## AMARILLO SOD POODLES (28-30) vs. SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (26-32)

RHP DANIEL EAGEN (0-5, 6.04 ERA) vs. SHP JURRANGELO CIJNTJE (3-3, 5.15 ERA)

**SETTING THE SCENE:** The Cardinals continue their series with Amarillo (Arizona) with a Thursday night game at Route 66 Stadium ... tonight Springfield debuts its freshest alternate identity and will play as the Ozarks Snipe Hunters ... its the 3rd game of the 6 game set ... the clubs have split the first 2 games of the series ... SHP Jurrangelo Cijntje starts tonight for the Cards.

**SWITCH ON 'EM:** SHP Jurrangelo Cijntje makes his 12th start of the season and his 2nd vs. Amarillo ... in his last start on 6/5 at Frisco he allowed 5 runs (2 ER) on 2 hits with 5 strikeouts and 4 walks ... started Opening Night (4/3) at Amarillo and allowed only 1 hit over 5.2 scoreless innings with 7 strikeouts and 2 walks ... ranks 5th in the Texas League with 64 strikeouts.

**TURN THE PAGE:** Springfield dropped Wednesday's day game to Amarillo, 14-4 ... despite the loss the Cardinals totaled 4 home runs in the game ... IF Brody Moore and C Chase Adkison each hit their first homers of the season ... IF Dakota Harris hit his 6th ... Amarillo totaled 4 home runs including 2 from Gavin Contincello and a grand slam from Adrian De Leon ... LHP Liam Doyle allowed 4 runs on 8 hits over 4.0 innings and took the loss.

**MASON'S MOUND:** LHP Mason Molina pitched a season-high 6.0 innings for his 2nd straight start on Tuesday night ... also tied a career-high with 9 strikeouts ... allowed 4 runs (3 ER) on 4 hits with only 1 walk ... lowered his team-leading WHIP 1.16 which ranks 3rd in the TXL ... also leads the staff with a 3.31 ERA through 11 starts

... ranks 3rd in TXL with 65 strikeouts ... leads Springfield with 2 quality starts.

**SLAMMIN' THE SODDIES:** IF Trey Paige's grand slam on Tuesday night was Springfield's 4th slam vs. Amarillo this season ... was the club's 5th grand slam overall and its first since OF Miguel Ugueto on 5/16 at Tulsa ... IF Dakota Harris hit grand slams in back-to-back games, and IF Jon Jon Gazdar hit one as well, during the season-opening series at Amarillo.

**WHY THE SOD FACE?:** Today's game is the 6th of 12 in the season series with Amarillo and the 3rd of 9 between the clubs in the Ozarks ... the Cards swept a 3-game series at Hodgetown to open up the season and are 4-1 against Amarillo.

**GET YOUR HITS AT ROUTE 66:** Yesterday's loss snapped an 8-game home win streak dating back to 5/9 vs. Corpus Christi ... swept Wichita in 5 games during the last home series ... are now 13-11 at home this season.

**SHUFFLING CARDS:** The Cardinals promoted RHP Austin Love to Triple-A Memphis ... RHP Andrew Schultz was added after being signed from Lancaster (Ind.) ... IF Brody Moore was added from Triple-A Memphis.

- Acquired by Cardinals from Seattle as part of a three-team deal including Tampa Bay on 2/2/26 ... STL also acquired OF Tai Peete, OF Colton Ledbetter, and two Compensation Round B picks while sending IF Brendan Donovan to Seattle in deal
- Entered 2026 season ranked as the No. 6 prospect in Cardinals organization according to *Baseball America* and the No. 91 overall prospect in baseball according to *MLB Pipeline*
- Is designated as a switch-pitcher and will pitch both right-handed and left-handed with the Cardinals
- Drafted by Seattle in the 1st round (15th overall) in 2024 MLB Draft
- Originally drafted by Milwaukee in 18th round in 2022 MLB Draft, but did not sign
- Born in Gravenhague, Netherlands ... grew up primarily in Willemstad, Curaçao
- Played collegiately at Mississippi State ... went 11-7 with a 5.25 ERA over two seasons
- Graduated from Champagnat Catholic School in Hialeah, FL ... was rated No. 1 switch-pitcher in the nation and the No. 34 pitcher overall by Perfect Game
- Played for Curaçao in 2016 Little League World Series ... played infield and pitched from both sides of the mound
- Is multi-lingual, speaking English, Spanish, Dutch, and Papiamentu (a Portuguese-based Creole language spoken in the Netherlands Antilles)
- His father, Mechangelo, was a professional catcher and pitcher in the Netherlands ... Jurrangelo is a natural left-hander but learned to throw right-handed by emulating his father
- Currently resides in Miami, FL

- Pitched in 26 games (23 starts) between Double-A Arkansas and High-A Everett ... was promoted to Arkansas on Aug. 9 and made seven 7 starts in Texas League
