### RIDERS DROPPED BY NATURALS ON FRIDAY NIGHT:

The Frisco RoughRiders came back from a 3-0 deficit to tie the game but never took a lead on Friday, falling 6-3 to the Northwest Arkansas Naturals at Riders Field. Frisco (30-31, 61-67) falls to seven games back of Amarillo with eight games remaining in the hunt for a playoff berth. Northwest Arkansas (30-30, 58-60) has won three of four games this week. Frisco's starter, **Ryan Garcia**, lasted five innings. He allowed three runs, two earned, all in the third inning. Garcia gave up just three hits and struck out eight in a no-decision. Down 3-0 in the fourth inning, Frisco put a pair of tallies on the board including **Wyatt Langford's** first Double-A run. Langford had walked to lead off the inning and advanced on **Liam Hicks'** single and **Aaron Zavala's** walk. Langford scored on a wild pitch, followed by **Frainery Chavez's** RBI groundout. Langford went 0-for-2 on Friday with a pair of walks in his fourth Double-A game. The 2023 fourth-overall selection has two hits this week including a double, an RBI and four walks. The Riders tied the game at 3-3 in the sixth inning, beginning with **Jax Biggers'** bunt single. He scored after three straight walks, with **Kellen Strahm** earning the RBI base on balls. The Naturals broke the tie in the eighth, scoring one run and saddling **Triston Polley** (2-3) with the loss. The Naturals added two unearned runs in the ninth to take a 6-3 lead. Frisco's bullpen allowed one earned run on Friday and has given up just three earned runs this week in 19 innings. TJ Sikkema (4-4) earned the win for Northwest Arkansas, pitching one inning without a hit. Jacob Wallace took the save by pitching a clean ninth inning.

### WELCOME, WYATT:

**Wyatt Langford**, who was taken with the No. 4 pick by the Rangers in the 2023 draft, was promoted to Frisco on Monday. He is the No. 2 prospect in the Rangers system and No. 13 in MLB.com's top 100 prospects. At the University of Florida, he was a Unanimous First Team All-American selection after leading the Gators to the College World Series Championship Finals, where they fell to the LSU Tigers. On the season, the outfielder hit an astounding .373/.471/.746/1.217 with 21 home runs and 57 RBIs over 64 games. In his Double-A debut on Monday, he went 0-for-4, and he went 2-for-2 with a walk and a sac fly in his second game on Wednesday.

### THE CARTER STORY GETS EVAN BETTER:

On Thursday, the Texas Rangers announced that No. 1 prospect and former RoughRiders outfielder **Evan Carter** was called up to the Major League roster. A second-round selection in 2020 by the Rangers out of Elizabethton High School in Elizabethton, Tennessee, Carter spent the last week of 2022 and the playoffs with Frisco before beginning the season with the RoughRiders in 2023. During the 2022 season, he won the Tom Grieve Texas Rangers Minor League Player of the Year award, batting .295/.397/.489/.886 with 21 doubles, 10 triples, 12 home runs and 28 steals over 106 games. In 97 games with the RoughRiders in 2023, Carter hit .284/.411/.451/.862 with 15 doubles, six triples, 12 home runs, 62 runs, 74 walks, 68 runs scored and 22 steals. When he was promoted to Triple-A Round Rock, Carter was second in the Texas League in walks (74) and on-base percentage (.411) while he was sixth in OPS (.862). In his MLB debut, he went 1-for-3 with a single, a walk and a stolen base.

### BROKEN BATS:

Since the exit of **Thomas Saggese** and **Luisangel Acuña** at the end of July, the RoughRiders have had a tough time scoring runs on the offensive side. Since August 1st, the RoughRiders are last in the Texas League with just 4.5 runs per game, a .236 batting average and 20 home runs over their 34 games. The 20 home runs during that time frame are the fewest in Double-A.

### DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in six of the last 13 games. The Riders are first in the Texas League in first-inning runs with 96 over their 129 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .272/.368/.433/.801 in the first inning with 14 home runs.

### WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 644 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .355 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. The Riders already have four players who have cracked the top 10 in single-season walks in franchise history: **Evan Carter** (74, 5th), **Trevor Hauver** (71, 6th), **Kellen Strahm** (69, 8th) and **Aaron Zavala** (69, 8th). In 2015, **Drew Robinson** set the single-season record with 83 walks. Strahm is also third in career walks in RoughRiders franchise history with 134. Next up is **Preston Beck**, who walked 143 times over his four seasons with the Riders.

### HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

**Liam Hicks** has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 43 games, Hicks is batting .306 (45-for-147)/.425/.395/.820 with eight doubles, a triple, a home run, 22 RBIs, 25 walks and 18 runs scored. In August, he hit .338 (26-for-77) with a .890 OPS.

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of five teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

### ABOUT JACK

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 87 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

### 2023 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2023 season as the No. 78 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system.

-In May, Leiter went 2-1 over five starts with a 1.67 ERA. Over 27.0 innings, Leiter struck out 33 while walking 13.

-After his July 7th start against Midland (0.1 IP, 6R, 5 ER), Leiter was placed on the Development List and stayed there for 44 days.

### 2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No.1 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Leiter dazzled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen in a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

-The righty allowed just one home run over his first nine outings before allowing two against Amarillo on June 7th. The two home runs were a grand slam and a two-run shot in a 7-4 loss to the Sod Poodles.

-Leiter was placed on the Development List on June 28th and was activated on July 10th before his start against San Antonio.

-Pitched a 1-2-3 inning on nine pitches in The SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game from Dodger Stadium on July 16th.

### 2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

### MORE INFO

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees shortstop Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).
