FROM THE CROWS NEST

WELCOME TO THE STRETCH RUN: After splitting their six-game set with Lakeland, Bradenton is off to a 20-22 start in the second half, currently 4.0 games behind the Threshers for the FSL West's final playoff spot (also up 1.5 games up Fort Myers). With 24 games to go, the Marauders are eyeing their first postseason appearance since 2021 when they won their second FSL title. After taking two of three from the Mighty Mussels two weeks ago, they have secured the season-series win which gives them the tie-break advantage if the two teams finish with even records at the end of the season. The Marauders don't have the head-to-head advantage with Clearwater.

TEJADA TUESDAY: Right hander **Clevari Tejada** will toe to rubber for the Marauders in game one of the series for his team-leading 20th start. Over a career-best 76 innings this season, Tejada has pitched to a 4.03 ERA and completed five innings or more six times. Last Tuesday at Lakeland, Tejada matched a season high by tossing six frames of two-run ball punching out four hitters. Over his five outings in July, Tejada was dominant, allowing just four earned runs over 19 innings of work (1.189 ERA). Before his last two starts, he has tossed 12 innings without allowing a run to begin the month. Tejada's fastball saw a major uptick in velocity in July, as he has averaged 94.9 miles per hour and topped out at 96.9 - good for his hardest pitch of the season. 12 of his 13 hardest thrown pitches this year have come during his last five outings. Tejada's slider has been a plus offering to both left-and-right-handed hitters, as opposing batters at just 4-for-39 against it (.103, 42.3% Whiff). His splitter has also surrendered just eight hits this season (.211) and has generated a 38.3 percent whiff rate.

ELECTRIC EDWARD: Bradenton Marauders outfielder Edward Florentino was named Florida State League Player of the Month for his dominant performance in July. He remains the only Marauders player to be honored this season by Minor League Baseball. Over the 23-game stretch, Florentino slashed .301/.433/.663 with 16 stolen bases and 17 walks. His eight home runs and 23 RBI were the most of any player throughout the Florida State League and Single-A. Florentino was also one of three Single-A players, and the only in the FSL, to tally 15 or more walks and ten or more extra-base hits. Florentino is the Pirates No. 6 ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline and was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on June 21.

TONY TATORS: Pirates No. 21 prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Tony Blanco Jr.** demolished his first two Single-A homers during the Marauders previous homestand. On July 30, he sent a fastball 415 feet to left field, that cleared the confines of LECOM Park. The ball left his bat at 118.9 miles per hour, marking the hardest-hit ball in Single-A at the time, clearing the next closest batted ball by 4.4 mph. Three nights later, he also demolished a walk-off three-run homer that left the bat at 119.8 mph - the hardest-batted ball in MiLB this season. Only three batted balls at the Major-League level have been hit harder this season. He joins Oneil Cruz (122.9 mph) and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (120.4 mph) on the list. Only him and Cruz (122.9 mph) have left the yard with such batted ball quality. He was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 at Jupiter.

MARAUDERS MASHERS: The Bradenton Marauders return from the All-Star Break as one of the best home-run hitting teams in all of Class-A. Their 87 longballs this season are the most in the Florida State League and second in Class-A (San Jose - California League, 92). 134 of their 489 total runs have been generated via the long ball (27.4%). They're 32-25 when leaving the yard at least once, and 18-29 when not homering at all. They've seen four players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (**A. Plaz**, **Y. De Los Santos**, **K. Griffin**, **J. Severino**)

BURNING THE BASE PATHS: **Yordany De Los Santos** stole his 43rd stolen base last weekend, adding to a career-best mark (34 between FCL/Single-A in 2024). In the process, he's passed **Jesus Castillo** (39 - 2023), for the most single-season stolen bases by a Marauder in franchise history. He ranks first in the Florida State League and seventh in Single-A. Moreover, he sits only behind **Konnor Griffin** (53) for the most swipes in the Pittsburgh Pirates system. They are the ninth and tenth 40+ stolen-base seasons in Pirates-MiLB history. The two are approaching **Rich Thompson** for the most in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer since 2005 when he stole 58 that season between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis.

MARAUDERS ON THE MEND: In this year's draft the Pittsburgh Pirates selected RHP **Seth Hernandez** sixth overall in the first round of the 2025 MLB Draft and signed with the organization on Tuesday for 7.25 million dollars, the largest bonus ever for a prep pitcher. Hernandez was recently named 2025 Gatorade National High School Player of the Year and spent the 2025 season as a senior at Corona High School in California (0.39 ERA/53.1IP, 105 K). He was committed to Vanderbilt University. At 19 years old, he was touted as the best prep arm in the draft, and the No. 3 overall prospect in the draft class via MLB Pipeline. His fastball reached 100 miles per hour, paired with an esteemed changeup, curveball and slider. Other notable selections included **C Easton Carmichael** (3rd Rd., Oklahoma), **SS Gustavo Melendez** (4th Rd., HS) and **1B Jared Jones** (9th Rd., LSU) among others.

Right hander **Clevari Tejada** will toe to rubber for the Marauders in game one of the series for his team-leading 20th start. Over a career-best 76 innings this season, Tejada has pitched to a 4.03 ERA and completed five innings or more six times. Last Tuesday at Lakeland, Tejada matched a season high by tossing six frames of two-run ball punching out four hitters. Over his five outings in July, Tejada was dominant, allowing just four earned runs over 19 innings of work (1.189 ERA). Before his last two starts, he has tossed 12 innings without allowing a run to begin the month. Tejada's fastball saw a major uptick in velocity in July, as he has averaged 94.9 miles per hour and topped out at 96.9 - good for his hardest pitch of the season. 12 of his 13 hardest thrown pitches this year have come during his last five outings. Tejada's slider has been a plus offering to both left-and-right-handed hitters, as opposing batters at just 4-for-39 against it (.103, 42.3\$ Whiff).His splitter has also surrendered just eight hits this season (.211) and has generated a 38.3 percent whiff rate.
