# BROOKLYN CYCLONES (11-20) at HUDSON VALLEY RENEGADES (22-12)

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped their 4th-straight game in a 9-6 loss at Hudson Valley on Tuesday night...Brooklyn's C Kevin Parada and CF Alex Ramírez each tallied solo home runs...Parada added an RBI single in a multi-hit and RBI game...Cyclones RF Stanley Consuegra registered 2 knocks — including a double — and 2 runs scored...LF Omar De Los Santos and DH Joe Suozzi collected run-scoring knocks from Brooklyn...CF Spencer Jones and LF Aaron Palensky posted solo homers for Hudson Valley...Jones and Palensky each posted 2 hits and RBI...RF Aldenis Sánchez accrued 3 hits and 2 RBI for the Renegades.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: LHP Josh Walker became the 95th former Cyclone (1st in 2023) to make his Major League debut — and the 62nd to do so for the Mets — when he entered in relief on Tuesday night at Citi Field vs. Tampa Bay...The 28-year-old walked 2 in a scoreless inning...Walker spent parts of 3 seasons with the Cyclones from 2018-19 and 2021...In 15 games (10 starts) with the franchise, the left-hander accumulated a 3-1 record with a 3.83 ERA (24 ER in 56.1 IP), 21 walks, and 66 strikeouts...Walker was a 32nd round pick by New York out of the University of New Haven (Conn.) in the 2017 MI B draft

HIT PARADA: C Kevin Parada cracked a home run on Tuesday night and has been on a tear since the calendar flipped to May... In 12 games during the season's second month, the 21-year-old is slashing .311/.380/.600 with a .980 OPS...Parada is 14-for-45 at the dish (.311) with 6 runs scored, 5 doubles, a triple, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI...In that time frame, the Los Angeles native holds a .429 wOBA and a 154 wRC+...In the month of May, Parada is tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (5) and extra-base hits (8)...For the entire campaign, the Georgia Tech alum is tied for 6th in the SAL in two-base hits (9).

RAMÍ TOUGH: OF Alex Ramírez homered on Tuesday night and has reached in 23-of-24 games dating back to April 12...In that span, Ramírez is slashing .286/.375/.385 with a .760 OPS and a 103 wRC+...Alex is 26-for-91 at the dish with 11 runs scored, 5 extra-base hits, 2 home runs, 15 RBI, 11 walks, and 4 stolen bases in 5 attempts... Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (51), hits (92) and doubles (21)...He only trails teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** in extra-base hits (29) and total bases (136).

ROAD WARRIOR: OF Stanley Consuegra has thrived away from Maimonides Park in 2023...Coming into Wednesday, the 22-year-old has posted a batting average 135 points higher on the road (.323) than at home (.188)...Away from home, Consuegra is slashing .323/.373/.629 with a 1.002 OPS adding 9 of his 14 extra-base hits and all 5 of his home runs...16 of his 18 RBI have been on the road, as well...As a team, the Cyclones are hitting 26 points better in visiting parks (.221) than on Coney Island (.195).

STU-PER DUPER: RHP Tyler Stuart has been as consistent as any starting pitcher in the SAL in 2023...The 23-year-old extended his scoreless inning streak to 8.0 innings with 5.0 scoreless frames at Wilmington on Saturday...Entering Wednesday, Stuart leads the league in ERA (1.40)...He is also tied for 6th in batting average against (.202)...The right-hander is also 5th in strikeout rate (32.1%) and xFIP (3.50), as well as 6th in strikeouts per nine innings (11.92).

NONE SHALL PASS: LHP Daniel Juárez has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...ln his first 10 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 2-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 4 hits and 4 walks, striking out 17 (13.12 K/9)...In 15 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 16.0 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 23 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn heads continues their 2 week road trip with a 6-game set against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades boast 3 of New York's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...OF Spencer Jones (6), RHP Drew Thorpe (8), and C Antonio Gómez (27) are featured...The Cyclones went 14-16 in 30 matchups against Hudson Valley in 2022...Brooklyn held a 8-10 record at Heritage Financial Park last year...The Cyclones are 126-135 (.483) all-time against the Renegades dating back to the 2001 season.

Palm Beach...Since then, he is 4-0 with 9 hits allowed, 13 walks, and 32 strikeouts in 26.1 innings...Since the streak began, no pitcher in Minor League Baseball has thrown more innings without allowing an earned run.

**'DASH' LOS SANTOS:** In addition to his 13 stolen bases in 14 attempts in 2023, OF **Omar De Los Santos** remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 83 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (91), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (86), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdéz** (86), and Athletics OF **Esteury Ruíz** (85) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 48 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 35...Omar is already 19 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

**JUMPIN' JOE:** OF/1B **Joe Suozzi** enters Wednesday riding a 6-game on-base streak...The Glen Cove, N.Y. native is 5-for-his-last-18 (.278) with 3 runs scored, a double, 4 RBI, 3 walks, and a stolen base... Suozzi has registered a .697 OPS in those 6 contests...Dating back to April 26 at Jersey Shore, the 25-year-old has registered at least one base knock in 9-of-12 games.

**WIZARD OF OS:** C **Drake Osborn** enters Wednesday's fixture on a season-long 6-game on-base streak...Since registering his first multi-hit game as a Cyclone on May 3 vs. Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is 6-for-21 at the plate (.286) with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 4 RBI, and 2 walks...Osborn holds an .967 OPS since the streak began.

**ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL:** Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

**MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS:** Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30... They include C Kevin Parada (No. 2 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF Alex Ramírez (3/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (6/9)...INF William Lugo (26/26) and RHP Christian Scott (29/26) also appears on both lists...OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 20 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

SIT DOWN: Tidwell whiffed a career-high 10 batters on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...The 21-year-old became the first Brooklyn pitcher to strike out 10+ batters in a single game since RHP Carson Seymour punched out 10 hitters on July 22, 2022, at Jersey Shore...Tidwell was the first Cyclone to do it at home since RHP **Dominic Hamel** accomplished the feat with 10 K's on July 16, 2022, vs. Greensboro.

TOP PROSPECT: Tidwell enters the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' top pitching prospect per MLB Pipeline...Comes at No. 6 overall on the Top 30 list...The 21-year-old is considered the organization's No. 9 overall farmhand by Baseball America...Only RHP **Kodai Senga** is a higher-ranked pitcher on their list...Selected as having the "Best Fastball" and "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2022 draft class.

2022: Selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft...Signed for \$1.85 million on July 27...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts... Hurled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League playoffs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).

**VOLUNTEER SERVICE:** Tidwell joined the New York system after an incredible career at Tennessee...As a draft-eligible sophomore in 2022, The Volunteer State native accrued a 3-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (13 ER in 39.0 IP) and 51 punch outs in 13 appearances (9 starts)...Missed the first two months of the season with shoulder soreness...Named to the 2022 Knoxville Regional All-Tournament team...As a freshman in 2021, Tidwell was recognized on the SEC All-Freshman Team and named a Freshman All-American by D1Baseball. com and Perfect Game.

LORETTO LIGHTNING: Tidwell is no stranger to being around talent...At Loretto (Tenn.) High School, the former second-round selection was teammates with 2018 firstround pick (No. 7 overall) and current San Diego Padres LHP **Ryan Weathers**...Ryan's father, **David**, who pitched for the Mets (2002-04) is also a Loretto High School alum.
