Syracuse Mets News and Notes

Heating Up: Over his last 26 games since June 27th, **Wilfredo Tovar** is 37-for-92 (.402) with 17 RBIs, three home runs, eight doubles, 17 walks, and seven strikeouts. Since June 27th, Tovar leads the league with his .402 batting average and is first with a .500 on-base percentage. Tovar has hits in 24 of his last 26 games. Tovar has hit four home runs in his last 28 games played after not hitting a home run in his first 23 games...**Drew Jackson** since July 1st is 25-for-69 (.362) with 15 RBIs and three home runs in 24 games. In his first 41 games, Jackson hit .210 with 15 RBIs and three home runs.

Offensive Turnaround: Since breaking a 15-game losing streak on June 25th, Syracuse is 13-16 and ranks fifth in the Triple-A East League with a .267 batting average. In the previous 45 games, Syracuse ranked 16th out of 20 teams with a .230 batting average and had a 12-33 record. Also since June 25th, Syracuse leads the league with a .378 on-base percentage.

Close Calls: 27 of Syracuse's last 38 games have been decided by three runs or less. Syracuse is 9-18 in the 27 games decided by three runs or less. Eight of those games went to extra innings (SYR: 4-4 record). Syracuse has held a lead in 25 of its last 38 games. The Mets are 14-24 in their last 38 games, including 5-6 in games decided by more than three runs.

Send back the Reinforcements: Syracuse has had **Jeff McNeil, Michael Comfarto, Albert Almora Jr., Tomás Nido, Brandon Nimmo, Jeurys Familia, Jonathan Villar, J.D. Davis, and Carlos Carrasco** complete rehab assignments with the team this season.

League Leaders: Syracuse is fourth in the Triple-A East League with a .352 on-base percentage...The Mets lead the league with 86 **stolen bases**, one more than Worcester...The Mets lead the league defensively in **double plays** with 78...**Wilfredo Tovar** is 12th in the league with a .293 batting average and seventh with a .394 on-base percentage...**Drew Jackson** is tied for second in the league with 42 walks, ranks third with a .412 on-base percentage, and is tied for fourth with 16 stolen bases... **Khalil Lee** ranks tied for second with 42 walks and is a few plate appearances shy of qualifying for the lead leaderboard, but would rank second with a .443 on-base percentage...**Jesús Reyes** is second in the league with 83.1 IP and is tied for sixth with 75 strikeouts.

Mets Dig the Long Ball: Syracuse has hit 83 home runs this season, scoring 131 total runs from those homers. That accounts for 36% of Syracuse's run production this season (367 runs).

Capacity Updates: NBT Bank Stadium capacity is nearly 100%. All but three sections will be at 100% with those three sections having socially-distanced seating for fans who are more comfortable in that setting. 549 seats will be "buffer seats" in the socially-distanced sections as NBT Bank Stadium's capacity is 10,266 (95%) out of full capacity of 10,815.


