The Frisco RoughRiders were held in check by the San Antonio Missions on Wednesday, losing 3-0 despite a terrific start from **Jack Leiter** at Riders Field. Leiter (2-3) allowed just one run and two hits in six innings, striking out four against one walk. He gave up a solo homer in the second inning but did not allow a hit to the next 14 batters. He allowed a single to the last batter he faced but Kellen Strahm threw out Cole Cummings at second base on the play. Leiter has allowed just five earned runs in the month of May across 27 innings for a 1.67 ERA. Daniel Camarena (1-2) pitched six shutout innings for the win. Frisco (20-26) has now split the season series so far at four wins apiece with San Antonio (25-22), which remains tied for first place in the South Division. The RoughRiders threatened in the bottom of the ninth inning despite having the bases empty with two outs. Dustin Harris and Nick Tanielu both singled but Alek Jacob induced Liam Hicks into a groundout to record the save. Strahm had the only multiple-hit effort for Frisco, singling twice in the game. Harris walked twice and singled once. After his fifth-inning walk, he stole second and third base during the same at bat. He now leads the Texas League with 21 steals and 36 walks.

PLEASE CONNECT TO POWER:

Over the last 11 games, Frisco has hit just two home runs while batting .217/.327/.290/.617. The two home runs (from **Liam Hicks** and **Trevor Hauver**) are the fewest in the league over the last 11. The Riders are averaging just 3.5 runs per game over the last 11 games, which is the second-fewest in the league (only in front of Northwest Arkansas, 2.5)

SCORE THEM ANY WAY YOU CAN:

The RoughRiders are hitting well this season with a .250/.353/.394/.747 slashline while being fourth in the Texas League in runs per game, averaging 5.3 runs per contest. They are fourth in average, third in OBP, sixth in SLG and fourth in OPS despite being tied for seventh with 42 home runs on the year.

DOESN'T GET BETTER THAN TREVOR:

RoughRiders utility man **Trevor Hauver** was hitting just .163 through April 26th, but he has been on fire since. Over his last 22 games, Hauver is hitting .300 (24-for-80)/.356/.475/.831 with two home runs and 15 RBIs. In his last 15 games, the former Arizona State Sun Devil is hitting .310 (18-for-58) with 14 RBIs. In 2022 with Frisco, Hauver hit .230/.432/.492/.924 over 21 games after starting the season in High-A Hickory.

DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

Dustin Harris has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 21 bags in 43 games this season to lead the Texas League and the entire Rangers organization. If Harris plays 110 games this season, he is on pace for 54 steals, which would by far be a career high. The RoughRiders are third in fewest caught stealings in the league with just eight while stealing 69 bases (90 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE, AND MAKE IT GRANDS

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Liam Hicks** hitting Frisco's sixth grand slam of the season on Saturday. They are the only team with six grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball and the only team with more than four. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese**). Frisco also has a 1.230 OPS with the bags full, which is third in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.391 and Triple-A St. Paul, 1.255).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Through his first 16 games of the season, Saggese was hitting just .203/.254/.281/.535, but he has been on a tear ever since. Over his last 30 games, he is hitting .347 (42-for-121)/.404/.504/.908 with eight doubles, a triple, three homers, 22 RBIs and 22 runs. In the month of May, he is batting .347/.396/.495/.891 and has four games with three or more hits to his name. Saggese is the No. 15 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .302 (51-for-169)/.374/.432/.806 through the first 40 games while ranking sixth in the Texas League in hits (51), tied for eighth in doubles (11) and tied for second in stolen bases (18). Over his last 36 games, he is batting .318/.395/.464/.859. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (119).

On the season, Frisco's 231 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .353 team OBP is third in the Texas League. Dustin Harris is first in the league with 36 walks while Evan Carter is eighth in OBP (.412) in the league and third in the league with 32 walks

-White was drafted out of Jesse C. Carson High School in China Grove, North Carolina in 2018. He won the
2018 North Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year award, going 10-1 with a 0.22 ERA his senior year, striking
out 101 over 63.2 innings. He also played shortstop and finished his career as the school's all-time record
holder in hits, runs, RBIs, wins and strikeouts. Also played basketball and football (had some small-school

-Originally committed to the University of South Carolina before signing for \$1.5 million with the Rangers. Texas used the No. 15 pick on RHP Cole Winn (Rangers Milb Pitcher of the Year in 2021 with the RoughRiders) and signed him underslot to help sign White overslot. Was thought to be a two-way player

2023 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Opened the 2023 season with three shutout innings against Amarillo on April 7th. He was working his way back up from a neck injury that kept him out for a couple weeks during Spring Training.

-Threw first quality start for RoughRiders pitchers on April 25th at Amarillo, allowing three runs over six innings. He retired the first 10 he saw and allowed just one baserunner on a single through five innings.

2022 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 8 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com

-Over his last three starts in Hickory, before being promoted to Frisco, White went 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4ER/19.0IP) while striking out 30 and just walking three over 19.0 innings.

rded five quality starts over his 10 total starts, including a 7.0 innings, 1 ER, 11 K start on June 11th.

-With Hickory, owned a 45.8 percent groundball rate, 10th in the South Atlantic League. Also had a 16.4 percent swinging strike rate (3rd in SAL) and a 33.3 percent strikeout rate (4th).

-Was dominant in Double-A debut on June 25th, allowing one runs until an inherited run came across over his 5.1 innings in Arkansas.

-Threw 5.1 hitless innings with seven strikeouts on July 1st against CC, winning Texas League Pitcher of the Week. Left game with left ankle injury, but was able to make next scheduled start. Riders lost nohitter in 7th inning when Seth Nordlin allowed single, but Frisco won 5-0.

2021 SEASON

-Was Low-A Down East's Opening Day starer before punching the ground after an error and breaking his hand on May 4th. He returned to the Wood Ducks on August 10th.

-From The Athletic: "As soon as I did that, CY (general manager Chris Young) called me and basically said the Rangers have my back and they knew that it wasn't out of like hatred or trying to hurt myself," White explained on Monday. "It was more going out and competing and my enotions got the best of me at that moment in time. It's not like I came in the dugout and punched something at a locker, it was just — emotions got the best of me, I did what I did, and now I had to pay the consequence. But ..." White paused and nodded before giving a wry smile. "I promised them that I would never do it again."

-After making just nine outings on the season, he won Arizona Fall League "Pitcher of the Year", going 5-0 with a 1.91 ERA and 29 strikeouts over a league-best 28.1 innings.
