LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones rallied from 4-0 down in the top of the 9th to stun the Blue Rocks, 5-4, on Saturday...DH William Lugo started the comeback with a two-run home run before RF Jefrey De Los Santos brought in a tally on a fielder's choice...LF Nick Morabito and SB Jacob Reimer provided back-to-back singles to tie the game and provide Brooklyn the lead...The Cyclones sent all 9 hitters to the plate in the 9th...RHP Dakota Hawkins worked around a leadoff single to finish his 3.0 innings and close out the victory...RHP Jonah Tong tossed a quality start for Brooklyn, allowing 3 runs over 6.0 innings...CF Omar De Los Santos finished with 3 hits, while Lugo added a multi-hit game of his own...RHP Bryan Cáceres took a no-decision for Wilmington, striking out 6 over 6.0 shutout innings.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On August 18, 2005, the Cyclones tied the game in the 9th on a DH Caleb Stewart double and won in the 11th on a RF Michael Sharpe RBI single in a 4-3 win vs. Williamsport...In 2016, down 5-4 in the 8th, Brooklyn tied the game on a wild pitch and jumped in front on a two-run 2B Jay Jabs single to defeat Staten Island on the road, 7-5...In 2019, completing a game suspended due to fog from the night before, Brooklyn scored 2 runs in the 6th to beat Tri-City, 2-1...The Cyclones won the finale in 8 innings, 5-3, on a walk-off two-run home run by 2B Yoel Romero...In 2021, Brooklyn erased a 7-4 deficit with a 7-run 8th inning...The Cyclones take the lead on a 3-run triple by CF Jaylen Palmer and cap the frame on 1B Jeremy Vasquez's 2-run home run in an 11-7 win at Hudson Valley...In 2023, Brooklyn came from 4-2 down in the 5th to win vs. Hudson Valley, 8-5...The Cyclones tied the game on LF Ryan Clifford's single and took the lead on a 3-run RF Stanley Consuegra home run.

**UPCOMING PROMOTIONS** 

COMEBACK 'CLONES: Brooklyn erased another multi-run 9th-inning deficit on Saturday en route to a 5-4 win at Wilmington...Since the All-Star break, the Cyclones have won 3 games when trailing after 8 innings after failing to do so before that...Brooklyn also came back from 5-0 down in the 9th to win 6-5 vs. Jersey Shore in 10 innings on July 19 and erased a 6-4 deficit in the 9th in a 7-6 win vs. Rome... The Cyclones have won 7 games in their final at-bat since returning from the break.

MORABITO BITE: OF Nick Morabito has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The McLean, Va. native is tied for ninth in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (50)...Morabito is 1-of-4 players in MiLB with 50 or more runs scored, walks, and stolen bases...High-A Eugene OF Jonah Cox (77 R/56 BB/57 SB). Double-A Biloxi OF Dylan O'Rae (74/74/53), and High-A Tri-City INF Caleb Ketchup (58/50/51) are the others...Morabito is the only one of the 4 to hold a batting average over .300 (304)...With two swipes (39) last Thursday, he broke OF Omar De Los Santos' single-season franchise record of 37, which was set last year...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (88), is 2nd in stolen bases (39), tied for 2nd in games played (78), and 6th in runs scored (50) and batting average (.281)...The former 2nd-round selection is 4th in the SAL in stolen bases (39) 7th in batting average (.281), and tied for 8th in hits (88) for the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.304), stolen bases (50), on-base percentage (.396)...He is also 2nd in hits (119), tied for 2nd in runs scored (64), 3rd in total bases (149), tied for 3rd in triples (4), and 5th in OPS (.777).

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit and all High-A pitchers in strikeouts (98)... The 98 strikeouts are also 8th in the circuit overall...Tong also leads the SAL in batting average against (218), is 2nd in ERA (3.70), 3rd in WHIP (130), and 6th in innings pitched (75.1) since that date...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 90.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is 1st in FIP (2.19), 3rd in strikeout rate (34.4%), 6th in strikeouts (134), and 7th in strikeout-to-walk rate (23.8%)...Since 2021, Tong's 134 strikeouts are the 8th-most in a season by a New York Mets farmhand...RHP Dominic Hamel has the most with 160 K's at Double-A Binghamton in 2023.

TO SMITH-EREENS: UT D'Andre Smith has been blasting the ball across the diamond since returning from the 7-day injured list on July 22...The 23-year-old has 3rd multi-hit games during an 8-contest on-base streak dating back to the opening game of last Wednesday's doubleheader vs. Hudson Valley...In that span, Smith is hitting 345/.387/.414 with a .781 OPS, 2 doubles, 2 RBI, and 2 stolen bases...The 23-year-old is hitting .262/.286/.344 in 17 games since being reinstated but has hit another gear since the calendar flipped to August...In 11 games this month, Smith is batting .342/.375/.474 with a .849 OPS, 2 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 4 RBI, and 2 steals...The former 5th-round pick is 5th in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.342) during August (min. 40 PA).

**EXTRAI EXTRAI:** The Cyclones' offense picked up 7 extra-base hits in Thursday's 8-5 win at Wilmington...The 7 extra-base knocks (6 doubles and a home run) were the most for Brooklyn in a single game since tallying 8 (6 doubles and 2 home runs) in an 8-5 win at Jersey Shore on August 25, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' record for extra-base hits in a game is 10, accomplished on June 24 and July 10, 2010 vs. Hudson Valley and State College, respectively...The 6 doubles in Thursday's game were a season-high for the club and the most since that 6-double performance on

vs. WILMINGTON: The Cyclones play their final in-division road series of 2024 against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks have two of Washington's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP Jarlin Susana (4) and OF Robert Hassell III (13)...Hassell is with the club on a Minor League rehab assignment...The Cyclones are 7-9 against the Blue Rocks this season, but just 3-7 at Frawley Stadium...Since moving to the full-season level in 2021, Brooklyn is 52-48 alltime against Wilmington (.520).

August 25, 2022, at Jersey Shore...The franchise mark since 2005 is 7, accomplished three times, most recently on August 3, 2015, at Lowell.

NONE SHALL PASS: The Cyclones' bullpen had a 17.2-inning streak without allowing an earned run snapped with DH T.J. White's solo home run in the third inning on Thursday...The stretch began in the fourth inning on Saturday vs. Hudson Valley...The 'Clones bullpen did not allow a hit in 11.0 consecutive innings with 19 strikeouts from SS George Lombard Jr.'s two-out single in the eighth inning on Saturday night until 1B Roismar Quintana's single in the sixth inning on Wednesday...RHP Eduardo Herrera, LHP Ryan Ammons, RHP Jordany Ventura, and RHP Alan Perdomo also combined to retire 22 hitters in a row from one out in the ninth inning on Saturday until one out in the eighth inning on Tuesday.

A DOZEN DONUTS: Brooklyn's 2-0 win at Wilmington on Tuesday night marked the team's 12th shutout of the year, setting a new single-season franchise record...The Cyclones tied the 2023 squad's franchise record with its 11th shutout in July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The Cyclones had blanked Wilmington in consecutive matchups and had thrown 21.1 consecutive scoreless frames against them dating back from the fifth inning on July 13 until the first inning on Wednesday...The 12 shutouts are two behind Rome and Hudson Valley (14) for the most in the South Atlantic League.

WENN IN BROOKLYN: RHP Jack Wenninger suffered the defeat in his first start at the High-A level, but has quickly figured things out at the classification since... After tossing 5.0-plus innings of shutout ball for his first High-A win on Tuesday, the 22-year-old is a 1-0 with a 1.31 ERA (3 ER in 20.2 IP) and one hold in his last 5 appearances (4 starts) since July 14 at Wilmington...Wenninger has surrendered 15 hits and 9 walks while striking out 27 in that span...The Barrington, Ill. native is 4th in the South Atlantic League (min. 20.0 IP) in ERA (1.31), 9th in batting average against (.192), and tied for 10th in strikeouts (27) in that time.

OMAR-I-GONE: OF Omar De Los Santos rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The 25-year-old clubbed a go-ahead three-run home run in the sixth inning on Thursday in Wilmington and powered a walk-off solo home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Rome on July 28...6 of his 7 home runs since returning from Double-A Binghamton tied the game or provided Brooklyn the lead...Since the All-Star break, Omar is tied for 2nd in the league in triples (2) and home runs (6), tied for 3rd in runs scored (16), 4th in slugging (.538), tied for 4th in total bases (42) and RBI (16), 8th in OPS (.860), and tied for 8th in extra-base hits (9)...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League for the year with 36 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's then-single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT Jaylen Palmer's (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (73) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is 2nd in the South Atlantic League (73) and is 5th across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (145).

IT'S A WALK-OFF: For the 4th time in 10 home games, Brooklyn earned a walk-off victory thanks to 3B Jacob Reimer's 2-run single in the bottom of the 7th in Game 1 of Wednesday's double-dip with Hudson Valley...In the Cyclones' previous home game, on July 28 vs. Rome, 3B Jefrey De Los Santos blasted a game-tying 2-run home run in the 9th before LF Omar De Los Santos followed with a walk-off solo shot in a 7-6 triumph...The back-to-back jacks marked just the 2nd time Brooklyn had accomplished the feat in 2024...SS William Lugo and CF Stanley Consuegra clubbed consecutive home runs in the 6th inning on May 18 at Bowling Green...It was also Brooklyn's 2nd walk-off home run of the season...3B Nick Lorussos smacked a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ininth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...The Cyclones also earned walk-off wins in those 10 home affairs on July 9, via C Chris Suero's game-winning bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Jersey Shore and, again, on July 24, courtesy of SS Wilfredo Lara's walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Rome...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 18 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.63% of all defeats, including 26.0

9% of all road losses, while earning 12 walk-off wins...30 of Brooklyn's 244 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.30%).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF Jesús Báez (10), RHP Jonah Tong (17), INF Jacob Reimer (22), RHP Jack Wenninger (27), and RHP Calvin Ziegler (30)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season IL...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (10), Báez (14), OF Nick Morabito (19), Reimer (20), and Wenninger (30).

LAST TIME OUT: Took a decision in his final start with Single-A St. Lucie last Sunday vs. Bradenton...Did not allow a run or a hit over 2.0 innings...Walked 1 and struck out 4...Threw 27 pitches and 15 strikes (55.56%)...Relieved by LHP **Franklin Gó**mez to start the top of the the 3rd inning and the Mets in front 4-1...St. Lucie went on to defeat the Marauders, 6-3.

COMEBACK TRAIL: Troesser has missed time this season on the injured list...The 22-year-old landed on Single-A St. Lucie's 7-day lL on May 26 and was reinstated 54 days later on July 19... In 3 appearances (1 start) since returning to the active roster, Troesser has no record, but earned a hold...The University of Missouri alum has not allowed a run on 2 hits in 5.0 innings...He walked only 1, struck out 7, and induced a double play before joining the Cyclones on July 15.

NO TROESS-PASSING: While the Loose Creek, Mo. native has had his season altered by injury, he has racked up the strikeouts when on the bump...Troesser recorded a career-high 9 whiffs over 4.2 innings of two-hit, shutout ball in a no-decision vs. Jupiter on May 1...The right-hander also picked up 8-strike-out performances in starts on April 19 vs. Tampa and May 7 at Bradenton...Among Florida State League pitchers (min. 30.0 IP), Troesser was tied for 7th in strikeout-to-walk rate (23.8%) and 8th in strikeout rate (34.4%).

**HOME COOKING:** Troesser thrived pitching at home during his stint in the Florida State League...At St. Lucie's Clover Park, the 22-year-old held an 0-2 record, but a sparkling 1.86 ERA (4 ER in 19.1 IP) in 6 games (4 starts) with 11 walks and 28 K's...In visiting ballparks, Troesser was 1-2 with a 7.02 ERA (13 ER in 16.2 IP), 5 walks, and 24 strikeouts in 7 outings (2 starts).

**2023:** Selected by the New York Mets in the 4th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of Missouri...Taken with the compensation pick the Mets received for losing RHP **Chris Bassitt** as a free agent to the Toronto Blue Jays...Signed with New York on July 14 and assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 22...Made his lone start and professional debut on August 22 at the FCL Cardinals...Plunked and walked a hitter, but struck out 3 in a scoreless inning.

EYE OF THE TIGER: Troesser spent his college career close to home at the University of Missouri...Attended Fatima High School (Westphalia, Mo.) located just 47 miles south east of the university...Collected a 5-3 record with a 4.73 ERA (24 ER in 45.2 IP), and 1 save in 22 appearances (3 starts) for the Tigers as a junior in 2023...Walked 17 and struck out 53...Over 37 career outings (10 starts) at the collegiate level, Troesser went 8-5 with a 4.98 ERA (43 ER in 77.2 IP), 1 save, 36 walks, and 76 strikeouts...Majored in Agriculture System Technology while at
