LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn snapped a 4-game slide with a $7-2$ win over Hudson Valley on Wednesday afternoon...1B Chase Estep collected 3 RBI, including a 2 -run triple in the 2 nd....Cyclones went ahead for good in the 6th when 2 scored on LF Jaylen Palmer's infield single and a throwing error...3B William Lugo reached base 3 times and registered a pair of knocks...RHP Blade Tidwell punched out 8 over 5 innings to earn his first pro win...LHP Daniel Juárez and RHP Paul Gervase combined to toss 4 -shutout and 2-hit innings striking out $6-$ to close out Brooklyn's win.

WHERE THERE'S A WILL-IAM, THERE'S A WAY: INF William Lugo comes into Thursday's matchup riding a season-high 4-game hitting streak...The 21-year-old tallied his first multi-hit game of the season on Wednesday afternoon and is 5 -for-his-last-15 (.333) during the stretch...Lugo has tallied 4 runs scored, a double, a triple, and an RBI, adding 2 walks and a stolen base...The Dominican native has also reached base safely in 6 -consecutive contests dating back to May 10...Lugo is slashing $.316 / .458 / .474$ with a .932 OPS and a 158 wRC+ in that span.

HIT PARADA: C Kevin Parada cracked a home run on Tuesday night and has been on a tear since the calendar flipped to May.. In 13 games during the season's second month, the 21 -year-old is slashing .306/.382/.592 with a . 974 OPS...Parada is 15 -for-49 at the dish (.306) with 8 runs scored, 6 doubles, a triple, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI...In that time frame, the Los Angeles native holds a . 428 wOBA and a 154 wRC + ...In the month of May, Parada is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in extra-base hits (9) and tied for 2nd in doubles (6)...For the entire campaign, the Georgia Tech alum is tied for 3rd in the SAL in two-base hits (10).

E-STEP UP: After a bumpy month of April, INF Chase Estep has picked up the pace at the plate in season's second month...In his last 9 games played dating back to May 5 , the 23 -year-old is slashing $.290 / .333 / .516$ with an .849 OPS... Estep has accumulated 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, a home run, and 7 RBI in 33 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a $122 \mathrm{wRC}+.$. In his first 12 games, the Estep was just 2 -for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21 .

NONE SHALL PASS: LHP Daniel Juárez has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 11 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 2-0 record with 1 save... He has not permitted a run on 5 hits and 6 walks, striking out 21 ( $13.83 \mathrm{~K} / 9$ )...In 16 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 18.0 innings...The 22 -year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 24 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is $4-0$ with 10 hits allowed, 15 walks, and 36 strikeouts in 28.1 innings...Since the streak began, no pitcher in Minor League Baseball has thrown more innings without allowing an earned run.
STU-PER DUPER: RHP Tyler Stuart has been as consistent as any starting pitcher in the SAL in 2023...The 23 -year-old extended his scoreless inning streak to 8.0 innings with 5.0 scoreless frames at Wilmington on Saturday...Entering Thursday, Stuart leads the league in ERA (1.40)... He is also tied for 6 th in batting average against (.202)...The right-hander is also 4th in XFIP (3.50) and 6th in strikeout rate (32.1\%) and strikeouts per nine innings (11.92).

ROAD WARRIOR: OF Stanley Consuegra has thrived away from Maimonides Park in 2023...Coming into Thursday, the 22 -yearold has posted a batting average 125 points higher on the road (.313) than at home (.188)...Away from home, Consuegra is slashing $.313 / .361 / .612$ with a .973 OPS adding 10 of his 15 extra-base hits
vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn heads continues their 2 week road trip with a 6-game set against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades boast 3 of New York's top 30 prospects per Baseball America...OF Spencer Jones (6), RHP Drew Thorpe (8), and C Antonio Gómez (27) are featured...The Cyclones went 14-16 in 30 matchups against Hudson Valley in 2022...Brooklyn held a 8-10 record at Heritage Financial Park last year...The Cyclones are 127-135 (.485) all-time against the Renegades dating back to the 2001 season.
and all 5 of his home runs... 17 of his 19 RBI have been on the road, as well...As a team, the Cyclones are hitting 25 points better in visiting parks (.220) than on Coney Island (.195).
'DASH' LOS SANTOS: In addition to his 14 stolen bases in 15 attempts in 2023, OF Omar De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23 -year-old has accumulated 84 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (91), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (88), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (88), and Athletics OF Esteury Ruíz (85) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 49 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 35 ...Omar is already 18 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

JUMPIN' JOE: OF/1B Joe Suozzi enters Thursday riding a 6-game on-base streak...The Glen Cove, N.Y. native is 5-for-his-last-18 (.278) with 3 runs scored, a double, 4 RBI, 3 walks, and a stolen base.. Suozzi has registered a 697 OPS in those 6 contests...Dating back to April 26 at Jersey Shore, the 25 -year-old has registered at least one base knock in 9-of-12 games.

WIZARD OF OS: C Drake Osborn enters Thursday's fixture on a sea-son-long 6 -game on-base streak...Since registering his first multi-hit game as a Cyclone on May 3 vs . Aberdeen, the 24 -year-old is 6 -for21 at the plate (.286) with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 4 RBI, and 2 walks...Osborn holds an . 967 OPS since the streak began

ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL: Prior to Opening Day, Baseball America ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the Ione South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, ac cording to MLB Pipeline and Baseball America and 5 of the Top 30. They include C Kevin Parada (No. 2 MLB Pipeline/No. 4 Baseball America), OF Alex Ramírez (3/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (6/9)...INF William Lugo (26/26) and RHP Christian Scott (29/26) also appears on both lists...OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 20 farmhand per MLB Pipeline.
