Today is a Coors Light Thirsty Thursday between the Lansing Lugnuts and the Dayton Dragons, the fourth game in a seven-game, six-day series between the two clubs, and part of a larger 18-game season series. The Nuts are 2-3 against Dayton and 239-195 all-time vs. the Dragons dating back to 2000 after dropping a twinbill yesterday.

Yesterday: A long day at the ballpark. The Dragons defeat the Lugnuts, 5-2, in Game 1 of a doubleheader beginning at 11:04 a.m., and then blanked Lansing 7-0 in Game 2 ending at 6:04 p.m. Game 1 ended at 1:19, but Game 2 didn't start until 3:50 due to a rain delay.

LUG-NOTES

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has No. 8 (Devin Taylor), No. 16 (Steven Echavarría), No. 19 (Zane Taylor), No. 26 (Nate Nankil) and No. 30 (Bobby Boser) on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects.

All Aboard: Shortstop Bobby Boser went 1-for-3 with a single in both games of yesterday's doubleheader and has now reached base in 21 straight games (25 hits, 12 walks and four HBPs). Davis Diaz, however, went 0-for-3 in Game 2 to halt his on-base streak at 17 games.

Cincinnati's Own: Outfielder Devin Taylor, born in the Queen City, is slashing .393/.487/.623 in his last 18 games, going 24-for-61 with five doubles, three home runs, three steals, and 13 walks. Taylor's personal hitting coach, coincidentally, is 2011 Lugnut Lance Durham, who batted .182/.279/.327 with 11 doubles and four homers in 50 games.

Going Deep: No starting rotation in the Midwest League has thrown more innings than Lansing (104 1/3) or Dayton (103 1/3).

Milestone Watch: Lansing is eight wins away from the 2,000 in Lugnuts history and 3 players away from 1,000 players all-time.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, Carlos Beltrán went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

Miller Time: The most dominant former Lugnut in the Majors is untouchable Padres closer / 2022 Lugnut Mason Miller... but Mason had his 35 2/3-inning scoreless streak stopped Monday, giving up two runs on three hits in an inning in a 9-7 win over the Cubs. Of his 37 appearances since joining the Padres, 35 have been scoreless – not including his four scoreless innings in the WBC for Team USA.

Major League Nut: The 201st Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues, 2023 Lugnuts catcher Daniel Susac, has opened his career batting .478 (11-for-23) with two doubles and a triple through 11 games with the Giants. Debuting on April 1, Susac hit safely in his first five at-bats, setting a new Giants modern-day franchise record and coming up one shy of the Major League modern-day franchise record set by Boston OF Ted Cox in 1977. Susac was taken in the Rule 5 Draft by Minnesota and traded to San Francisco.

Player of the Week, April 7-12: The first Midwest League Player of the Week was 23-year-old Lansing C/3B Davis Diaz, who batted .611 (11-for-19) while reaching base 16 times and scoring nine runs in five games at Fort Wayne. Diaz added four doubles, four walks, one HBP, and two runners caught stealing.

2010: For the second straight day, the Lugnuts and River Bandits played a game in two hours and six minutes. This one featured 18 hits (nine apiece) in a 4-3 Quad Cities victory, played at Duane Banks Field in Iowa City, home of the Iowa Hawkeyes, the third stadium (and third city) to host the Lugnuts/Bandits following flooding in Davenport.

2010: Fort Wayne turned a 4-2 deficit into a 10-4 win with eight runs in the top of the 8th at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2022: Jeff Criswell came three outs from a no-hitter, settling for a one-hitter in a doubleheader split at Classic Park.

In a Nutshell: In first full season in pro ball after getting drafted last year in the 10th round... debuted in relief on Opening Day (took loss in 8-7 defeat to Dayton), then tossed five scoreless innings in 2-1 loss at Fort Wayne, April 9... enjoys fishing.

Last Game: started at Quad Cities on April 23, suffering the loss: 4 2/3 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 3 ER, 1 HBP, 3 BB, 4 K, 77 pitches, 42 strikes... allowed two runs in the 2nd inning, departed with two runners aboard in the 5th... both scored against Jack Mahoney, proving crucial in a 4-3 defeat.

Before College: Batted .515 with .612 OBP, 4 HR, 39 RBI as a senior at Westbrook Christian High School, leading Warriors to 2021 state title (first title in school history)... threw four no-hitters, one a perfect game, as a senior, going 9-0, 0.40 ERA, 53 IP, 14 H, 5 BB, 117 K... Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American... pitched for 2019 USA Baseball 16U National Team Development Program.

College: Spent three years at LSU, one year at Auburn... ascended to Game 3 starter as true freshman at LSU in 2022, spent 2023 as reliever and was named SEC Academic Honor Roll (sport administration), majority reliever in 2024 (tossing 1 1/3 scoreless IP vs. Tennessee in SEC championship game)... transferred to AU for senior season and was named Second Team All-SEC (first Auburn player to earn All-SEC since 2018) and ABCA First Team All-Southeast Region... led Auburn in wins (7) and strikeouts (95), the most strikeouts for a Tiger since 2019... played with older brother Andrew at Auburn; Andrew had been at Birmingham-Southern for four years, forced to transfer when they shut their baseball program; he transferred in to Auburn for 2025 and blasting a home run in his only plate appearance of the year.

Pro Ball: Signed for \$150,000 as the 290th pick in 2025, the fifth pick of the 10th round... one of seven Tigers drafted, led by Orioles first-rounder Ike Irish... made pro debut on August 21, 2025, vs. Lake Elsinore with one hitless innings, one walk, two strikeouts... after two scoreless relief appearances, finished the year with three short starts, fanning five in 1 2/3 innings vs. Visalia on September 7 in final appearance... right-handers were 3-for-17 (.176) with eight strikeouts, lefties went 4-for-12 (.333) with five strikeouts.
