Today: It's Game 3 of a 12-game, 13-day homestand, with the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, playing the third of a six-game series against the Quad Cities River Bandits, the High-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. Tonight is also Greek Night on a Coors Light Thirsty Thursday featuring \$2 domestic beer specials and \$5 craft beer specials.

Starting Matchup: Right-hander Mitch Myers, a 12th-round selection in 2021 from Pitt, makes his third start of the year for the Lugnuts; in his previous outing, he tossed five shutout innings at Lake County. Quad Cities counters with one of its most dominant pitchers, right-hander Luinder Avila, currently 1st in the MWL in FIP (0.63) and tied for the third in the MWL with 22 strikeouts (achieved in just 12 1/3 innings).

Last Night: Lugnuts 5, River Bandits 0. Lazaro Armenteros homered again, his league-leading sixth of the year, Caeden Trenkle blasted a two-run homer to extend his on-base streak to 14 games, and the Nuts' pitching trio of Christian Fernandez, Grant Holman and Jorge Juan combined to shut out Quad Cities on two hits, picking up Lansing's first whitewashing of the year. Trenkle and Jack Winkler each went 2-for-4 to support the Lugnuts' winning cause, with the game decided in a brisk one hour and 58 minutes.

On the Air: Today's games are available on Bally Live, MiLB TV and StreamGuys with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa on the call.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a Dollar Deal Day, with \$1 specials at the concession stands. Then on Saturday, the Lugnuts play for the first time this year as their Copa identity, the Lansing Locos!

Streaking: OF Caeden Trenkle went 2-for-4 vesterday with a single and a home run, and has now reached base in all 14 games he has played this year

On a Tear-os: Lazaro Armenteros has knocked six home runs in his last six games (going 9-for-20 in that span), giving him the Midwest League lead in roundtrippers. Armenteros also leads the circuit in slugging percentage (.838) and OPS (1.260) and is tied for fourth in total bases (31). He has hit safely in his last six games and reached base in his last eight.

Others Among the League Leaders: Jonny Butler is tied for first in triples (3), Jack Winkler is tied for second in doubles (6), and Caeden Trenkle is tied for fifth in runs scored (11).

Hoosier Cannonball: Jack Perkins, who blanked the River Bandits in the opener through 5 1/3 innings, is first in the league in WHIP (0.78), tied for second in ERA (0.59) and fourth in opponent batting average (.132).

Starting Strong: The Nuts' rotation has an ERA of 2.93 this year: compare that to the league-leading 3.35 team ERA of the South Bend Cubs

Bearing Down: 2021 sixth-rounder Grant Holman, the Lugnuts' 2022 Opening Day starter, tossed two more shutout innings in relief yesterday and now has worked six scoreless innings in four appearances since joining the team off the Injured List.

Goose Eggs: Following yesterday's shutout, Quad Cities has scored in only one of the 18 innings played in this series, a five-run eighth on Tuesday vs. Jack Owen and Brock Whittlesey. The River Bandits are 1-for-18 with runners in scoring position, 0-for-2 last night.

Powering On: After not homering in their first six games of the year, the Nuts have hit 12 roundtrippers in their last ten games, including two last night.

Two's a Charm: The Lugnuts lead the league with 17 double plays turned, including at least one double play in 12 of their 16 games

Wild Days on the Farm: A day after Double-A Midland rallied to walk off Corpus Christi, 15-14, Triple-A Las Vegas scored ten runs in the bottom of the seventh inning at Las Vegas Ballpark and held off Tacoma, 18-17. The game included 39 combined hits, 23 by the Aviators; JJ Bleday went 3-for-5 with a double, home run, four runs scored and five RBIs to aid the victory.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old Max Muncy was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old Daniel Susac was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: Chad Jenkins fired eight shutout innings, striking out nine, and Evan Crawford wrapped up a seven-hit Lugnuts 6-0 victory at West Michigan.

2016: The Nuts extended their scoreless streak to 24 innings, as Angel Perdomo (5 IP, 7 K) combined with two relievers on a four-hit 6-0 shutout at Beloit.

2018: Cullen Large went 5-for-5 and scored the game-winning run on a Norberto Obeso RBI single in the bottom of the ninth, helping the Lugnuts complete a four-game home sweep of the Dragons with a thrilling 8-7 win. (Obeso, added to the roster earlier in the day from Extended Spring Training, wore eyeblack that read "I'm back.") The Lugnuts had lost a 4-2 lead and entered the seventh trailing 7-4, but Ryan Noda singled in Large in the seventh, Kacy Clemens tied the score with a two-run single in the eighth, and Obeso won it with a fly that fell between LF Narciso Crook and CF Miles Gordon.

In a Nutshell: Became the final Lugnuts starting pitcher to make his 2023 debut, opening as the Wednesday starter... upon throwing his first pitch, became the 906th player in Lansing Lugnuts franchise history... the last Pitt Panther to start a game for the Lugnuts was also the only other Panther ever to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st overall pick in 2016, who made two starts for Lansing in 2016 and is now in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A - Philadelphia)... @mitch_myers9 on social media.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

College Journey: Initially committed to University of Alabama, joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros)... upon transferring to Pitt, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.

Last Start: tossed gem, betrayed by pen

Needed only 73 pitches (50 strikes) to blank Lake County over five innings... allowed four hits, induced two double plays... departed with 3-0 lead, but Hunter Breault allowed six runs on seven hits in the 6th, leading to Nuts' 6-4 loss.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.
