh year in the Royals' organization, as he was slated to manage Advanced-A Wilmington in 2020 and led Burlington to the Appalachian League Championship Series in his first season as Manager in 2019. Prior to that, he was Wilmington's Bench Coach from 2016-18.
- Before joining the Royals organization, he managed the Independent League Camden Riversharks in 2015 and was their Pitching Coach from 2012-14.
- A third-round pick by Seattle in the 1992 Draft, Widger played in parts of 10 seasons in the Majors with the Mariners (1995-96, 2000), Expos (1997-2000), Yankees (2002), Cardinals (2003), White Sox (2005-06) and Orioles (2006), winning a World Series with Chicago in 2005.
- Widger and his wife, Whitney, reside in Pennsville, N.J., with their children: C.J., Ashlynn and Skylar.



## **MAS DERRICK LEWIS - PITCHING COACH**

- Derrick Lewis is in his third season with the Royals' organization and second as pitching coach at Northwest Arkansas.
- He spent the previous 16 seasons in the Atlanta Braves' organization, the first 14 as a Minor League pitching coach and the last two as the Pitching Coordinator.
- Pitching coach timeline: 2004-07: GCL Braves (Gulf Coast League, RK)... 2008-10: Danville Braves (Appalachian League, RK)... 2011-13: Rome Braves (South Atlantic League, A)... 2014: Lynchburg Hillcats (Carolina League, A+)... 2015-2016: Carolina Mudcats (Carolina League, A+)... 2017: Mississippi Braves (Southern League, AA)
- He played seven seasons in the Braves' organization from 1997-2003, after being selected in the 20th round of the 1997 draft.
- Lewis and his wife, Roslyn, reside in Charlotte, North Carolina, with their daughter, Skye and Son, Lake.



## 🜃 ABRAHAM NÚÑEZ • HITTING COACH

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).
- Núñez played for parts of 12 seasons in the Majors with the Pirates (1997-2004), Cardinals (2005), Phillies (2006-2007) and Mets (2008). A switch-hitter, he owns a career average of .242 as a utility infielder in the big leagues, primarily playing third base, but could play all four infield positions.
- His best season came in 2005 when he batted .285 in 139 games for the National League Champion St. Louis Cardinals.
- Lifetime .346 (9-for-28) hitter in the postseason, including the 2005 National League Championship Series with St. Louis when he hit .385, though did not play in the World Series.
- Born in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, he now resides in Hudson, Massachusetts.



## #27 CHRISTIAN COLON - Assistant HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- · Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



## #23 MIKE JIRSCHLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.
- Jirschele previously managed the Triple-A Omaha franchise for 11 seasons (2003-13), leading the team to four division titles, three-straight trips to the Pacific Coast League championship round (2011-13), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and a Triple-A Championship in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field.
- Prior to his 11-year stint with Omaha, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years (1998-2002), while he held managerial positions with Omaha (1995-97), Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.



## DANNY ACCOLA • CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.
- He was slated to serve in that role with Wilmington in 2020 and previously filled those roles with Lexington in 2019, Burlington from 2017-18 and with Surprise in 2016.
- Accola graduated from the University of Central Missouri in 2014 and previously held an athletic training internship with the Denver Broncos in 2013.



## C.J. MIKKELSEN • STRENGTH & CONDITIONING COACH

- C.J. Mikkelsen will serve as the Northwest Arkansas Strength & Conditioning Coach for the second consecutive season, after being slated to fill that same role at Idaho Falls in 2020.
- He graduated in December 2019 with a master's degree in sports physiology from Texas A&M University, where he also worked as a Sports Performance Graduate Intern
- Mikkelsen earned his bachelor's degree in exercise and wellness from Arizona State University in 2016. He resides in Desert Hills, Arizona.

**FASTBALL**: Sits low 90's (90-93 mph), started touching mid-90's but might dip down into high 80's. **CHANGEUP**: Above average pitch (77-81 mph), uses it to keep hitters off the fastball with good arm-side run to get swings and misses from both side of the plate, a "Bugs Bunny Changeup."

**CURVEBALL**: Developing pitch with decent spin and shape, has been better as of late.

#### 2022 SEASON

- Has pitched at least 5.0 innings in each of his last four starts, has not walked a batter in his last two starts ... allowed just one hit in back-to-back starts 4/20 and 4/26 ... leads the team in innings pitched (24.0) and has the lowest ERA among qualified pitchers (3.38).
- Ranks 8th in the Texas League in ERA, 2nd in opponents' average (.184) and 3rd in WHIP (0.96) ... ERA and opponents' average are lowest among qualified Royals Minor Leaguers, WHIP ranks 2nd, as does innings pitched.
   Pitched 11.0 scoreless innings between 4/20 and 5/1, including 6.0 scoreless vs. AMA on 4/26.

#### CAREER NOTES

#### 2021

- Split the season between Quad Cities (A+) and Northwest Arkansas (AA), with a break in between to pitch for Team
  USA at the 2021 WBSC Olympic Baseball Qualifiers.
- Broke camp in High-A with the River Bandits and did not allow a run across 15.2 innings, pitching in four games (one start), while striking out 23 (41.1 K%) and walking just three (7.67 K/BB).
- Joined the Naturals on June 6 and remained at Double-A through the end of the season ... went 5-4 across 18 games (17 starts) with a 3.36 ERA (31 ER in 83.0 IP) and 95 strikeouts.
- Named the Double-A Central Pitcher of the Month in August, pitching in 5 games (4 starts), with a 2-0 record and
   1.13 ERA (3 ER in 24.0 IP) ... struck out 27 with a 0.88 WHIP (13 H, 8 BB) and .163 opponents' batting average.
- Named the league's Pitcher of the Week after his start on 8/27 against Springfield, a 7-inning complete game shutout in the first game of a doubleheader at Arvest Ballpark ... allowed two hits with no walks while striking out seven in an 8-0 win over the Cardinals.
- Among qualified Minor League pitchers (96.0 IP), ranked 14th in WHIP, 14th in opponents' batting average (.198) and 16th in ERA (2.83).
- Combined between High-A and Double-A, his 118 strikeouts ranks 5th among Royals Minor League pitchers, 98.2 innings pitched ranked 4th ... among Royals farmhands with at least 70.0 innings pitched, he ranked 1st in ERA (2.83) and WHIP (0.99) and 2nd in opponents' average (.194) behind Quad Cities' Will Klein (.171).
- Member of Team USA at the 2021 WBSC Olympic Baseball Qualifiers from May 30 to June 5 ... pitched in one game for the United States, helping the team qualify for the Tokyo Olympics by earning the win after pitching two scoreless innings out of the bullpen with two strikeouts on June 4 in a 10-1 victory over Canada.

#### 2019

- Pitched in nine games (four starts) for the Burlington Royals (R), going 3-0 with a 2.52 ERA (7 ER in 25.0 IP), striking out 39 (14.04 K/9) while walking just four (9.75 K/BB) in his professional debut.
- Earned his first professional win on July 11 against the Elizabethton Twins, pitching 3.0 innings out of the bullpen with five strikeouts in a 5-0 win over the E-Twins on the road.
- Did not allow a run in five of his nine appearances, or his last 5.1 innings of the season with the B-Royals.
- Did not appear in a postseason game with Burlington, who made it to the Appalachian League finals, but lost to the
  Johnson City Cardinals in a best-of-three series ... went back to FSU to finish his degree in the fall semester.

- Attended Florida State University, making two trips to the College World Series (2017, 2019) with the Seminoles.
- In 2019, went 8-5 with 112 strikeouts in 81.2 innings (21.3 K/9) across 17 outings (16 starts) as a junior and the Noles Friday night starter throughout the season ... bookended the season with a pair of memorable performances: was part of a combined no-hitter on Opening Day against Maine (2/15), pitching five scoreless innings at the start in FSU's 10th no-no in school history ... ended his career with eight scoreless innings against No. 5 Arkansas in the opening game of the College World Series, FSU's first victory in the CWS opener since 1999.


