TEEING OFF

- LET'S GET IT STARTED: Augusta looks to build off the momentum
 of last night's win, with Kendy Richard taking the mound for his Single-A
 debut against the vaunted Carolina offense.
- TEEN TITANS: The top of Augusta's order has led the way this season, with four players age 19 or younger dominating the top of the order, and four of six starters in the rotation being under 20 years of age.
- **RANK 'EM:** Four players from MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Braves Prospects are currently on Augusta's roster, down from five on Opening Day. The highest regarded is #1 prospect LHP Cam Caminiti, along with OF Luis Guanipa (#13), C Nick Montgomery (#22), and RHP Ethan Bagwell (#24).
- **TURNAROUND:** The Jackets rebounded from a poor showing in Myrtle Beach with four wins in six tries at Hickory, pulling to just under .500 on the roadtrip as the bats came alive.
- SO CLOSE, YET SO FAR: The GreenJackets fought all the way to the final day of the first half, but ended one game short of the team's first playoff appearance since 2019. The Columbia Fireflies claimed the South in the first half, and would await Augusta if the Jackets win the 2nd.
- **STRANDED:** Augusta has seen its team average with runners in scoring position drop over the last six weeks, down to .231 after rising over .255 at the beginning of June. The Jackets were 22-71 in those spots this week, coming up clutch and winning four of six games.
- **STRONG START:** The Jackets' starting pitchers have been rock solid as of late, especially at home. Augusta allowed just four earned runs in 40.1 innings pitched in their last 8 games at SRP Park.
- NEXT TIME OUT: Jacob Shafer makes his first home start of the year after returning off the Injured List last week. Carolina counters with Bryce Meccage, a top-15 prospect in Milwaukee's system.

MANAGER

Sawyer came to Augusta after a season with the FCL Braves, where he primarily worked with the catchers. A San Diego native, Sawyer was drafted in the 8th round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Scripps Ranch HS by the Baltimore Orioles. He spent 7 seasons in the Orioles system, before finishing his career with a year with the Los Angeles Dodgers and two seasons with the Minnesota Twins' systems, reaching AA Tulsa with the Dodgers and AAA Rochester with the Twins.

ELVIN NINA

PITCHING COACH

A mainstay at SRP Park over the last few years, Elvin Nina returns to the GreenJackets to guide the pitching staff for the second straight year. Nina was previously with the FCL Braves for the last two seasons, also as pitching coach, and served in the same role for Augusta in 2021.
