History vs. Quad Cities

The Lugnuts are 75-81 all-time vs. the River Bandits, 41-37 at home and 34-44 in Davenport.

After not meeting up at all in 2021 and 2022, the Lugnuts and River Bandits played 12 games against one another in 2023. Lansing went 7-5, 3-3 in QC.

Last year, the Nuts went 2-4 at Quad Cities, held in late August. Future Royal Jac Caglianone went 6-for-25, .240, .589 OPS, with 2 doubles, 1 walk, 4 strikeouts. The Nuts batted .188 and scored 20 runs in the series.

Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the second in a six-game series at the Quad Cities River Bandits, High-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, the only meetings between the two clubs this year. A Lugnuts win would reduce Cedar Rapids' magic number for clinching the West Division to 1.

Last Night: Lugnuts 3, River Bandits 0. The Nuts dealt a blow to Quad Cities' postseason hopes, waiting out a 77-minute rain delay and tossing a combined four-hit shutout behind **Jake Garland's** 6 2/3 scoreless innings and a five-out save from **Mark Adamiak**. Former Bandit **Jared Dickey** drove in two runs and scored the third run.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and River Bandits play through Sunday, finishing up the first half tomorrow and opening up the second half on Friday. Then the Nuts return home from Tuesday, June 24, through Sunday, June 29, vs. the Dayton Dragons.

Prospecting: The Lugnuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 8 prospect (**Tommy White**), No. 11 (**Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**), No. 13 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 17 (**Ryan Lasko**), No. 18 (**Rodney Green, Jr.**) and No. 28 (**Nate Nankil**). Overall, 21 of the 30 prospects have seen time in Lansing, with five prospects yet to reach the High-A level.

A'round the A's Org.:

- In Triple-A, **Zack Gelof** returned to action and drew two walks, stole two bases and scored two runs in Las Vegas' 7-0 win over Sugar Land. Back-to-back PCL Pitcher of the Week **Jack Perkins** dominated with five one-hit scoreless innings, whiffing seven.
- In Double-A, singles from **Cole Conn** and **Drew Swift** prevented a no-hitter in a 6-0 loss to Tulsa.
- In Single-A, **Ryan "Magic" Magdic** twirled six brilliant innings with seven strikeouts, allowing two hits and one run (a solo homer) in a 5-1 victory over Inland Empire.

Mark it Down: With his 11th save of the season last night, **Mark Adamiak** tied for the Minor League lead in saves with Frederick's Nathan Blasick, Knoxville's A.J. Puckett, and Hartford's Welinton Herrera. The next closest Midwest Leaguer is Beloit's Will Kempner with six, though Kempner has already been promoted to Double-A Pensacola.

The Men in the Pen: The Lugnuts have four of the six most heavily used relievers in the league. **Blaze Pontes** came on in relief yesterday for his league-leading 23rd appearance, followed by **Mark Adamiak** in the closer's 22nd appearance. **Hunter Breault** and **Yehizon Sanchez** are tied for 3rd in the league with 21 appearances..

Welcome Back to the QC: Last night's Lansing offense came on the shoulders of former River Bandits outfielder **Jared Dickey**, who ended an 0-for-22 drought with his RBI triple in the ninth. Dickey was drafted by the Royals in the 11th round in 2023 from Tennessee, played 82 games for the Bandits in 2024, and was traded to the Athletics at the deadline last year, returning to Quad Cities last August to slug his 10th home run of the season. Dickey currently is tied for 4th in the Midwest League in walks (40).

And Now... T.J.: First baseman **T.J. Schofield-Sam** is 3rd in all of Minor League Baseball in batting average (.346), and leads the MiLB leader, San Jose's Carlos Gutierrez, in OPS, .950-.914. Schofield-Sam leads the Midwest League in base hits (75) and HBPs (18), and ranks 2nd in total bases (113), 2nd in OPS (.943), tied for 2nd in triples (4), 3rd in slugging (.521), 4th in OBP (.422) and tied for 4th in runs scored (41).

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank 1st in the Midwest League in fewest strikeouts (442), 3rd in batting average (.257), 2nd in base hits (544), 2nd in doubles (126), 4th in on-base percentage (.353), 3rd in total bases (807) and 4th in OPS (.734).

On the Mound: Lansing's pitching corps is 1st in the league in holds (28), tied for 1st in complete games (2), 1st in fewest HBPs (21), 1st in fewest balks (4), 2nd in fewest walks (234) and 2nd in saves (17).

In the Field: The Nuts have turned 68 double plays this season, most in the Midwest League.

JUNE 18TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2002: The Lugnuts hosted their third Midwest League All-Star Game, setting a new league record with a crowd of 10,334. The East defeated the West, 6-3. The game includes future Major League stars Joe Mauer and Edwin Encarnacion.

2013: Dalton Pompey's two-out RBI single in the bottom of the ninth lifted the Eastern Division All-Stars to a 6-5 walk-off win over the West in the MWL All-Star Game in Dayton. If Pompey had not come through, the game would have ended in a tie.

2016: The first three Lugnuts in the 1st inning, Andrew Guillotte, Jake Thomas and Max Pentecost, each singled to load the bases against West Michigan starter Sandy Baez. A Little League grand slam followed: Juan Kelly tripled into the bullpen and scored on a Jose Azocar throwing error. Five batters later, Ryan Metzler supplied a two-run triple, capping a six-run first inning. The Lugnuts won, 7-6..

Last Time Out: On June 12 vs. West Michigan, gave up six runs in four innings (5 H, 2 BB, 4 K), losing 7-1... gave up three runs in the 1st (Malgeri leadoff HR, McGonigle 2B, Clark 2B, sac fly), McGonigle solo HR in 3rd, and two runs in 5th (McGonigle RBI 2B, inherited runner scored against Wander Guante).

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball – the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

19-year-old Steven Echavarria is part of an exclusive club: players who suited up for the Lugnuts as teenagers. Future Major Leaguers include 19-year-old Max Muncy, who joined the Nuts for the final 42 games of 2022; 19-year-old Gabriel Moreno, who homered in his first Lugnuts at-bat in 2019; Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. and Bo Bichette, who were 18 and 19 respectively when they dominated the 2017 Midwest League and appeared in the Futures Game; 18-year-old Carlos Beltrán, who was in the Lugnuts' very first Opening Day lineup on April 5, 1996; and the 1999 Lugnuts teenage duo of 19-year-old Corey Patterson, who was named the Midwest League Prospect of the Year, and 18-year-old Carlos Zambrano, who won 13 games and worked 153 1/3 innings.

Path to Lansing: After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... vs. right-handers: .306/.386/.387, 1 HR, 5 GiDP... vs. left-handers: .316/.431/.474, 3 HR, 1 GiDP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
