JUMBO SHRIMP DROP FINALE 4-1

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp offense struggled again on Sunday in a 4-1 loss to the Gwinnett Strippers. **Jakob Marsee** led off the game with a triple and scored on **Joe Mack's** sacrifice fly two batters later. However, **James McCann** socked a two-run home run in the bottom of the first inning to put Gwinnett in front for good. The Strippers added a run in the fifth on a **David Fletcher** sacrifice fly and another in the sixth on a **Jason Delay** RBI single. Over the last two games, Jacksonville's offense has mustered only two runs combined on eight hits.

SO, BABY, PULL ME CLOSER

Of the Jumbo Shrimp's last 48 games, a whopping 35, or 72.9 percent, have been decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 23-12 (.657) in these closely-decided affairs during this stretch. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 25-13 (.658) in games decided by no more than three runs, including a 13-6 (.684) mark in one-run games. Those 13 one-run victories are tied for the most in Triple-A and tied for second in MiLB.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the season opener, Jacksonville has recorded a stolen base in 46 of their last 56 games, with multiple steals in 34 contests. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have eight games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A and are fifth in the minors with 130 steals.

EXIT (VELOCITY) STRATEGY

Jacksonville's biggest strength in 2025, along with stealing bases, has been its pitching and defense. The club ranks second in Triple-A with a 3.56 ERA, and their 227 runs allowed are tied for the second-fewest at the level. Interestingly, Jacksonville's staff ranks only 17th in Triple-A in strikeouts (488), but their 390 hits allowed are the level's fewest, meaning the club has suppressed quite a few balls put in play. Opponents have mustered an average exit velocity of 87.0 against the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff, the third-lowest such mark in Triple-A.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD

Jacksonville's bullpen went nearly a week between earned runs, yielding three runs in the ninth inning of their May 24 contest against Memphis before a ninth-inning tally on Friday for Gwinnett. Over their last seven games dating back to May 25, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to surrender only six runs, three earned, on 14 hits in 29.2 innings for a 0.91 ERA. Jacksonville relievers have combined for 26 strikeouts against 15 walks during this stretch.

BE STILL, MY BEATING START

Over the six games of their series at Gwinnett, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers combined to cede just seven runs on 16 hits in 26.1 innings for a 2.39 ERA. Jacksonville lid-lifters have fanned 20 Gwinnett hitters against nine walks during this stretch. Through the six games against Gwinnett, the Strippers scored only 11 runs on 27 hits in 48.0 innings. Jumbo Shrimp starters surrendered three runs or fewer in all six contests.

PÉREZ DAY

Miami Marlins phenom **Eury Pérez** will continue a rehab assignment by starting Tuesday's game against Durham. After undergoing Tommy John Surgery and missing the entirety of the 2024 season, Pérez began his rehab assignment on April 26 for Low-A Jupiter. After five rehab starts for the Hammerheads, the 22-year-old has fanned 11 in 8.1 innings over two rehab starts with Jacksonville. Pérez was the Marlins 2022 Minor League Pitcher of the Year and was consensus top-15 prospect across the sport in 2023. He made his MLB debut on May 12, 2023 against the Cincinnati Reds. In 19 starts that year for Miami, Pérez had a record of 5-6 with a 3.15 ERA with 108 strikeouts in 91.1 innings. He finished seventh in NL Rookie of the Year voting.

SHRIMP BITES

Second-place Jacksonville now trails Lehigh Valley by 7.0 games in the International League, their biggest deficit in the standings this season... At 34-23, Jacksonville is off to its best start to a season since the 2010 Jacksonville Suns also started 34-23. If the Jumbo Shrimp can win on Sunday, they would own the best 58-game start in recorded club history (2005-present)... **Jakob Marsee** leads the IL in steals (33) while ranking tied for second in walks (39).

ABOUT EURY

-Eury stands 6-foot-8, but his parents, Eddy and Xiomara, are just 5-foot-3 and 5-foot-2, respectively. Eury is their only child.

-Pérez signed with the Miami Marlins for a \$200,000 bonus on July 2, 2019 as an international free agent.

-Pérez split the 2022 season between Low-A Jupiter and Double-A Pensacola. In 18 combined starts, he posted a 3-3 record and 3.97 ERA with 110 strikeouts in 77.0 innings of work. Following the season, he was named the Marlins' Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

-When he was coming up through the minor leagues, Pérez was a consensus top-15 prospect in all of baseball in 2023, ranking as high as No. 7 by *Baseball America*. He was called up straight from Double-A Pensacola to make his major league debut on May 12, 2023 for the Miami Marlins at loanDepot park. Pérez did not factor into the decision, going 4.2 innings and yielding two runs on four hits with seven strikeouts against two walks. The Marlins fell to the Cincinnati Reds 7-4. Pérez's first major league strikeout was of Tyler Stephenson.

-Pérez earned his first major league win six days after his debut. He yielded just one run on five hits with six strikeouts and one walk in 5.0 innings in Miami's 5-3 victory over the Washington Nationals on May 18, 2023 at loanDepot park.

2025 SEASON

-Pérez began a rehab assignment with Low-A Jupiter on April 26. Prior to joining Jacksonville, he has gone as many as 4.0 innings in a start and thrown as many as 48 pitches (both May 16 vs. Fort Myers).

2024 SEASON

-Pérez did not pitch after undergoing Tommy John Surgery.

2023 SEASON

-In nine home starts at loanDepot Park, Pérez went 3-2 with a 1.97 ERA (45.2 IP, 31 H, 13 BB, 57 K, .190 BAA). In 10 road starts in the major leagues, Pérez pitched to a 2-4 record and 4.34 ERA (45.2 IP, 41 H, 18 BB, 51 K, .236 BAA).

-Over 183 plate appearances in the major leagues, left-handed hitters slashed just .189/.290/.358 against Pérez. In comparison, over 188 plate appearances, right-handed hitters batted .236/.275/.483 against Pérez.

-Among major league pitchers, Pérez ranked in the 94th percentile for fastball velocity (97.5 mph), the 93rd percentile in whiff percentage (33.7 percent), 92nd percentile in breaking ball run value (9), 88th percentile in expected batting average against (.208), 85th percentile in both strikeout percentage (28.9 percent) and extension (6.9), 75th percentile in chase rate (31.0 percent) and 74th percentile in expected ERA (3.61).
