CARDINALS SPLIT TWINBILL ON THURSDAY NIGHT: The Cardinals defeated the NW Arkansas Naturals 6-3 in game one but dropped game two 1-0 on Thursday night at Arvest Ballpark in Springdale. The Cards rapped out nine hits, including a 3-for-3 performance from catcher Jimmy Crooks and two RBI games from Noah Mendlinger and Bryan Torres. Tekoah Roby fired a season-high 5.1 IP allowing just 1 ER with 4 K to pick up his second win of the season. Edwin Nuñez fired 4.0 shutout innings for the second straight start in game two, but the Cardinals lost 1-0 on a walk-off wild pitch in the bottom of the 7th inning.



DPPOSING STARTER: Left-hander **Tyson Guerrero** makes his 4th start (5th appearance) of the season...Last pitched on Friday, May 3 against Wichita and allowed 6 ER on 4 H in just 1.2 IP with 3 BB and 4 K in relief of Eric Cerantola...Went 0-1 with a 1.59 ERA in 3 starts in April, striking out 14 batters in 11.1 IP...Made 3 starts with Northwest Arkansas to finish the 2023 season going 1-2 with a 6.55 ERA, striking out 15 batters in 11.0 IP...Began last season at High-A Quad Cities going 2-4 with a 3.63 ERA in 18 appearances (17 starts), racking up 106 K to just 29 BB in 84.1 IP...Limited to just 6 starts with Quad Cities in 2022 because of shoulder injuries and went 0-3 with a 6.17 ERA...Made 9 appearances between ACL and Low-A Columbia in 2021...Selected by the Royals in the 12th round of the 2021 draft out of Washington... Went 3-3 with a 2.96 ERA in redshirt sophomore season with the Huskies...Pitched at Lower Columbia CC in 2020 making 2 starts in the COVID-shortened season...Was a two-way player at Washington State as a freshman in 2019, going 1-2 with a 3.63 ERA in 19 appearances while hitting .277 with 2 HR and 5 2B in 94 ABs...25 years old

CARDS, NATURALS CLASH FOR FIRST TIME IN 2023: The Springfield Cardinals conclude their 12game, two-city road trip in Srpingdale, AR with a six-game series against the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (Double-A, Kansas City Royals). It is the first meeting of the season between the two North Divsion rivals. The Naturals finished 64-74 in 2023, the worst record in the Texas League by a half-game.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

TWD-DUT MAGIC: Of the 19 runs the Cardinals have scored in their last 4 games, 17 (89.4%) have come with two outs. Despite a .217 average over that time, the Cards have notched 16 RBIs. All 11 Springfield runs in the first three games of their series against the Naturals have been scored with two outs.

BIRDS BOAST BEST DOUBLE-A OFFENSE: Through 29 games the Cardinals lead the three Double-A leagues with a .266 batting average; the Arkansas Travelers are next at .260. The Cards also lead the the level in runs RBIs (154) and OBP (.358). Springfield is 2nd in runs (166), tied for 4th in hits (251) and has also been particularly prodcutive hitting situationally with 15 sacrifice flies this season, tied with the Reading Fightin' Phils for most in Double-A.

The Cards' bats, however, have cooled off since April 26, batting just .235 over their last 11 games which ranks 7th in the Texas League during that time

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cardinals have struck out just 212 times in 29 games, the 2nd-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. The Cardinals trail only the Spokane Indians (199 K's) for fewest whiffs in the minor leagues. The Indians, however, have played four fewer games than the Cardinals (25). The Birds are averaging just 7.3 K's per game.

STAFF LODKING TO GET BACK ON TRACK: Since the Cardinals' franchise-record nine-game winning streak to start the season, Springfield has struggled to prevent runs the way they did at the outset. Over their last 18 games since April 16, the Cards have a 5.93 ERA, the highest mark in the Texas League by a run (Amarillo Sod Poodles, 4.93). Springfield's WHIP (1.63) and opponents batting average (.278) are also last in the league. Additionally, the 26 home runs the Redbirds have allowed over their last 18 games is most in the circuit during that time. The Birds have allowed 36 longballs this season, tied for the most in the league behind the Sod Poodles.

The Cardinals got quality pitching on Thursday in their doubleheader split at NW Arkansas, allowing just 2 ER over 13.1 IP.

TABLE SETTERS: The hitters that occupy the top two spots in the Cardinal lineup on the most regular basis, **Bryan Torres** and **Nathan Church**, have been the fuel to Springfield's league-leading offense. Combined, **Torres** and **Church** are batting .327 (67-for-205) with 38 R, 12 2B, 20 SB, 4 CS and have walked as many times as they've struck out (26). One of their names can be found 9 times among the top 10 in 7 different categories on the Texas League offensive leaderboard.

Springfield leadoff hitters are batting .293, and .308 out of the 2-hole, both good for 2nd in the Texas League.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: Cardinals outfielder **Nathan Church** ranks in the top-5 among qualified hitters in the following categories: RBIs (3rd; 22), hits (3rd; 36), total bases (4th; 53), and runs (t4th; 20). **Church** has hit safely in 24 of his 27 games played and despite 3 K's in Thursday's doubleheader, has struck out just 11 times in 126 plate appearances (8.7%). The UC Irvine product has already set a career high with 4 HR. He hit just 3 longballs at High-A Peoria last season in 119 games.

On Monday, **Church** was named Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month for April when he slashed .349/.402/.512 with 3 HR and 18 RBIs. He led all Cardinals minor leaguers in OPS (.914), hits (30), total bases (44), and runs (17). He hit safely in 19 of 20 games for the month.

TORRES STREAK SNAPPED: Springfield leadoff man **Bryan Torres** had his season-opening 23 game on-base streak snapped in game two of the Cardinals doubleheader on Thursday night with an 0-for-3 outing. **Torres** ranks among the leaders in the Texas League in 5 offensive categories: batting average (4th; .337), OBP (4th; .422), hits (t6th; 31) and leads the league with 13 stolen bases while being caught just twice.

REDMOND TIES FRANCHISE RECORD: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.


