KEEPING UP WITH THE JONES: Coming off his first home run and first stolen base of the season on Tuesday night, Spencer Jones also reached base three times for the second time in his last three games. Now with an OBP of .500, he ranks T-5th in the Eastern League. Jones' homer on Tuesday traveled 402 feet with an exit velocity of 107 mph.

DEJA VU: Last night, for the second time in the Patriots' first four games, they had a 4-1 lead in the 8th inning or later and went on to lose by a final score of 5-4.

STARTING STRONG: Through four games, Somerset Patriots starting pitchers have posted a 2.81 ERA (T-5th in the Eastern League) over 16.0 IP. Somerset's bullpen has pitched to a 9.82 ERA over 18.1 IP, which ranked last in the league, 2.62 runs higher than the team that ranks 11th, Reading. Patriots relievers have taken the losing decision in all three of the team's losses this season.

MIDDLE MEN: Over the first four games of the season, the Somerset Patriots have scored all 19 of their runs during the 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th innings. The Patriots offense has yes to score in innings 1, 2, 3, 4 or 9.

PROLIFIC PITCHING: Entering today, the Patriots pitching staff has struck out 53 batters to lead the Eastern League. The mark also ranks 2nd in Minor League Baseball since Friday, when the Eastern League season started. Over their last four games, 14 Patriots pitchers have combined to strike out 42 batters, tying for the most in MiLB in that span. Reading's pitching staff compiled 48 strikeouts, the third-most of any Eastern League team. Cam Schlittler's Opening Day outing of 5.2 innings pitched stands as the longest start by any Eastern League pitcher to date this season.

BACK IN THE FLO: Rafael Flores remains the only Patriots batter to have hit safely in every game this season, ranking top 5 in the Eastern League with 6 H (T-3rd), 2 HR (T-2nd), 5 RBI (T-3rd) and 12 TB (2nd). Flores homered in back-to-back games for the Patriots on Saturday and Sunday. His homer on Sunday traveled 428 feet with an exit velocity of 109 mph.

2025 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (3rd year)

Raul Dominguez enters his third consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 11th overall as a manager and 19th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2024, Dominguez led the Patriots to their third consecutive playoff berth and their second appearance in the Eastern League Championship Series with an overall record of 75-62. Dominguez's Patriots erased a 6.0-game deficit in the final 30 games of the regular season by going 22-8 to end the campaign and clinching the Eastern League Northeast division's second half title with a second half record of 43-25. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). He gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). An outfielder during his playing career, Dominguez spread four minor league seasons for with the Yankees between the DSL and the GCL. He began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as a Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Mike Fransoso enters his first season as a Double-A coach in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past five years as a member of the Seattle Mariners organization, most recently with the Double-A Arkansas Travelers as the team's hitting coach. On 8/13/24, Fransoso took over as the Travelers' interim manager and led the team to clinch a second-half playoff berth en route to winning the 2024 Texas League Championship. He also previously served as the hitting coach for High-A Everett (2023), Class-A Modesto (2022) and the AZL Mariners (2021). During his playing career, Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots in 2018 and 2019 when the team was independent. Prior to his stint playing for the Patriots, he spent three seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after being a 27th round pick of the team in 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine.

PETER LARSON: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Peter Larson enters his first season in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past six seasons as a member of the Minnesota Twins organization, including the last two with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints (2023-2024). For Minnesota, Larson also previously served as the pitching coach for Double-A Wichita (2022) and Low-A Fort Myers (2019). In 2020, he was slated to be the pitching coach for Low-A Cedar Rapids, before the Covid cancellation of the minor league season. His first season with the Twins, he served as the minor league rehab pitching coach (2019). Prior to his professional career, Larson worked as a pitching coach at the collegiate level for Fordham University (2018) and the University of Albany (2017). He also served as an assistant coach for Siena College (2016) and King University (2015).

DEREK WOODLEY: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Derek Woodley enters his first season in Somerset and his third with the Yankees organization. He spent the last two seasons as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley (2023-2024). Following the 2024 season, he represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League as an extra coach for the Salt River Rafter. Prior to joining the Yankees organization, Woodley spent 30 seasons as a college baseball coach, racking up over 300 wins and most recently as the head coach for Defiance College for 15 seasons from 2008-2022. He also served as the school's athletic director from 2019-2022.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Uziel Viloria enters his first season in Somerset and in the Yankees organization. He began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), making it as high as High-A Jersey Shore.

2024

Spent the entire 2024 season with Double-A Somerset, working as a starting pitcher for the first time in his professional career. Dees made 27 appearances (26 starts) and went 7-7 with a 4.25 ERA. He ranked among the Eastern League leaders with 145 K (2nd), .226 BAA (5th), 137.2 IP (6th) and a 1.25 WHIP (8th).

2023

Began the season with High-A Hudson Valley, making 26 appearances and posting a 1.74 ERA with a 15/59 K/BB ratio. He was promoted to Double-A Somerset on 7/25 and finished the season over 16 games for the Patriots in which he posted a 4.29 ERA in 21.0 IP.

2022

Spent the majority of his second pro season with Single-A Tampa, going 4-3 over 31 games, while posting a 3.31 ERA, 24 BB, 62 K and a 1.14 WHIP. In September, he was promoted to Hudson Valley for his final three appearances of the season, allowing 4 R (2 ER) over 5.2 IP with 2 BB and 8 K.

2021

Pitched three games in his pro debut season for the FCL Yankees, including his only career start, combining to allow 5 R (2 ER) over 2.1 IP with 1 BB and 5 K.

College

Played four seasons at Penn State University, appearing in 43 career games (33 starts) and going 8-9 with a 4.52 ERA with 64 BB and 176 K. He earned Academic All-Big Ten honors his sophomore, junior and senior seasons (2019-21).

Personal Notes

Attended Hough High School (NC) as a junior and senior, after transferring from Independence High School (NC) as a freshman and sophomore. As a freshman in 2014, he helped lead Independence to a conference championship, while guiding Hough to back-to-back conference championships in 2017 and 2018.
